WVUD GENERAL MANAGER RESIGNS

DAYTON, Ohio, April 6, 1981 -- Donald W. Miles has resigned as general manager of WVUD-FM of the University of Dayton.

Miles succeeded the late George Biersack as the station's general manager on July 1, 1980. He was responsible for the management of all station operations. An interim general manager has been appointed. He is Jack C. Rang, Ph.D., associate professor in the Department of Communication Arts. A search will be undertaken immediately to fill the position.

In accepting Miles' resignation Brother Joseph W. Stander, S.M., vice president for academic affairs and provost, acknowledged the general manager's contributions to the station and thanked him for his efforts.

WVUD-FM is a 50,000-watt FM station which provides on-the-air opportunities for students of the University of Dayton interested in broadcasting careers.
