California launched the Nation's most unique and promising regulatory reform effort when the Legislature passed and the Governor approved AB 1111 (McCarthy). That legislation created the Office of Administrative Law and charged it with the responsibility of conducting a thorough review of all state regulations—new as well as existing ones.

During the first nine months of the Office's existence, the number of new regulations amending or adding to the Administrative Code has been cut by 50 percent. That same critical evaluation is now to be applied to the 30,000 pages of regulations adopted by 123 state agencies during the past four decades.

Regulations affecting all aspects of life—from air pollution to worker health and safety, including coastal protection, energy standards, licensing, and permit requirements—will be judged against the statutory standards of necessity, authority, consistency, reference, and clarity. Any regulation failing to satisfy these standards will be changed or eliminated.

These regulations will first be examined by the adopting agencies in accordance with review plans submitted to the Office of Administrative Law. We have summarized the plans from the 123 agencies into the attached Master Plan as called for by Government Code Section 11349.7. This Master Plan summarizes when and how each state regulatory agency will conduct the review of its existing regulations and describes the mechanism each agency will use to ensure public participation in the review process.

Certainly, we want to encourage active involvement by individuals, groups and businesses as we seek to reduce governmental interference in the lives and enterprises of California residents. Full participation by the public will enhance our efforts to end unwarranted governmental control while maintaining appropriate protection for the economy, the environment, and the health and safety of workers and the public. The purpose of this Master Plan is to aid the public in monitoring and taking part in the comprehensive review of all existing regulations.

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“Every agency subject to the provisions of this chapter shall undertake a review of all regulations administered by it. . . . The Office of Administrative Law shall, on or before April 1, 1981, file with the Governor, the Senate Committee on Rules and the Speaker of the Assembly a MASTER PLAN FOR REGULATION REVIEW (emphasis added). The Master Plan shall establish specific dates by which each agency shall have complied with this section, including interim review goals to be met each year. . . .”

INTRODUCTION

This *Master Plan for Regulation Review* is submitted pursuant to Government Code Section 11349.7(d). The purpose of the Master Plan is to provide a schedule of specific dates by which each regulatory agency shall have completed its review of regulations in effect prior to July 1, 1980, with the ultimate objective of repealing or amending those which do not meet the statutory standards of necessity, authority, clarity, consistency, or reference.

The Master Plan is also intended to facilitate the understanding of and participation in the regulation review process by the Legislature and the general public.

Section I provides a general overview of the regulation review requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act (AB 1111, McCarthy), the regulatory reform measure signed into law by Governor Brown in 1979.

Section II describes the required contents of each agency plan, the progress agencies have made in developing their plans and the process used by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for approving plans.

Section III contains an outline of the regulation review process, describing required review activities and OAL's role as monitor and independent reviewer.

Section IV contains a summary of each agency plan, with completion dates and a brief description of the agency's review process, including coordination and public participation mechanisms.

SECTION I: BACKGROUND

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA), Chapter 567 of the Statutes of 1979 (AB 1111 McCarthy), charged all regulatory agencies and the Office of Administrative Law with the orderly review of the almost 30,000 pages of existing government regulations against statutory standards, with the goal of reducing the number and improving the quality of regulations.

The APA requires agencies to develop and submit review plans to OAL, describing how each agency will evaluate regulations in effect prior to July 1, 1980 to determine whether such regulations are: (1) necessary to implement, interpret or make specific a law or court decision (2) promulgated by agencies authorized to do so; (3) clearly written so that persons affected by them can easily understand them; (4) consistent with existing laws; and (5) referenced to a specific statute or court decision.

The original statutory deadline for submitting plans to OAL was July 1, 1980, the date OAL opened its doors. We found at that time that about half of the agencies had prepared review plans. Those that had developed plans had done so without the benefit of guidelines or instructions. Consequently, most plans were wholly inadequate. Accordingly, OAL and the Administration worked with the Legislature in amending Government Code Section 11349.7 to extend the deadline for submission of plans to December 31, 1980 (SB 1754, Holmdahl).

In October, the Governor issued Executive Order No. B72-80 instructing all agencies to accelerate the completion of the regulation review process and to ensure that the reviews be conducted with full opportunity for public participation. The Governor's Executive Order required that the review of all existing regulations be completed by December 31, 1982. (A copy of the Executive Order is attached to this report.) The review is to be completed in accordance with the following schedule:

June 30, 1981	Titles 1, 7, 9, 11, 12, 15, 20, 21, 23
January 31, 1982	Titles 2, 3, 4, 5, 13, 14, 19
July 31, 1982	Titles 8, 10, 16, 17, 18, 22, 25

Where agencies documented a need for additional time to conduct a thorough review, OAL has extended the above deadlines on an exception basis.¹

Also in October, OAL drafted agency instructions for compiling the review plan. Meetings were held with a number of agencies, legislative staff and several private sector interest groups to obtain their assessment of the draft instructions. Incorporating their suggested changes, the OAL instructions were finalized and sent to agencies on October 24, providing over two months for plan completion.

