TODAY IS ~~MONDAY~~ the 31st. I guess I sort of woke up on the wrong side of the bed. We got to the site late because the white Mazda truck was broken. I had trouble setting up the metric square. I opted to do only one side under Pat's advice. I'm struggling to understand what Santiago is saying but he already started digging without a ground survey. I did a slap dash ground survey yesterday with No. Verso Hs. I am not really sure of what I am doing - having had little if none experience with this type of excavation so I am positive that I am missing some of what I would have otherwise found. We have taken the 1 meter square down a little past 10 cm. I have found bits & pieces of Pot sherds - nothing significant so far I have found little & I decided to go down another 10 cm to see if there might be ~~somes~~ a fallen rock. This rock looks wet and does not seem to tie into anything in square 1. I have gone down an average of 20 centimeters. Still no relation with fallen rock but other rocks in no order are surfacing. I believe though that I am in the same level. Level 01 because though I have not taken the datum point yet, I measured from the lowest corner Eastern corner. Tomorrow I will tie together all that was not done.



My Trench runs West about 280° I have decided to take the mound along its longest axis. Today we have begun lot #2. I feeling better about this and not so frustrated. I picked up another worker named Milton he seems very unbothered and knows what he is doing. My trench:



at the beginning of Lot 2 we are approaching what seems to be a layer of rock roughly the same size and positioned in a somewhat systematic position. I might open up square 12 to further investigate. Lot 2 has yielded

N.E. edge pottery fragments and an obsidian blade. I think the of Rock is ~~not~~ stone that I found might be a terrace piece

31.5 cm it is 71.5 cm from my corner. I have indeed decided to open up square 12 to see if the Miles Davis extends out away from the site further. So far I have Lot 1 & 2 Unit 1 and Lot 3 Unit 12.

Lot 3 of Unit 12 has revealed more of the rocks and also a large deposit of Pit Sherdz. They are located along the South wall 13 cm down

We found a small piece of charcoal but Milton said it was too small to be important. Unit 12 Lot 3 has yielded more pot sherds, bajar redware, and obsidian. I plan on exposing unit 12 down to sterile soil. I could not tell if they rocks in unit 12 were fill or tumbler, however some pot sherds exist under a Rock too. They could also be fill or tumbler. Yet I will take this unit down to understand the stratigraphy. As I am going down, I am finding larger pieces of pottery than I have encountered before. We found a, or what looked like a nose to a figurine.

We took lot 4 out in order to understand
& make sense of the rocks we were finding.


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I could not make sense of the rocks in both square 1 and square 12. I have decided that they are more than likely tumble. I wish to understand the stratigraphy so I'm taking them out of Unit 12. Lot 3 from yesterday was 10 cm, Lot 4 was 10-20 cm.

Today I am beginning Lot 5 which will be 20-30 cm. As we have begun to lift the rocks there seems to be a layer of light brownish soil - I don't have a Munsell reading. I have found a line of rocks that seem to be oriented 140° S.E. I am leaving this to test my Miles Davis theory.



I am now beginning to start Lot 6 30-40 cm.
I will now draw what I believe I see. This is not to scale.



My next question is are the dark rocks the wall or are they tumble of the line formed by the white ones. If the dark ones are indeed the Wall, It is not oriented with the way I perceive the site to be oriented.

I am also including in lot 5 a flat rock that seems to have abrasions on one surface. These abrasions have given it a very smooth feel.

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I have decided to go down another 10 centimeters and see if I can learn more about Miles Davis from better understanding the stratigraphic record. We found more beige rechae and a small obsidian blade. The Miles Davis seems to have some flat rocks laying flat under it, though this is not uniform through the whole of what is exposed. We therefore are going to open unit 13 to better understand what was happening in 12.

