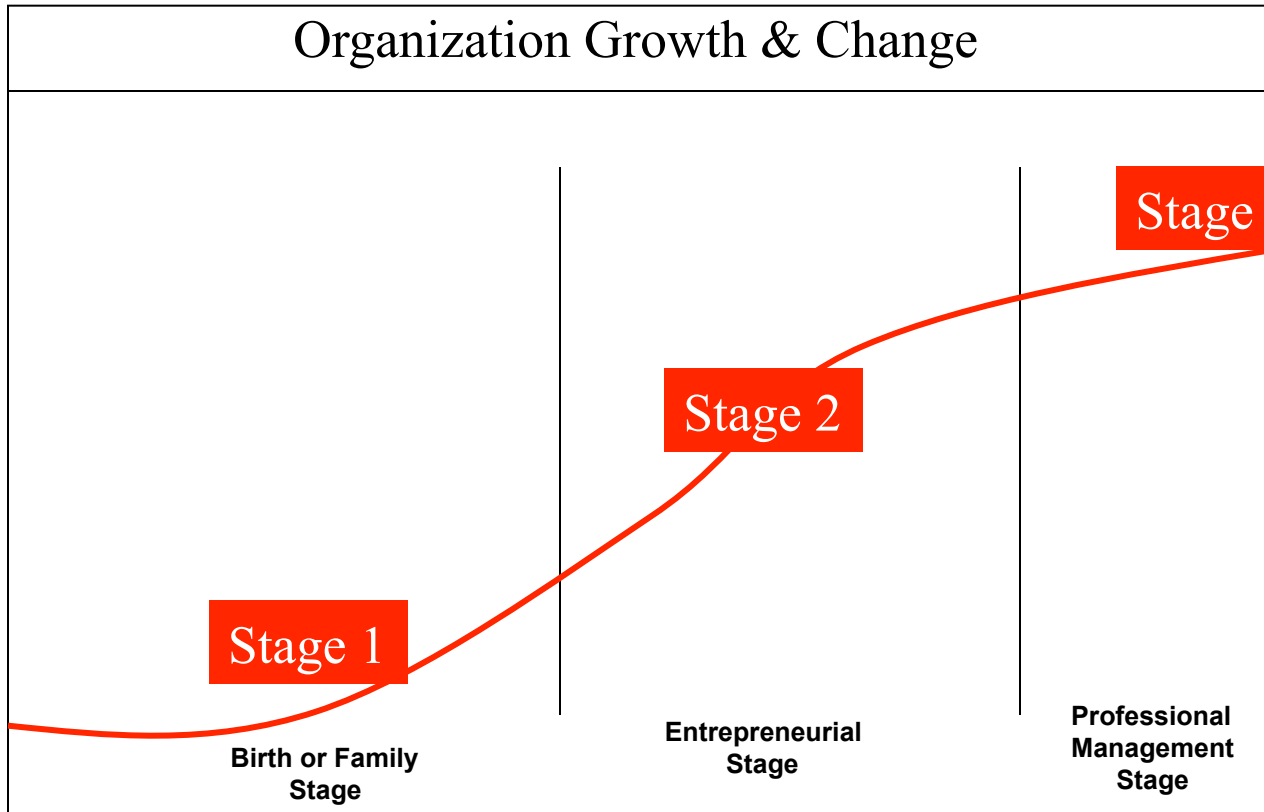

- ❖ Paradigm shifted in 1999 with the creation of the Jubilee Schools, and the opening of suburban schools.