¹ The review of regulations contained in Title 24 relating to building standards is the responsibility of the Building Standards Commission and thus not included in this schedule.

We project that agencies will complete the review of approximately 10 percent of the regulations by June 30, 1981, 35 percent by January 31, 1982, and 95 percent by July 31, 1982. OAL has approved extension requests beyond July 1982 for the remaining 5 percent of the Administrative Code.

All regulations will have been reviewed well within the original statutory deadline of June 30, 1986. The Office of Administrative Law will conduct its own independent review of those regulations amended or left unchanged within six months after each agency has completed its review.

Agencies have been encouraged to rely on existing resources to accomplish the review. The Legislature appropriated a total of \$3.5 million annually to be used by agencies and OAL for additional costs associated with review activities. The Governor has ordered that no new funds shall be added to this annual appropriation, directing agencies to meet any additional costs by diverting resources from activities having less priority. Agencies may apply for a portion of the \$3.5 million by submitting a budget change proposal to the Department of Finance, which has the responsibility for allocating the available funds. We have been informed that fewer than 25 out of the 123 agencies have requested these funds.

SECTION II: PLANNING FOR REGULATION REVIEW

The OAL instructions for regulation review provided specific guidelines for the development of review plans and required that agencies describe how this review process:

- (1) would ensure adequate public participation;
- (2) would be coordinated with other agencies sharing regulatory responsibilities for program areas which overlap or are closely related;
- (3) would be scheduled and staffed to ensure an even flow of activities and the timely completion of the review.

The statutory deadline for plan submission to OAL was December 31, 1980. Only 65 of the 123 agencies met the deadline, with an additional 41 agencies submitting plans during January. Some plans were received as late as March 24, 1981.

To date, only one agency, the Department of Education, has failed to submit a plan. Despite numerous attempts by OAL to effect compliance, this agency still refuses to follow the mandate of AB 1111. As far as we know, the Department has no intention of submitting a review plan or conducting a review of its regulations. The remedy provided by the Legislature to ensure compliance in this situation is an order to show cause why regulations ought not to be repealed. If subsequent to that order, OAL does not receive information supporting the necessity, authority, clarity, and consistency of the regulations, OAL may order the repeal of those regulations which fail to meet one or more of the standards.

OAL staff has closely examined each agency plan and approved those that conformed to statutory mandates and to the Governor's Executive Order. Many plans were not acceptable and required extensive negotiations with regulatory agencies. The majority of agencies, however, proved to be cooperative, even though they were late in meeting deadlines.

Issues requiring negotiation related primarily to unacceptable delays in scheduling, inadequate public participation and, in a few instances, to plan provisions that resulted in excessive and unnecessary costs. The great majority of these issues were resolved with agency representatives. In a number of instances, OAL exercised its statutory authority to set agency schedules and ensure appropriate public participation.

All plans, with whatever amendments were necessary, have now been approved by OAL. Many agencies have already begun implementing their plans and a few have even completed their review of a portion of their regulations.

SECTION III: REGULATION REVIEW PROCESS

The regulatory review process includes the following steps:

1. Agencies develop and OAL approves agency plans for review of all regulations, specifying sections to be reviewed, dates for public comment and completion of review and the process used for public participation and coordination.

2. OAL periodically publishes a schedule of reviews based on agency work plans in the California Administrative Register Notice Supplement (Notice Register). OAL will monitor agency progress and report periodically to the Governor and the Legislature.

3. Agencies conduct reviews, ensuring adequate public involvement. At completion of review, agency submits Statement of Review Completion to OAL. The Statement will be published in the Notice Register. For any proposed adoptions, amendments or repeals of regulations resulting from the review, agencies must comply with all provisions of Government Code Section 11346 establishing procedural requirements for regulatory action.

4. For all regulations retained, an agency shall provide to OAL a Statement of Findings summarizing public comment, studies and other reasons or information relied on for its decision. The Statement of Findings may relate to a cluster or group of regulatory sections, appropriate. In addition to the summary of information, the Statement of Findings shall contain at least the following information: (a) where public comment has been made recommending the repeal of specific regulations, the agency shall include its reasons for rejecting the public comment; (b) where regulations that are being retained do not have a specific reference to statutory authority, that reference must be cited.

