Troup County } Pursuant to the last will and testament
of Simeon R. Carly, late of said County, Deceased, after public
notice, made in the La Grange Reporter, on the first Tuesday in Febru-
ary, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty six, I, Elm-
ira C. Carly, duly constituted executrix of the last will and testam-
ent of said Simeon R. Carly, deceased, did, Agreeable to an order of
The Honorable the Court of Ordinary of said County, put up and expose
to sale to the highest bidder, at La Grange in said County, between the
legal hours of sale, lot of Land number one hundred and twenty two,
in the twelfth district of said County, containing two hundred, two
and a half acres more or less; when John Shankle, being the highest
and best bidder, said lot of Land was knocked off to him, at and for
the price of eighteen hundred and fifty dollars: now, therefore,
this indenture, made and entered into this the fifth day of February,
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six,
between said Elmira C. Carly of said County, executrix of the last
will and testament of said Simeon R. Carly, late of said County dec-
eased, of the one part, and said John Shankle of the same place, of
the other part, witnesseth that for and in consideration of eight-
een hundred and fifty dollars, cash in hand paid, at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, said Elmira C. Carly, executrix as aforesaid,
hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents doth
grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said John Shankle, his heirs, execu-
tors and administrators, all that lot of Land situate, lying and being
in the twelfth district of said County, known and distinguished in the
plan of said district by the number one hundred and twenty two,

containing two hundred two and a half acres more or less, with all the rights, members and appurtenances to said lot of land in any wise appertaining or belonging. To have and to hold said lot of land, unto him, the said John Shank, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever in fee simple. In testimony whereof the said Almira C. Early, executrix as aforesaid, hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal, the day and year above written.
