





RESPONDENTS BY COUNTRY (ECD – 6,566)




RESPONDENTS BY COUNTRY (SID – 2,498)





■ MALE ■ FEMALE



■ MALE ■ FEMALE



AGE BY GENDER (WAD)







LEVEL OF EDUCATION (ECD)




