## FOREWORD

This bibliography represents 200 publications including journal articles, books and book chapters; and 123 creative works from the arts by the faculty/staff at The College at Brockport during 2014-2017. It includes citations from all of the schools and many academic departments. Citations were gathered from a number of sources. The bibliography is expanded this year to include the 139 grants received during the last five years.

The number of citations since last publication of this list continues to grow. In part, this can be attributed to Brockport's vibrant faculty with many new names and areas of scholarship represented. The bibliography also provides evidence of the many senior and emeriti faculty who continue active scholarship activities.