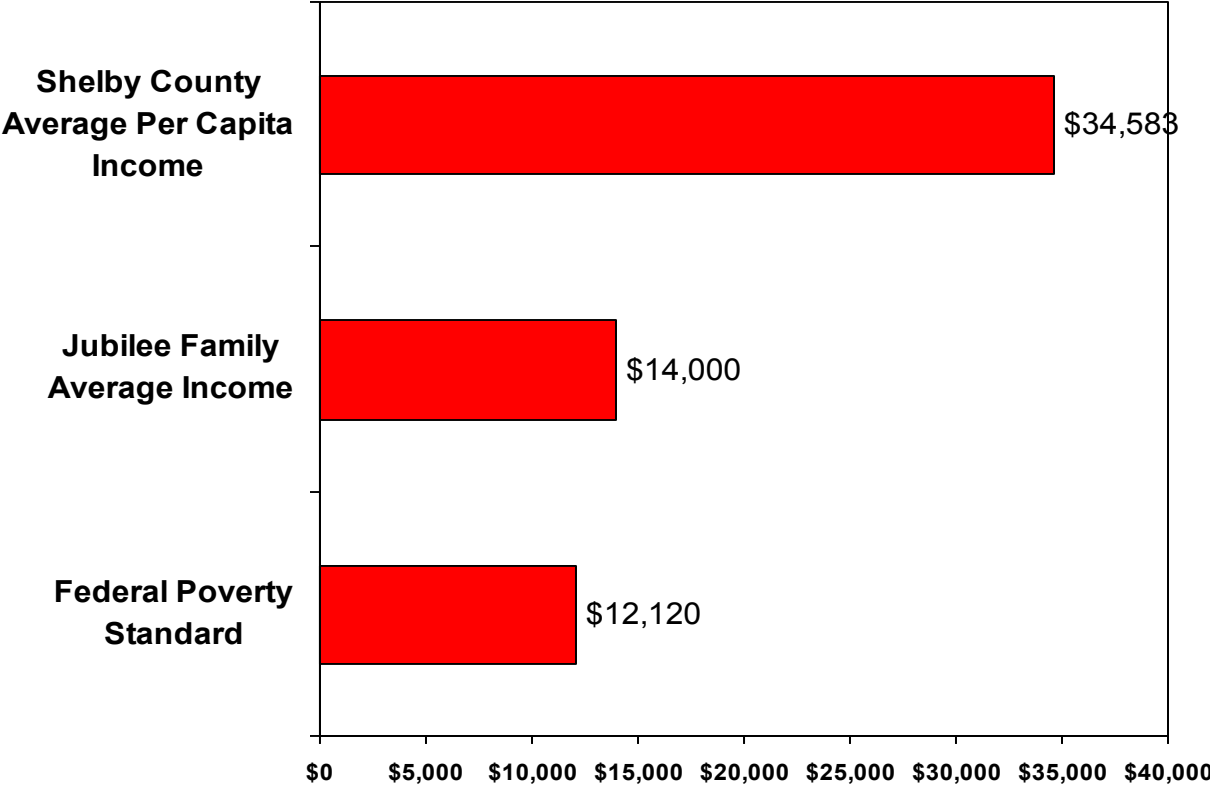

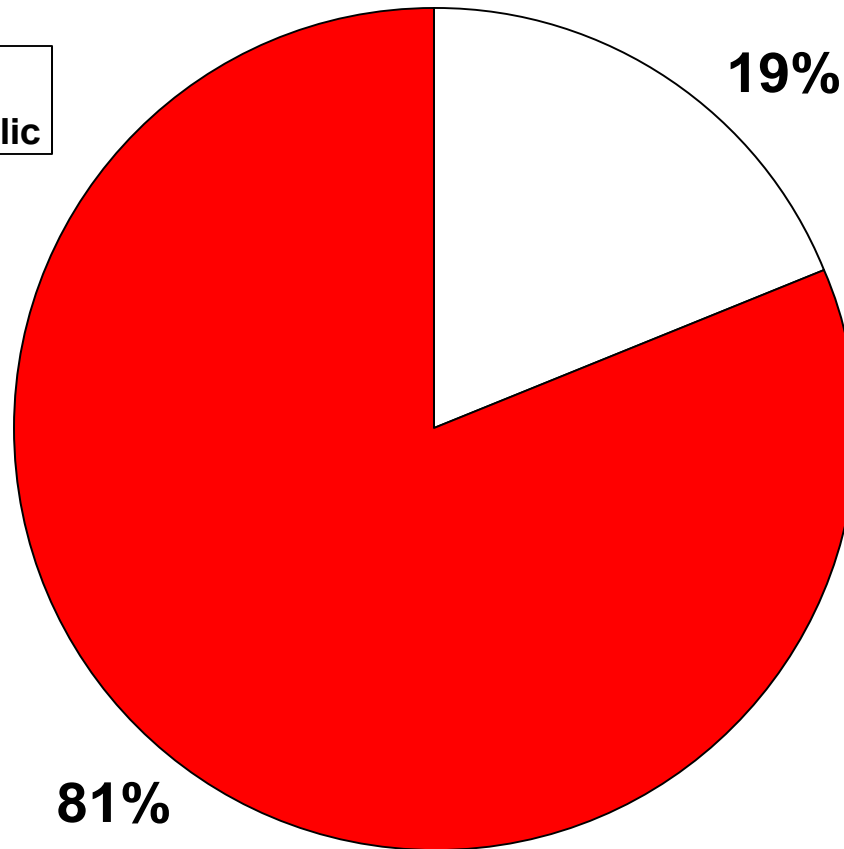

