A STUDY OF WOMEN  
IN THE SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH

There is an increasing interest in the role of women in the Seventh-day Adventist church. Any study of this subject must necessarily give consideration to the attitudes and behaviors of the women themselves.

From 1980-1982, the Institute of Church Ministry conducted church growth surveys in a number of conferences. A large amount of information was collected which revealed the attitudes and practices of church-attending Adventists toward their local church and its mission to the community.

This report is a secondary analysis of the data. It seeks to compare the differences between the profiles of the women and the profiles of the men who responded to the questionnaires in several of these church growth surveys.

This sample of over 11,000 active Adventists, drawn from widely separated sections of the United States, provides a substantial base from which to understand the differences -- if any -- between the attitudes and behaviors of men and women.

In addition the 4530 Oregon women (the largest group) and the 2998 Oregon men have been sub-divided into five age categories: 19 years or under, 20-35 years, 36-50 years, 51-65 years, and over 65 years. While the youngest group has only 10 percent of the women and 11 percent of the men included, the others contain approximately the same number, ranging from 20 to 25 percent. These ten profiles are also included so that it can be determined if the characteristics of women differ across age categories.

#### Comments

A comparative analysis of the responses of men and women in Illinois, Pennsylvania, Oregon, Hawaii, and Georgia indicate a number of significant differences.

Women tend to feel better about their relationship with Christ and are more sure about eternal life. Although slightly more men feel better prepared for soul winning activities, conduct Bible studies and attended witnessing training, more women set a personal soul-winning goal, are involved in community outreach programs, and study the Bible more often.

There's a slight difference in attitudes toward evangelism. Men would like the conference to spend more on evangelism and yet women find their local church more soul-winning.
