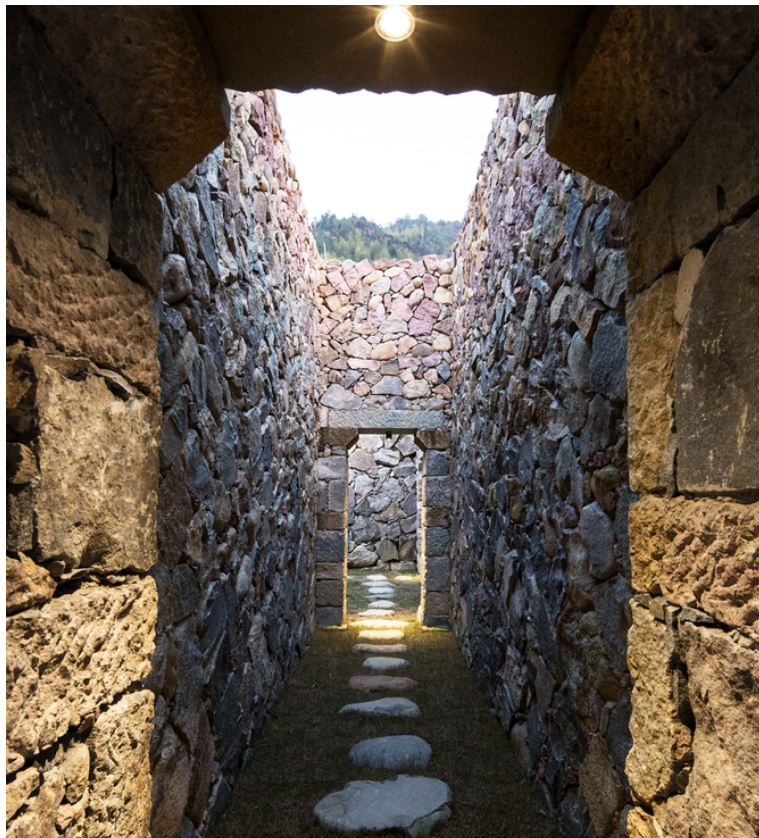


Hakka Indenture Museum