Again there was no surface artifacts collected. I am taking 13 down with pick 10 cm. This we shall call Lot 8. The Workers blew through lot 8 (0-10 cm) & lot 9 (10-20 cm). Therefore I most likely mistakenly bagged Lot 9 with Lot 8. Both lots only yielded pot sherd's so I think this mistake caused minimal damage but it should be so noted. So far we have only found up pot sherd's. Some Rocks seem to be surfacing near the western ~~side~~ as I had expected.

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
TODAY I am beginning Lot 10 by taking unit 13 down from 20-30 cm. So far it has yielded large pieces of potsherds. About the same size as the respective other lots at 20-30 cm. I believe I have confused my measurements a little; thus Lot 10 will probably end up being 14 cm deep. I have found a little bajar redware, some obsidian ~~some~~ blades & a core & much pottery. This level has revealed a midden of rocks and broken pottery. Still no clue as to where Miles Davis fits in. I found a figurine piece of a nose and a foot/paw. (unrelated). I am finished square/unit 13 for the time being. I have taken it down to 30 cm. I am not quite sure about Miles Davis from the information that 13 yielded. Thus I'm going back to unit 12.

Unit 12

- I plan to take out some of the larger rocks to understand what it is I'm looking at. I'm leaving the three rocks on top of the three flat rocks in the South-Eastern corner. I have taken out one of the large rocks and I shall now look to see what I have.

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When I arrived at my sight a bull had totally trashed my site. He ripped down my strung up Trench Marker. I put these back in the holes as best I could. Today I shall begin with Lot # 11. Thus far it seems that my trench features look like this:



THIS LEVEL HAS YIELDED MANY OBSIDIAN BLADES & MUCH CHARCOAL. IN ACTUALITY MY SQUARE IS ABOUT 57 CM. FROM N-E. CORNER OF UNIT 12.



TODAY WE'RE GOING TO CONTINUE EXCAVATING WEST OVER MY MOUND ALONG THE TRENCH. I BELIEVE YESTERDAY WE EXPOSED ANOTHER LEVEL & WE ARE THUS GOING TO FOLLOW THIS LEVEL INTO UNIT 3 FROM UNIT 2. THIS LEVEL, FROM THE SURFACE TO THE LEVEL AT WHICH JOHN COLTRANE STANDS WE SHALL CALL LOT 13. MILTON FOUND AN OBSIDIAN POINT IN THE SURFACE JUST OFF MY MOUND, I'M INCLUDING IT WITH LOT 13 EVEN THOUGH IT DID NOT COME FROM THERE. THIS LEVEL HAS SO FAR YIELDED MANY SURFACE ROOTS. THIS LEVEL IS NOT YIELDING MUCH POTTERY OR BAJA REQUE. ALTHOUGH THE POTTERY IS MORE SPARSE THE PIECES ARE LARGER.

HAVING JUST TALKED WITH ED, I BELIEVE THAT THERE EXISTS A CHANCE THAT THE PREVIOUSLY DEFINED JOHN COLTRANE IS PREMATURE AND THAT PERHAPS THE WALL EXISTS FURTHER BACK. FIRST I AM GOING TO EXCAVATE DEEPER DOWN THE LEVEL OF UNIT 1 & 2. THIS WILL BE LOT 15 & LOT 16 RESPECTIVELY. MILTON FOUND AN UNFINISHED MATATE IN LOT 16 UNIT 2.

I AM CONTINUING TO EXCAVATE LOT 16 BUT I AM GETTING READY TO MOVE TO LOT 15 OF UNIT 1 AND EXPOSE IT FURTHER. WE ARE NOW BEGINNING LOT 15. LOT 16 ONLY YIELDED A LITTLE POT SHELLS > LESS THAN ANY OTHER LEVEL. WE HAVE UNCOVERED A LITTLE BAJA REQUE & SMALL PIECE ($1\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 CM) OF OBSIDIAN. WE JUST UNCOVERED SOME POTTERY. STILL THIS IS NOT MUCH, I AM INCLUDING THE OBSIDIAN FLAKE IN UNIT 2 LOT 13 THAT MILTON FOUND ON THE GROUND IN WITH THE SMALL OBSIDIAN BLADE FOUND BY MILTON UNIT 2 LOT 16.

