Morris Campus to Conduct Emergency Training Exercise

University of Minnesota, Morris employees, along with other Stevens County emergency responders, will participate in an emergency training exercise on Thursday, June 29, on campus from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. There will be increased traffic and police activity on and near campus: please know it is just a drill.

This live emergency preparedness exercise will involve UMM units, area law enforcement, Stevens County Emergency Management, EMS, fire departments, University of Minnesota Emergency Management as well as the University of Minnesota Duluth Police Department, Homeland Security, and other emergency response teams in an active threat simulation and response.

This exercise is a part of ongoing efforts to prepare staff and faculty to respond quickly and efficiently in the event of an actual emergency. Participants will gather for discussions on University processes for responding to emergencies on and off campus.
