5. We call upon all support organizations and individuals to send letters or telegrams to the White House, supporting our demands for the freedom of Nelson and Winnie Mandela.

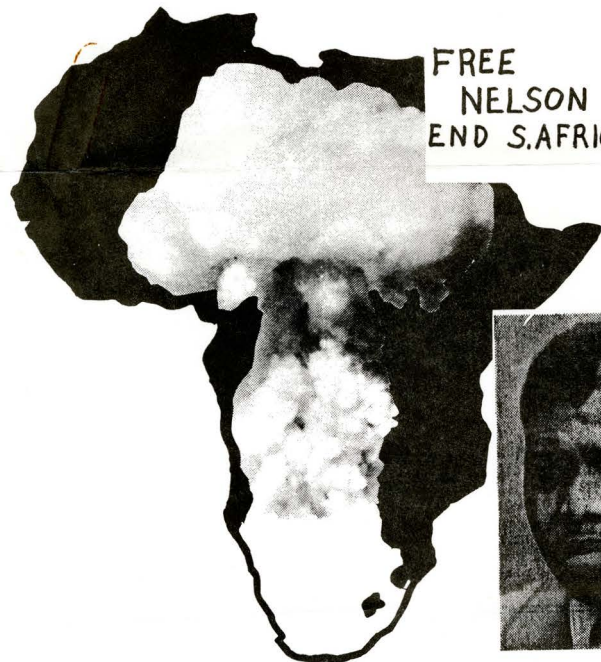
