





A joint meeting of the Securities Exchange Commission and the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System was called to consider possible methods of counter-attack to restore the slumping market. The most drastic of the proposals considered was one for a 150% margin requirement on the purchase of securities.

Addwight Stevenhower, bipartisan President, has been in emergency consultation with Sec retary of State John Foster Dullice, to consider the effects of this crisis upon our foreign relations. A further issue under consideration is the question of how to cope with the anticipated raids of the Cuban rebels, under the leadership of Fidel Castro. It is reported that since receiving the news of the stock-market crisis, Castro's men have been ready to storm the mainland.