I HAVE TAKEN LOT 16 UNIT DOWN TO 50 CM. BELOW THE SURFACE TOP OF THE JOHN COLTRANE EXPOSED. WE DUG DOWN IN UNIT 2 BELOW THE LEVEL OF THE TERRACE IN UNIT ONE. BY DOING THIS WE CAN BETTER SEE THE JOHN COLTRANE. THE JOHN COLTRANE IS 160 CM FROM MY N.E. STAKE IN UNIT 1. I BELIEVE THIS WALL TO BE CLEAR & WELL DEFINED. THUS I HAVE ALSO MADE THE DECISION TO LEAVE LOT 15 OF UNIT 1 UNEXCAVATED.

LOT 15 IS UNEXCAVATED ➤

I SHALL THEN CONTINUE TO EXCAVATE THE TERRACE ASSOCIATED WITH JOHN COLTRANE. THIS LOT IS LOT 14 OF UNIT 3. I BELIEVE WE ARE FINISHED EXCAVATING LOT 13 OF UNIT 2.
POINT OF INTEREST - OFF TO THE N.E. CORNER OF UNIT 2 ARE TWO LARGE REDDISH ROCKS. THEY STAND APART FROM THE OTHER ROCKS, STARKLY. THEY ARE ORIENTED VERTICALLY AND APPARENT BARELY THE SAME SIZE ALTHOUGH THEY DO NOT APPEAR TO BE WT.

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As I spoke of on the previous page the Southern most rock's dimensions are 41 cm x 20 cm wide. The Northern most rock is 41 cm tall too. I am NOT sure what the width is though because it is partly covered by unexcavated earth, but the exposed area which is the majority is about 20 cm wide too! Possible further excavation by opening another 1 x 1 m square unitality could shed more light on this most peculiar find, however for now I shall proceed up the trench and define my terrace levels. I am reopening up lot 14 now in Unit 3.

AFTER LUNCH → I have a splitting headache! We are continuing to excavate lot 14. & expose what believe to be a terrace. We believe we have found a new wall to which I will prescribe the name Paul Desmond.

We found the mouth and eyes of a figurine. We also found a large obsidian blade almost four cm long. Today we are going to finish and sweep up the trench & call it a day. Tomorrow we shall expose Paul Desmond.

WE ARE STILL IN LOT 14 AND WE ARE PUSHING BACK OR EXCAVATION TO FURTHER EXPOSE AND DEFINE PAUL DESMOND. PAUL DESMOND UPON FURTHER EXCAVATION SEEMS TO BE VERY COMPLICATED & PERHAPS IT NEVER EXISTED AT ALL. RATHER A NEW POSSIBLE FEATURE HAS BEEN FOUND TWO WE SHALL REFER TO IT HAS ERIC DOLPHY. 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This page begins after lunch. The PAUL DESMOND feature to which I spoke of last is perhaps still farther back. I am not sure as of now what I'm looking at although I believe to be in the middle of two walls. The South Wall runs parallel with the trench & carries the name Eric Dolphy. The other wall runs parallel with the trench and I shall hence forth refer to it as: CHARLIE PARKER.

We have uncovered a large rock near the beginning of Unit Four. It resembles a stair & is roughly situated between ~~the~~ Eric Dolphy & Charlie Parker. Still no sign of Paul Desmond. I am beginning to wonder if it exists at all. I am beginning lot 18 at the level that large flat rock & surrounding equally level smaller rocks have created. Another large rock exists


The large rock which marks the beginning of what I believe to be stairs is 170 cm from John Coltrane. It stands about 18 cm above the terrace associated with John Coltrane.

LOT 2 13H IS NOW BEGUN 20-40 CM UNIT 1. LOT 1 13H YIELDED SOME BAJA REQUE & SOME POTSHREDS. & SOME OBSIDIAN.

