UD ELECTS
NEW TRUSTEES

DAYTON, Ohio, June 3, 1981 -- The University of Dayton Board of Trustees has elected six new members and re-elected three.

The new trustees are Brother George A. Deinlein, S.M., assistant provincial and director of studies of the Cincinnati Province of the Society of Mary (Marianists); David E. Easterly, president of Dayton Newspapers, Inc.; Ermal Fraze, chairman of the board of Dayton Reliable Tool Company and president of Fraze Enterprises; Stanley Z. Greenberg, partner in the law firm of Jeffrey, Snell, Rogers and Greenberg; James W. McSwiney, chairman of the board of Mead Corporation; and Gerald S. Office, Jr., chairman of the board and president of Ponderosa Systems, Inc.

Only Greenberg has served previously on the UD Board of Trustees (1971-80). He is a 1962 UD graduate and former president of the student body.

Re-elected to three-year terms are Charles W. Danis, vice chairman of the board of Danis Industries Corporation; Ohio State Senator Richard H. Finan, partner of Finan, Lippert, and Dunlap, attorneys at law; and Peter H. Kuntz, vice president of personnel of the Peter Kuntz Company. Kuntz is re-elected as vice chairman of the UD Board of Trustees.
