
2010

Policy proposal not-approved by the Council.



2009

Building of a municipal public policy through Municipal Working Group on Food Security (Mesas SAN)



2015

CIAT starts its work with the Mayor's Office to boost the development of a new Policy and participates simultaneously in the Food Security Working Group.

The "Cali better food" Project began and generated knowledge about the city's food system. This project was funded by FORD Fundation.

2016

Call to Municipal Secretariats to build the Policy, in order to create multisectoral interest.

Creation of the Academic Platform to support the process aiming to build the public policy.

> CIAT research on food consumption informed by gaps identified in the Working groups established by the municipal authorities.



2018

Consolidation of Cali's food policy and presentation to the Municipal Council

South-South exchange workshop on "Urban city-region agro-food practices and policies" to promote cooperation between Cali, Medellín and Quito (Ecuador)




