## **PREFACE**

The fifteenth annual edition of the Ninth Circuit Survey focuses on selected decisions of the Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. This issue is primarily a collection of notes and comments regarding cases decided in 1989. A few significant cases have been summarized as well.

In addition, this issue includes two articles selected for publication.
