Preface

This research report was prepared by the National Institute of Multimedia Education (NIME) for the purpose of supplying the findings of the surveys conducted by the 1987 research projects, the Research Team on University of the Air Students (led by representative Masaya Iwanaga) and the Psychological Research Team on the University of the Air Students' Continuation of Studies (led by representative Yusaku Otsuka). (See the preface of Otsuka's report (1988) for the reasons why this research report has been used as data.)

A central component of this research report is the Survey on the Consciousness of University of the Air Students (with thin green cover), conducted in August 1987. The draft plan for this survey was prepared by Otsuka and Iwanaga of the Research Team on University of the Air Students and considered by the following persons: Hidetoshi Kato, Professor at the UA (currently Director of NIME); Morio Shibayama, Associate Professor at NIME (currently information systems specialist at the Office of Information Processing, the Department of Policy, the Education Minister's Secretariat); Chieko Shiozaki, Associate Professor at Shinonome Junior College; Hayato Yamanaka, Assistant professor at NIME; the authors; and other members of the same research team.
