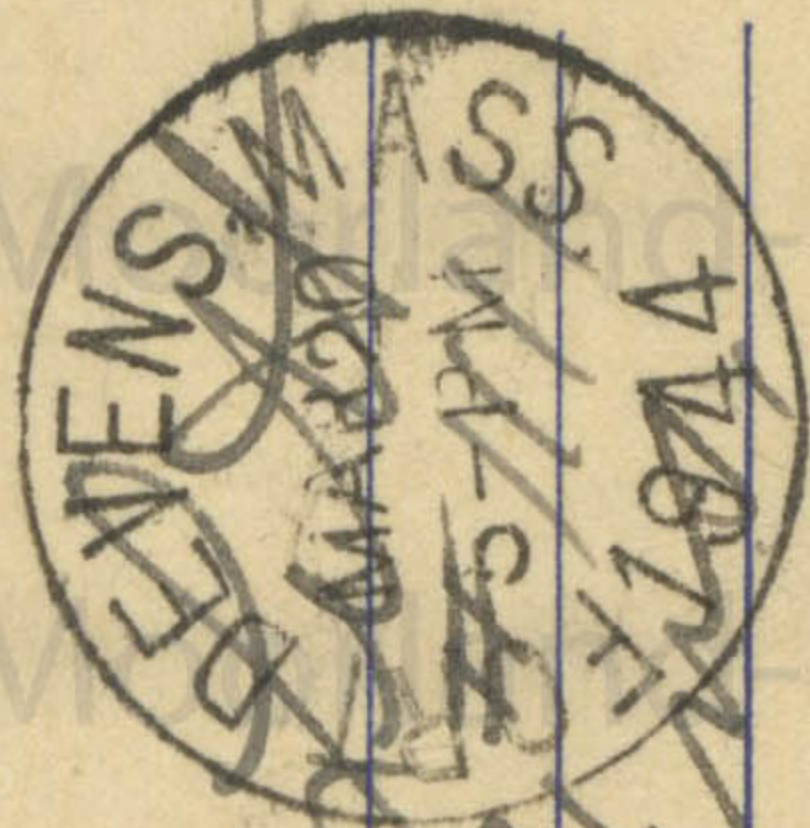
I can assure you I enjoyed it to the utmost & will endeavor to get more boys to read it.

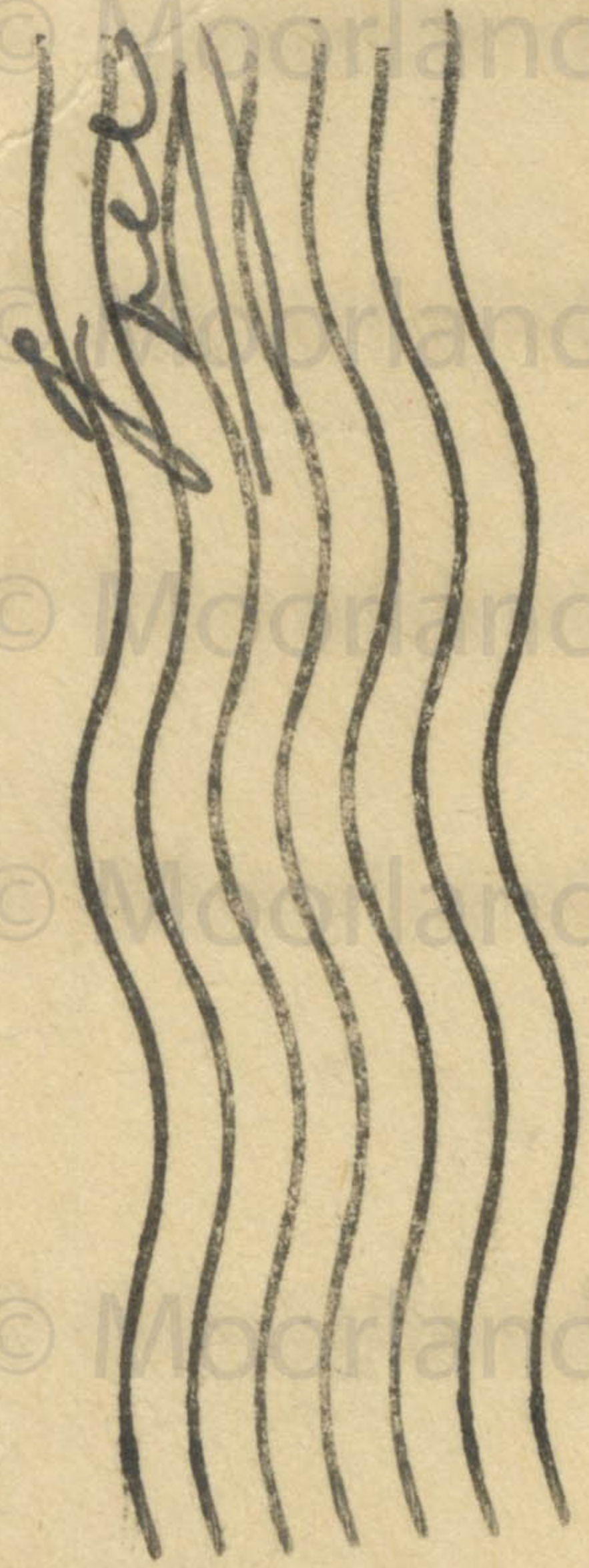
