I went to the theater the other night and I saw a fellow named Davis (from New Orleans) says that he wrote you. He is "L" Company. I guess you will remember him. I thought that I would write you because I hadn't written to you in such a long time.

I am in a position to see more of the former members of Howard than anyone else and yet most of them all over Italy. Ernest Blache is at: 402 Repl Co, 13 Bn, 24 Replacement Depot, APO 781, c/o PM, N Y, NY. Cason is there also. Of course many of our ^{group are} deceased but the others might be able to carry on. So far as collecting money, and writing letters, and etc, is not convenient to some. However, I am a stenographer in G-1 at the present time. I was in a rifle company but I came back here. I have been working in this office since the last of December. I have seen such notable characters as Clara Booth Luce, Margaret Bourke-White, Lt Gen McNaray, Lt Gen Mark Clark and one or two lesser of notes. Someone of note is always coming here. There was a colored musical group with a Madam Jabore or Yarborough or something like that sang the other night. Do write us whenever you have time. I see Romeo Green and some of the others also most daily since most of the personnel sections are located in the vicinity of our headquarters. I went up to the front last week and stayed a day. Do write. By the way, I saw Charles Daniel the other night. He gave me some "cognac" at the theater. Sincerely,