I'm going to take UNIT 1 13G down 20 more cm. This is Lot 3 13G (40-~~50~~ cm). The ground is very hard, thus it is seemingly difficult for Milton to dig through the ground. Yet were still finding OBSIDIAN POTTERY & BAJA REQUE.

Lot 2 13H has so far yielded a large piece of OBSIDIAN ($4 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ cm) & a very large piece of lithic material could be chert. ($4 \frac{1}{2} \times 5$ cm)

In the South West Corner of Unit 1 13H was an area of BUENO earth and Baja Reque. This, however, was only 25 cm below the earth's surface and thus not Culture but rather a burned root.

We are turning up outrageous amounts of small pot shreds. Most of them range from .5 cm - 1.5 cm. I have decided to pull only the ones larger \approx 2-3 cm & Not the others.

THIS WALL LOOKS VERY SIMILAR IN CONSTRUCTION WITH OSCAR PETERSON & I WOULD WITHOUT A DOUBT SAY THEY WERE CONTEMPORARY. THE WALL IS ONE COARSE HIGH & SITS ON A COBBLE FLOOR. THE OUTSIDE FACES 60° N.E. THE BLOCKS USED ARE LARGE & VERY LARGE SIZE ROCKS. SOME SAMPLE SIZES ARE. $(50 \times 38 \text{ cm})$ $(42 \times 34 \text{ cm})$ & $(31 \times 40 \text{ cm})$. THIS WALL RISES & AVERAGE OF 15-18 CM THICK. THE THICKNESS OF THE WALL IS HIDDEN UNDERR UNEXCAVATED EARTH BUT I WOULD GUESSTIMATE THE THICKNESS OF THE WALL TO BE, BETWEEN $(55 \pm 60 \text{ cm})$.

FEATURE #10 [YUSEF LATEEF]

I BELIEVE THAT THE WALL YUSEF LATEEF IS 335 CM LONG & IS ORIENTED 330° N.W. WHILE THIS IS NOT TOTALY EXCAVATED DOWN TO THE BASEL STONES, JUDGING FROM MY CORNER & LARGELY USING MY IMAGINATION TO RECREATE AN ACCURATE PICTURE OF THIS WALL IN ANTIQUITY, I BELIEVE THAT THE WALL WAS 4 COURSES TALL. THIS WALL IS BIASECTED BY WYNTON KELLY & AT THIS INTERSECTION I FOUND 2 CUT BLOCKS RESTING ONE ON TOP OF ANOTHER & ON A ROCK PROTRUDING OUT FARTHER THAN THE 2 CUT BLOCKS.

THE WALL YUSEF LATEEF CORNERS OUT BUT DOES NOT LINE UP VERY WELL WITH WYNTON MACSARL. I THINK THAT YUSEF LATEEF IS A POORLY PRESERVED WALL. IT LOOKS LIKE IT HAS SWUMPED & I THINK THIS HAS BOTH THROWN THE ORIENTATION OFF & CONFUSED THE CORNER. THERE IS ALSO THE POSSIBILITY THAT YUSEF LATEEF IS THE FRONT SIDE OF A LARGER WALL WITH SUN RA CONSTITUTING THE BACK SIDE. THIS THEORY MIGHT STAND UP WITH THE WEIGHT THAT RED GARLAND II HAS SHOWN. IT IS ABOUT 125 CM BETWEEN FRONT OF YUSEF & THE BACK OF SUN RA. AS WYNTON KELLY RUNS WEST & INTERSECTS YUSEF, IT MAKES A REASONABLY NICE CORNER. YUSEF LOOKS IT HAS LARGE ROCKS LAIN ON TOP WITH LARGE ROCKS UNDER IT REPRESENTING WHAT I ASSUME TO BE VARIOUS COURSES HOWEVER DUE TO THE PRESERVATION, I CAN ONLY FOR SURE STATE MEDIUM SIZED ROCKS WHICH ALSO USED IN THIS CONSTRUCTION. YUSEF LATEEF SEEMS TO BE CONSTRUCTED & I AM LOOKING AT A CROSS SECTION AT ITS INTERSECTION (FRONT VIEW) WITH WYNTON KELLY. IT SEEMS THAT THERE WERE SMALL ROCKS BELOW & THEN A LAYER OF LARGE & MEDIUM SIZED ROCKS FOLLOWED BY ANOTHER COURSE OF THE SAME ABOVE THAT & FINALLY WITH LARGE ROCKS ON TOP OF THAT. THIS WALL COULD BE 5 COURSES TALL BUT AGAIN THE PRESERVATION IS VERY POOR, YUSEF STANDS ABOUT 45 CM ABOVE THE LEVEL OF PHIL UPCHURCH TERRACE. CROSS SECTION AT THIS POINT



