Interpropositional Relationships

The Translation Department of SIL/WBT has been seeking for some time to develop a precisely-defined list of interpropositional relations for use in preparing semantic propositional displays of New Testament materials. An attempted list of this type was presented in Staff Seminar, along with a set of definitions and examples. The material was very constructively criticized by staff and students and was revised, taking into account also some additional contributions received from John Beekman. The accompanying network diagram is the result of this revision. It is hoped that it will be useful both in furthering discussion on this topic in the Translation Department and also as a guide for those members of SIL interested in investigating this area of meaning in language.
