WORKSHOP SESSIONS AT UD WILL FOCUS ON RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CONCERNS

DAYTON, Ohio--"Religious Education: Believing and Proclaiming," a one-day seminar for religious educators, will be offered from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 17, at the University of Dayton's Kennedy Union.

The keynote speaker for the 16th annual Religious Education Institute will be the Rev. Patrick J. Brennan, director of the office for Chicago Catholic Evangelization, president of the National Council for Catholic Evangelization and president of the National Center for Evangelization and Parish Renewal. His work focuses on parish renewal programs for active and inactive Catholics as well as those with no parish affiliation. Among his books are The Evangelizing Parish, The Reconciling Parish and Re-Imagining the Parish.

Those attending the institute will participate in three workshop sessions designed for primary, elementary, junior and senior high school religious education teachers. Participants will choose from 41 topics, including "Building an Affirming and Enriching School Climate," "Nurturing the Faith Life of the Young Child," "Religious Education for Special Needs Learners," "The Gospel Message and the American Dream" and "Teaching the Sacraments with Love and Visual Aids."