THIS WALL COULD BE AS TALL AS 6 COURSES.

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FEATURE #11 [SUN RA]

I AM LEANING TO THE NOTION THAT SUN RA IS THE BACKSIDE OF YUSEF'S LARGER WALL. I ALSO BELIEVE THIS WAS A LATER ADDITION BECAUSE IT SEEMS THAT SUN RA RESTS ON AN EARLIER CONSTRUCTION. SUN RA IS 200 cm TO THE CORNER OF THE INSIDE OF WYNTON MARSALIS & 335 cm TO THE END CORNER OF RED GARCIA II. THIS WALL ONLY SEEMS TO BE ONE COURSE THICK. I BELIEVE THIS WALL IS 4 COURSES ABOVE THE PRECADING FOUNDATION. THIS WALL HAS LARGE & MEDIUM RIVER ROCKS ON TOP WITH MEDIUM, SMALL, & SOME LARGE UNDERLAYING MEZ. ON AVERAGE THE WALL IS 30 cm THICK. THERE WAS NOTHING FLAT LAYING IN BETWEEN YUSEF & SUN RA. I RECKON THAT IT WAS PROBABLY FIVE.

FEATURE #12 [WYNTON MARSALIS]

IT IS 272 cm FROM THE EASTERN BEGINNING OF WYNTON MARSALIS; TO THE END OF THE ROCKS THAT LOOK LIKE AN ELEVATED WALL. IT IS 425 cm TO THE FAR WESTERN CORNER OF BRADFORD MARSALIS & 335 cm TO THE POINT WHERE THE EARLY PHASE CONSTRUCTION; WALL WALLACE BOONET FIRST APPEARS. THIS LEAVES A = 63 cm WIDE OPENING THAT EITHER SUGGESTS A DOORWAY OR A FAIRLY PRESERVED SECTION OF THE WALL. I HAVE BEEN CONSIDERING THE POSSIBILITY THAT WYNTON MARSALIS IS THE INSIDE WALL TO A LARGER WALL OF WHICH HERBIE MANCOCK IS THE OUTSIDE WALL. IF SO THEN THIS WALL WOULD BE ABOUT 115 cm WIDE. FAIRLY SUBSTANTIAL





FEATURE # 13 [BRANDFORD MARSALIS]

THE WALL OF BRANDFORD MARSALIS IS EXACTLY 300CM LONG FROM ITS CORNER TO W/WYNTON KELLY) TO WHERE IT SEASOS TO HAVE RAISED COURSES. THIS IS NOT TO SAY THAT PERHAPS THE WALL CONTINUED TO THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STRUCTURE & TIED IN AS AN OUTSIDE WALL. IF THIS BE THE CASE (& I'M NOT SO SURE IT IS THIS WALL WOULD BE 360CM LONG. 