5. Upon completion of agency review, OAL, upon its own motion or upon petition from a

The Office may request the agency which chose not to repeal a regulation to forward any information on which it relied in reaching its decision. Agencies must respond within 14 calendar days.

6. In the event OAL determines through its review that an existing regulation does not meet the standards set forth in Section 11349.1, the Office shall order the adopting agency to show cause why the regulation should not be repealed. Agencies shall respond to OAL no later than 60 days following receipt of the order.

7. OAL shall review all information available to it, including the agency's response to the order to show cause and determine whether the regulation meets the statutory standards. If OAL determines that a regulation fails to meet the standards, it shall deliver to the agency, Legislature and Governor a public statement specifying the reasons for its determination.

8. Thirty (30) days after delivery of the above statement, OAL shall prepare and transmit an order of repeal of the regulation to the Secretary of State.

Throughout the review process OAL will monitor the activities of the agencies and will publish periodic reports to the Legislature on the progress of each agency. The plan submitted by each agency will serve as the basis for determining progress and adherence to the review mandate. OAL will work closely with each agency to ensure that the plan is carried out in a timely and effective manner.

All those who are interested in the review of regulations are encouraged to participate. To become involved in the review, contact the agency responsible for the regulations concerned.

By referring to the following section which summarizes the plans for each agency, it can be determined who to contact for further information, and the schedule for the review of specific sections of the Administrative Code.

SECTION IV: AGENCY PLANS

On the pages that follow, a summary of each agency's Regulation Review Plan is provided to enable interested parties to become involved in the review process and to determine certain basic information on the conduct of the review.

The following explains how to use the plan summaries.

1. Agencies

The plans are organized by Cabinet level agency, with each department appearing in alphabetical order.

2. Agency Coordinator

The Agency Coordinator is the contact person for the review. Their names, addresses and telephone numbers are provided to enable interested persons to contact agencies for further information and to arrange for participation in the review process.

3. Column Headings

A. Administrative Code Under Review

Under this heading appear the sections or block of sections being considered within a given period of time. Contact the Agency Coordinator to confirm this schedule.

B. Public Comment Ending Date

The date that appears in this column is the final date for receiving public comment by the agency as indicated in the agency plan. Please confirm this with the Agency Coordinator.

C. Statement of Review Completion

This is the date by which the agency will submit its Statement of Review Completion to OAL. The Statement of Review Completion is the document submitted to OAL following an agency's review of all or a group of regulations. The Statement identifies those regulations that the agency had determined do not satisfy the statutory standards and thus will be repealed or amended, as well as those that are found to meet all the standards.

D. Methods of Public Involvement

This column provides a summary of how the agency intends to notify the public of the review process. It is recommended that, if the agency intends to use mailing lists, interested persons ask to be placed on the mailing lists. The public can also request to become involved in advisory groups. Interested parties may wish to subscribe to the Notice Register, which can be accomplished by contacting OAL.

E. Review Process

This summarizes key aspects of the agency's review process. For more information, contact the Agency Coordinator.

F. Coordination

This column lists entities or aspects of coordination to ensure that efforts are made to reduce regulatory inconsistency and duplication. For more information on how agencies intend to carry this out, please contact the Agency Coordinator.

With the publishing of the Master Plan, it is hoped that participation in the review process will be encouraged and facilitated. OAL is convinced that the success of the regulation review effort will be greatly dependent on the extent interested parties and the general public participate. We strongly urge all interested persons and organizations to become involved in this effort.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B72-80

WHEREAS, burdensome, unclear and unnecessary state government regulations increase the business and consumer costs of services and commodities and stifle private initiative and individual responsibility; and

WHEREAS, this Administration is alarmed about the effects of such regulations and is committed to reducing and minimizing the intrusion of government into the affairs of California businesses and residents; and

WHEREAS, it is the constant obligation of government to reassess its proper role and to seek ways to be more effective and efficient, and particularly so during times of diminishing resources; and

WHEREAS, my signing of AB 1111 makes California the first state to require every state agency to review all regulations with the purpose of reducing their number and improving their quality, and establishes the Office of Administrative Law to direct the completion of the regulation review by 1986.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:

