Dr. Tate:

I returned recently from Italy where I served with other Promethians in the Ninety Second Infantry Division. Although some of the fellows were left behind, fortunately a few are now in the States and discharged. James Tucker, John O. Plummer, Harry D. Hawkins, Gerald S. Hooper, Carlos Allston and Forrest Thomas are some of the former A.S.T.s who have joined the ranks of "freed" men.

It is my intention to return to Howard at the beginning of the Spring Quarter and toward that end I have forwarded an application for admission to the Registrar. It is my hope that crowded conditions do not interfere with the successful outcome of my application. Perhaps you can take steps to insure the acceptance of Promethians who desire to return to Howard University. Such a move would bring a substantial number of the organization together for a considerable length of time which in my opinion would aid its growth toward a more stable group.

Please accept my congratulations for the splendid job that you have done as Co-ordinator of the Promethians. The newsletters were to me a powerful link which kept fellows in the far off places of the globe abreast with the more progressive things on this side.

At present I am still a bit awed at the abrupt change from the military to the civilian way. I suppose the novelty will disappear shortly or sometime in the future since I shall spend the rest of my existence in civilian clothing.

I should be very happy to receive information on current Promethian happenings. In my opinion we have the type of membership capable of fulfilling the loftiest of ideals (with your supervision, of course).

I trust that your holiday period was spent with in happiness and that the new year will bring every thing that is good.