FEATURE # 14 [WYNTON KELLY]

WYNTON KELLY IS A NICELY PRESERVED WALL RUNNING EAST → WEST ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STRUCTURE. IT CORNERS TO THE EAST WITH SUNRA / YUSEF LATEEF & POSSIBLY EXTENDS ALL THE WAY INTO WES MONTGOMERY. TO THE [REDACTED] WEST WYNTON KELLY CORNERS WITH BRADFORD MARSHALLS. WYNTON KELLY IS ⁴⁴⁰ CM FROM THE CORNER OF (INSIDE) BRADFORD TO SUN DA & POSSIBLY 605-610 CM FROM THE CORNER WITH B. MARSHALLS TO THE INTERSECTION WITH WES MONTGOMERY. WYNTON KELLY IS ON AVERAGE 75 CM. THICK. WYNTON KELLY ALSO EXTENDS 535 CM FROM THE CORNER OF B. MARSHALLS TO ^(OUTER) EDGE OF YUSEF LATEEF. I SHALL NOW DRAW A TOP VIEW OF PART OF THE WALL.



THIS IS A CROSS-SECTION OF THE INSIDE OF WYNTON KELLY STANDING ON TOP OF EARLIER WALL CHARLIE CHRISTIAN.



THE SHADED ROCKS DENOTE THE EARLIER CONSTRUCTED WALL CHARLIE CHRISTIAN. THE CLEAR ROCK DENOTE THE LATER CONSTRUCTED WYNTON KELLY.

THE HEIGHT OF THE TOP OF WALL TO WHICH CHARLIE CHRISTIAN BASAL STONES BEGIN IS 75 CM & CHARLIE CHRISTIAN EXTENDS 15 CM BELOW THAT.

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JUDGING FROM A CLEAN TOP VIEW OF THE WALL I BELIEVE THAT WYNTON KELLY IS (3) COUSES WIDE. I ALSO BELIEVE THAT THESE COUSES ARE CHARACTERIZED BY LARGE & MEDIUM RIVER ROCKS.

NEXT WYNTON KELLY APPEARS TO BE (4) COUSES TALL. THIS CROSSSECTION IS THE TALLEST INTACT PORTION OF ANY WALL I HAVE ON MY ENTIRE STRUCTURE. THIS IS CHARACTERIZED BY LARGE, MEDIUM & SMALL RIVER ROCKS. THE LARGER ROCKS SEEM TO BE MORE CONCENTRATED ON THE UPPER LAYERS WHILE MEDIUM ROCKS CONSTITUTE THE MAJORITY OF THE LOWER COUSES & THE SMALL ROCKS ARE STREWN IN BETWEEN NICE FILL. WYNTON KELLY IS ORIENTED 250° S.W. WYNTON KELLY IS INSET 235 CM FROM THE WALL / TERRACE OSCAR PETERSON & A PORTION OF THE WALL (W.K.) IN THE SOUTH WEST CORNER RUNS ONTO THE TERRACE ASSOCIATED WITH DEXTER GORDON & TONY WILLIAMS. WYNTON KELLY STANDS BETWEEN 15-20 CM ABOVE THE SURFACE WHICH IS AT THE SAME LEVEL AS THE TERRACE ASSOCIATED WITH HERBIE MANN.

FEATURE #15 [CHARLIE CHRISTIAN]

CHARLIE CHRISTIAN IS A WALL OF EARLY CONSTRUCTION FOR THIS STRUCTURE. IT UNDERLAYS WYNTON KELLY, BUT IT SEEMS TO BE ORIENTED SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT. ITS ORIENTATION IS 240° S.W. THE BASAL STONES OF CHARLIE CHRISTIAN SEEM TO BE THE ONLY STONES OF THIS CONSTRUCTION LEFT. I BELIEVE THAT TO THE EAST CHARLIE CHRISTIAN CORNERS WITH A previous WALL CONSTRUCTION UNDER SUN RA. & TO THE WEST I BELIEVE CHARLIE CHRISTIAN CORNERS WITH THE PREVIOUSLY UNSTRUCTURED WALL WALLACE ROONEY. THESE I BELIEVE ARE MY FIRST PHASE ARCHITECTURE DEM. THIS THE BASAL STONES ARE MEDIUM-LARGE RIVER ROCKS THIS WALL BEGINS AT 85 CM. BELOW THE SURFACE & REMAINS ONLY 15 CM DEEP. THIS WALL HAS A VERY CLEAR LINE TO IT.

