John graduated in 1973, and following this worked as an accountant at Lilydale Adventist Academy. In 1988, John returned to Avondale College to manage the Bookshop.

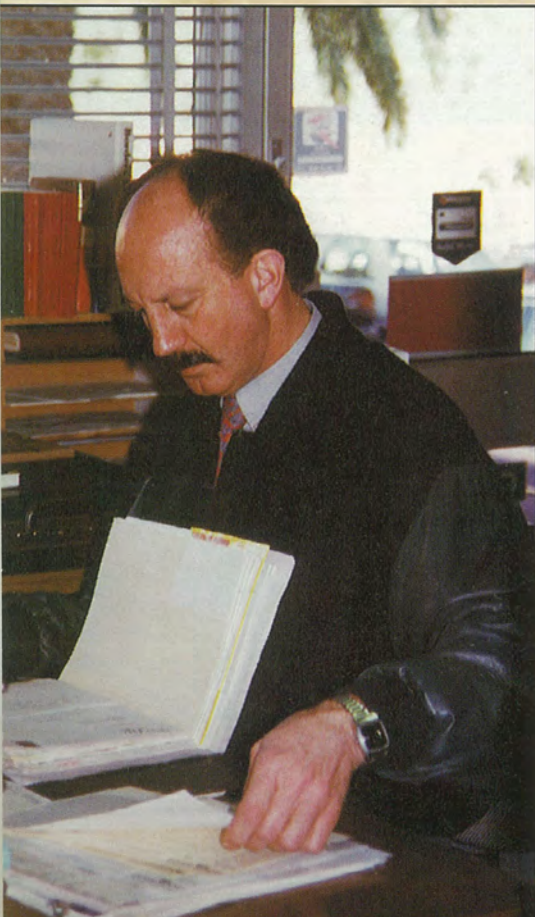

# President's Address

Ernest Boyer in his book, *College: The Undergraduate Experience in America*, poses two questions that should provoke reflection by educational institutions and students alike. These questions are:

- Education for what purpose?
- Competence to what end?

We might well ponder what difference it makes whether a skilled computer programmer, for example, develops a model to design new nuclear weapons or works to design protocols that assist medical treatment. Education can never be value neutral. It is Avondale's privilege to be able to place education and competence in a much wider context.

we conduct a desperate search.

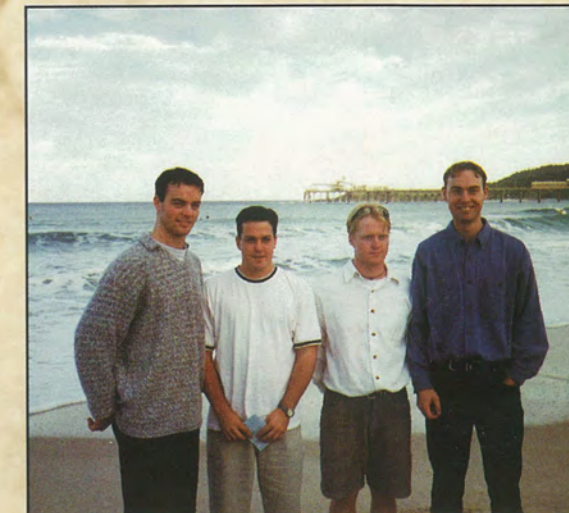
The search is driven by humanness
