NOTES ON CLOTHING, SAFETY AND SUCH

1. DRESS WARMLY FOR OUTDOOR EVENTS—WEAR SEVERAL LAYERS OF LIGHT CLOTHES (WOOL IF POSSIBLE) WITH BREAKER ON TOP. SHED THE LAYERS ONE AT A TIME AS YOU BEGIN TO PERSPIRE. WEAR MITTENS OR GLOVES (MITTENS ARE BETTER). WEAR BOOTS OR OVERSHOES AND WOOL SOCKS.
2. REPORT ALL ACCIDENTS IMMEDIATELY TO THE FACULTY MEMBER OR STUDENT IN CHARGE. FIRST AID WILL BE AVAILABLE.
3. AT SNOW CREST, PLEASE DO NOT PARK SO AS TO BLOCK THE ROAD. THIS IS A SAFETY MEASURE TO INSURE THE SPEEDY PASSAGE OF AN INJURED PERSON. TOBOGGANS AT SNOW CREST ARE NOT TO BE USED.
4. BE ON TIME!