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I CAN NOT QUITE DETERMINE HOW WIDE CHARLIE CHRISTIAN BUT BECAUSE I DID NOT PICK IT UP ON THE OTHER SIDE OF WYNTON KELLY I ASSUME THAT IT IS NO GREATER THAN 80 CM, BUT I CONCLUDE THAT IT IS PROBABLY THE SAME WIDTH OR SMALLER (SLIGHTLY) AS WYNTON KELLY. THIS WOULD PLACE THE WIDTH OF CHARLIE CHRISTIAN AT ABOUT 75 CM WIDE. I CANNOT GIVE AN EXACT MEASUREMENT (LENGTH) FOR CHARLIE CHRISTIAN BECAUSE I CANNOT SEE WHERE IT CORNERS ON BOTH SIDES BUT I GUESS THAT THIS IS PROBABLY WITHIN 5 OR 10 CM THAT IT IS 355 CM LONG.

FEATURE # 16 [WALLACE ROONEY]

WALLACE ROONEY, I BELIEVE IS CONTEMPORARY WITH CHARLIE CHRISTIAN. THE BASAL STONES CLOSELY RESEMBLE THE BASAL STONES OF CHARLIE CHRISTIAN. AGAIN I CANNOT DETERMINE HOW WIDE THIS EARLY WALL NOR CAN I ACCURATELY DETERMINE HOW LONG IT WAS. I BELIEVE THAT IS WAS PROBABLY ABOUT 210 CM LONG. I KNOW THAT WALLACE ROONEY CORNERS AT THE SOUTH WITH CHARLIE CHRISTIAN BUT I AM NOT SURE WHAT IT DOES IN THE NORTH. THERE ARE A COUPLE OF POSSIBILITIES: (1) IT CORNERS & CONNECTS WITH AN EARLY CONSTRUCTION UNDER █████ WYNTON MARSHALIS OR (2) IT CONTINUES ON, MAKING IT 3 M LONG & CONNECTS WITH HERBIE HANCOCK WHO PROBABLY IS CONTEMPORARY WITH WALLACE ROONEY OR (3) IT ENDS AS (1) SUGGESTED BUT DOES NOT CORNER INSTEAD IT LEAVES ROOM FOR A DOORWAY & THEN PICKS THE LINE UP UNDER WYNTON MARSHALIS.

FEATURE # 17 [DEXTER GORDON]

DEXTER GORDON IS THE EASTERN (WALL COMPIMENT) TO TONY WILLIAMS. WILLIAMS & GORDON ARE PARALLEL & INCLUDE A SMALL TERRACE.

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
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Dexter Gordon extends well into an unexcavated area, but I think it shall be the same length as Tony Williams. I believe that this terrace could have served as an entrance & welcoming point for this structure because of the raised sidewalk yet once than the step on the edge of the Herbie Mann terrace, I do not see another entrance way or doorway into the main room. The terrace, however, is 230cm wide. This terrace rises 20cm of the dirt terrace of Oscar Peterson. I believe that Gordon is almost as long as Williams, they both probably stop in line (along south side of structure) Gordon is probably, 135cm long. This terrace is an earthen terrace with a piece of shist & with small medium & very small rocks constituting the floor.

FEATURE # 18 [DUKE ELLINGTON]

I believe that Duke Ellington is associated with the final third phase of occupation & architectural change. Duke Ellington is a floating feature. That is I cannot tie it to any other feature on my structure. I however believe it could be contemporaneous with my burial. Duke Ellington stands 42-45 cm above the second phase living floor. This is the floor my burial was laid into. Duke Ellington is (90 x 95 x 90 x 95) cm square.



