UD PRESENTS THIRD
LECTURE IN SERIES

DAYTON, Ohio, June 23, 1987--"Mission of the Laity" will be the topic of the third lecture in the University of Dayton Department of Religious Studies' summer lecture series on Tuesday, July 7, at 7:30 p.m. in Kennedy Union Boll Theatre on the UD campus. Dr. Bette Moslander, CSJ, will present the talk. According to Moslander, "This presentation will explore how the idea of mission is of central importance for understanding the nature of the Church and the need for Christians to understand themselves as called to mission through Baptism. The presentation will indicate that lay leadership in the Church works at finding ways for the Gospel message to take root in our own culture."

The final lecture in the series will be "Emerging Ministry of the Laity" given by Rosemary Haughton and Nancy Schwoyer on July 14.