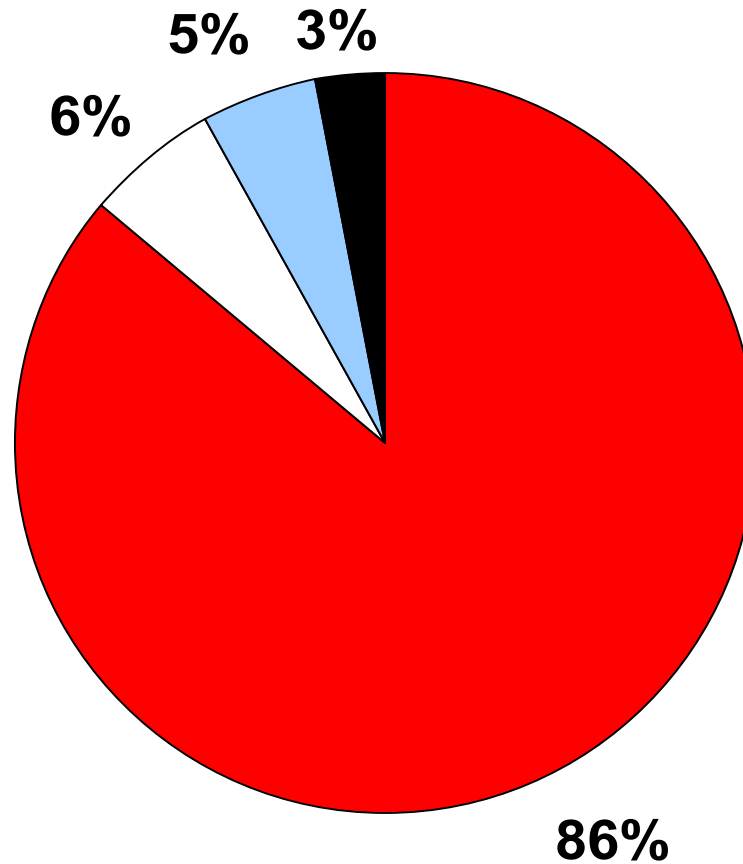
Average Incomes



Religion of Students



