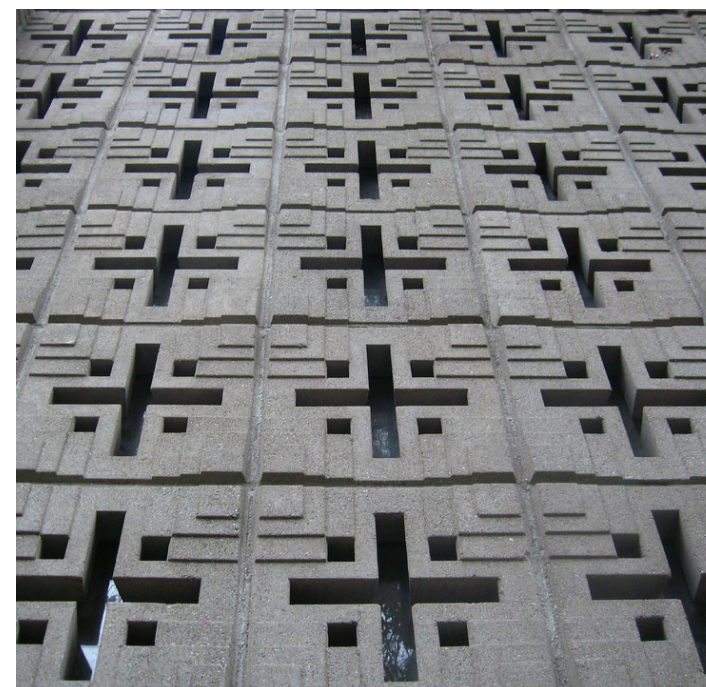


The Millard House

Climate: Mediterranean

Material of interest: 16" Concrete Textile Block

Application: Pre-cast concrete block used for all walls. Exterior walls have patterns, and at certain locations, the pattern has been cut to allow light and air to filter through.

Properties of material: Whitish-grey pre-cast concrete block formed with cruciform-imprinted molds. Wright used the block due to its modular characteristic making it cheap to make and easy to customize.
