Philadelphia Oct. 2<sup>d</sup> 1806

The bearer, my dear Henry, is my nephew,  
John Hyde, of whom you were so good as to  
say that you would take charge, for a while  
during his vacation. Let me recommend him to your  
care & that of Mrs. Henry. He will be able  
to remain with you about two weeks, after  
which I wish him to return by Northampton  
Shimfield & Hartford, to New York.

He arrived here yesterday, all in good  
health. Reveling has agreed perfectly well  
with Mrs. Harper, who is now in better health  
than she has been for four years past. We  
and the other ladies join me in affectionate  
remembrance to you & Mrs. Henry