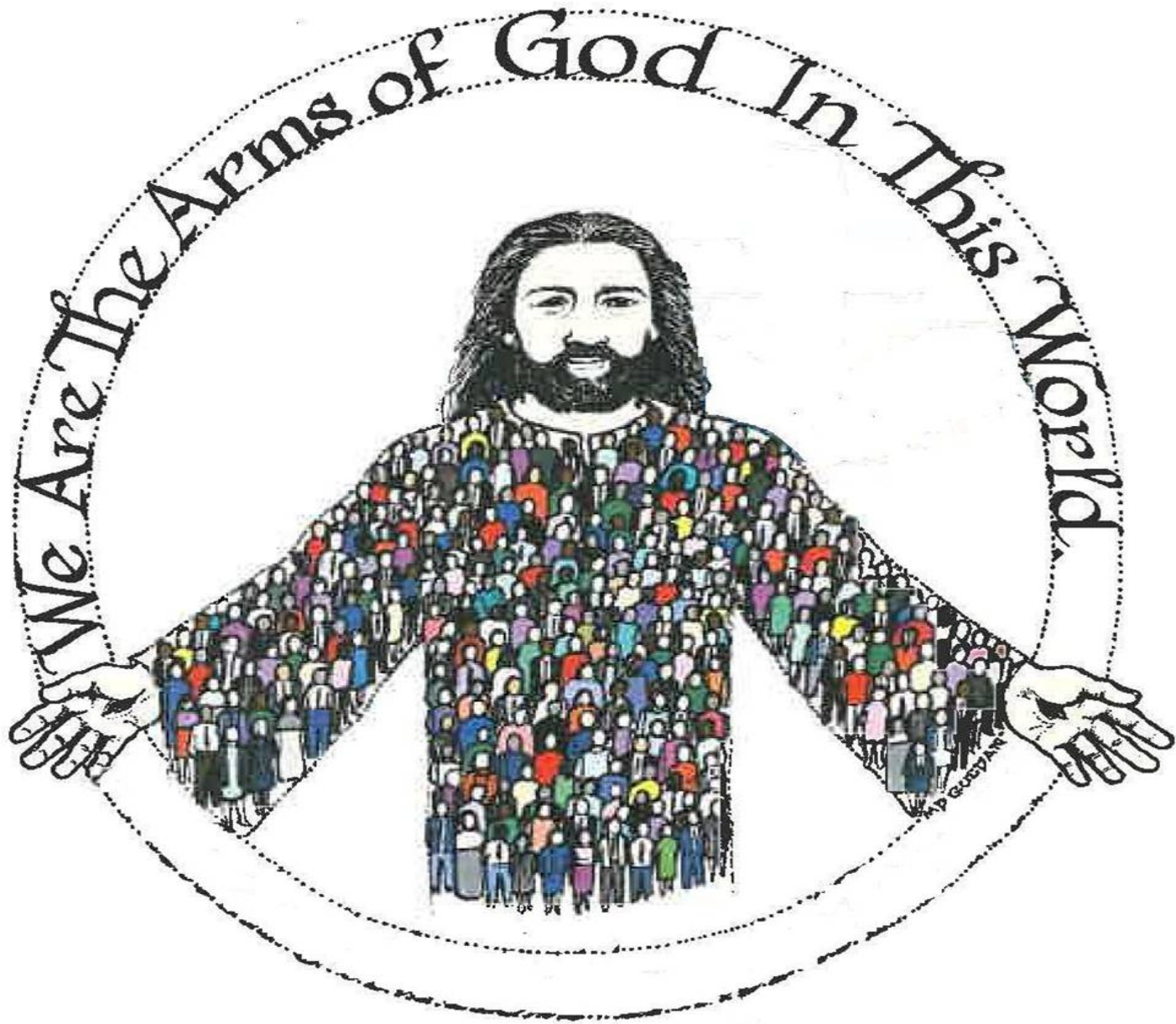
Race of Students

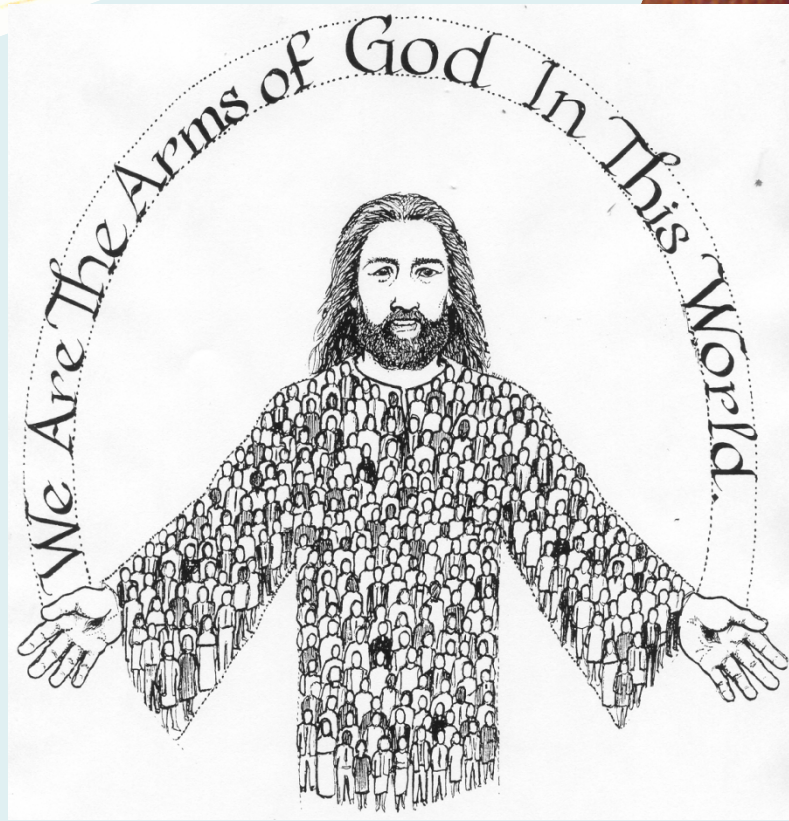
