**SENIOR CITIZEN DAY CELEBRATION
TO BE HELD AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON**

DAYTON, Ohio, April 30, 1990--"Senior Citizens Day," an annual celebration recognizing the contribution of older Ohioans, will be held on Tuesday, May 15, from 1:30 to 4 p.m. in the University of Dayton's Kennedy Union. The event, which is open to all senior adults in Montgomery County, is sponsored by the Montgomery County Council on Aging.

Awards for outstanding senior adults will be presented to two individuals, a Montgomery County couple and a local nursing home resident. Winners from previous years also will be recognized. The event will include entertainment by the Kettering Music Makers and Community Chorus and the Human Race Theatre Group.

Senior Citizens Day has been celebrated across the state of Ohio since 1977 when the state legislature declared the third Tuesday of May as a day to recognize "the annual celebration of aging." The 1990 theme for the event--"A Partnership of Ages"--will recognize the bonds between young and old.
