

Claudia A. Butts

In March 1992, Claudia R. Butts was appointed Assistant for Congressional Relations at the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). In this position, Mrs. Butts serves as a liaison for the Department of Housing and Urban Development to members of the United States Congress.

Prior to joining HUD, Mrs. Butts was appointed in August, 1991, as Associate Director for Public Liaison at The White House. In this position, she served as the President's liaison to the African-American community and also handled issues relating to African affairs. She was also co-liaison to youth groups, the sports community and liaison to the legal community on ethics issues.

At the White House, she arranged briefings, meetings and policy discussions for constituents, interest groups, and individuals from the general public at large with the President and key White House officials as well as with Cabinet members and agency heads.

Her duties also included arranging White House tours, photo opportunities with the President, and coordinating Rose Garden Ceremonies and receptions for VIP guests and celebrities such as the NBA World Champions Chicago Bulls, the World Series Baseball Champions Minnesota Twins and the United States Olympic athletes.

In addition, she coordinated various Presidential Proclamation Signing and Bill Signing Ceremonies, including ceremonies for the Historically Black Colleges and Universities Week Proclamation; the Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday Proclamation; and, the 1991 Civil Rights Bill Signing Ceremony in the Rose Garden. Mrs. Butts also assisted in the coordination of the National Adoption Week Proclamation Ceremony.

This year Mrs. Butts planned and served as the project officer for "The White House Lecture and Reception for Black History Month." Guest performers were noted actress and educator, Dr. Maya Angelou and Gospel Grammy Award Winner, Shirley Caesar.

Before going to the White House, she was Deputy Director of the New Majority Project of the Heritage Foundation, a Washington-based think tank. In 1989, Mrs. Butts came to Washington, D.C. to work as Associate Director and Legal Counsel for "Save America's Youth" and "Committee For Family America," non-profit youth organizations.

Before going to Washington, D.C., Mrs. Butts practiced law as a general practitioner in Watkins Glen, New York, and worked as the primary Law Guardian for Schuyler County Family Court. She was admitted to the New York Bar on January 14, 1988, in the Fourth Department, Rochester, New York, and admitted to the District of Columbia Bar on December 9, 1991.

From August 1985 through January 1988, she served as a missionary to troubled teenagers at Freedom Village, USA in Lakemont, New York. There she was senior staff and served as a resident dorm counselor and the in-house legal advisor. She was also the content producer of Freedom Village's daily television talk show.

Mrs. Butts is originally from Burlington, North Carolina, and is the fifth of six children born to Rev. and Mrs. Philip J. Woods. She is a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, (B.A., 1982) where she majored in Radio, Television and Motion Pictures. She is a 1985 graduate of North Carolina Central University School of Law in Durham, North Carolina, where she received her Juris Doctorate degree. She also attended Georgetown University School of Law as a visiting student in the spring semester of 1985.

She is married to James A. Butts and both are very active members in the Crossroads Baptist Church of Bailey's Crossroads, Virginia. They reside in Alexandria, Virginia.

Mrs. Butts is frequently asked to speak and has done numerous radio and television talk show interviews, including appearing on NBC Television's "America's Black Forum," The Consumer Business Channel's "The McLaughlin Group," CNN's "Sonya Live," and CBS and Fox Television Networks' evening news. She has been quoted in various national newspapers and publications and was recently spotlighted in "EBONY" magazine in December, 1991, in an article entitled, "The Best Christmas I Ever Had."