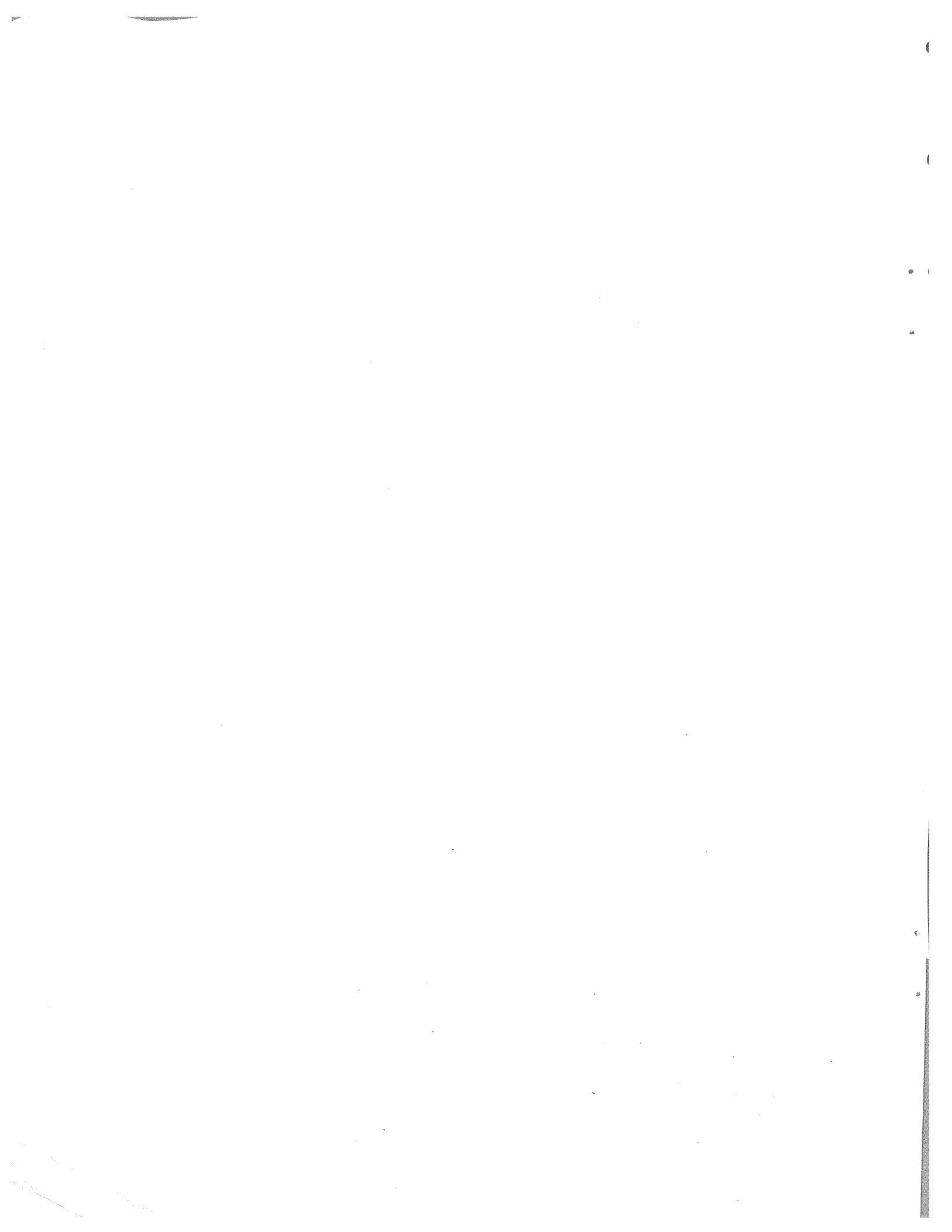
1. Agencies reviewing proposed and existing regulations shall eliminate all regulations that do not serve an essential governmental purpose.
2. The review of all existing regulations shall be accelerated and completed by December 31, 1982 provided, however, that an agency may seek from the Office of Administrative Law a later completion date if extraordinary circumstances would render completion by December 31, 1982 impossible.
3. State agencies shall insure that representatives of persons who are affected by their regulations are effectively involved in the review of all existing regulations. The Office of Administrative Law shall monitor agencies to ensure public participation in the review of existing regulations.
4. No new funds shall be added to the state budget for the accelerated review of regulations. Each year costs for conducting the review of existing regulations shall be allocated from an annual appropriation amount not to exceed the amount of the 1980-81 Budget Act for regulation review. Additional staffing needs shall be met by diverting existing resources.
5. The Office of Administrative Law shall deliver periodic reports to the Governor and the Legislature summarizing each agency's performance in meeting the goal of reducing the number of regulations and improving their quality.