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FEATURE # 19 [Max Ranch]

Max Ranch is a cobble floor that extends east in front of the structure. The floor itself is comprised of medium to small river cobbles. The wall extends along from the North East Corner of the structure to the South East Corner of the structure. This makes the floor approx 750 cm long. The floor is also an average of 110 cm wide. The wall Miles Davis seems to be resting on top of this floor. I cannot say however exactly how wide the floor is because it becomes progressively wider at the South Eastern End. I believe that this ~~floor~~ is oriented at about 325° N.W. The River Rock for the most part seen to be about the same size. Some sample sizes are: (13x14)(12x10)(13x21)(14x18)(13x18)

FEATURE # 20 [Miles Davis]

I am not very sure what this feature is. It is oriented at 325° N.W.; so about the same orientation as the floor. I believe, however that the floor was in an early construction & MILES DAVIS way of a late construction. This wall is both poorly constructed, & poorly preserved. It is about 60cm wide in most places. I am unsure of how long it is. As it stands now it is cm long from the point where I stopped digging it out to where it runs into my unexcavated area. The wall seems to have slumped east, for on the eastern side I can make out 3 cut blocks. One is ($45 \times 25 \times 9$) the others are 60 & 30cm long respectively. There are two large pieces of shirt & a smaller one standing vertical on the western side, other than that no cohesion exists.



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

FINAL COMMENTARY

Despite the many puzzles structure 55 of 13 put forth for me to arrange & then solve, I can generally conclude a number of things. I believe foremost that my structure was a domestic structure for a family of not poor but not very affluent wealth. I believe that I have found three different architectural phases. & I think there is reason to believe that this coincides with possibly 3 different ^{EAST} EDAS of occupation. I believe the front of the structure was the ~~██████████~~ (primary) & south secondary. My reason. The eastern side has the stone floor. & the south has a cobble sidewalk leading probably though under excavated soil to Op 19. I believe that slight obsidian manufacturing was occurring between Tom Williams & Dexter Gordon Wall in the South-West Terrace. I also believe that my structure is contemporaneous with Janne Wendt's structure also in Op 13 & John Dietlers structure. Construction is very similar & preservation is about the same. Last and of equal importance. I believe my burial ["Ida" as I refer to it in my notes.] is associated with what I perceive to be the third & final phase of occupation. This burial was buried under a floor & I believe is contemporary with the construction of the floating surface Duke Ellington. I also believe "in a very amateur opinion" that Ida is around twenty years old.





I WENT IN WITH A HYPOTHESIS THAT A CHANGE IN POLITICAL OR RELIGIOUS FOCUS UPROOTED THE SITE CORE & STARTED A NEW OR SEPARATE CORE NORTH EAST OF THE OLD ONE. THE FOLLOWING STRUCTURES I BELIEVE ARE PART OF THIS NEW SITE CORE; IA-49, IA-48, IA-47, IA-46, IA-40, IA-42, IA-43, IA-44, IA-45 & possibly IA-19 & IA-~~34~~³. DUE TO THE CONVINCING CENTRALITY OF LA SIERA'S ORIGINAL SITE CORE, I ASSUMED THAT THIS WOULD BE A NEW SITE CORE, ACTUALLY IT MAKES SENSE THAT IT WOULD BE BUILT ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF THE OLD ONE. THIS QUESTION, HOWEVER, REMAINS TO BE INVESTIGATED FURTHER.

I CHOOSE IA-48 FROM ALL THESE STRUCTURES FOR A NUMBER OF REASONS. IT WAS SMALL AND THUS WORKABLE WITH THE SHORT AMOUNT OF TIME I HAD. ZNO, IT WAS LOCATED ON THE SOUTHERN OUTSKIRTS "OF NEW SITE CORE". I THOUGHT THIS LOCATION OF THIS STRUCTURE MIGHT MAKE THE STRUCTURE HAVE BEEN A TRANSITION POINT FOR THE NEW FROM THE OLD. THIRDLY, THIS STRUCTURE ON THE SURFACE, SEEMED TO BE VERY WELL PRESERVED. I COULD DISTINGUISH MANY LINES & THIS LED ME TO BELIEVE THE ARCHITECTURE WAS VIRTUALLY INTACT. LASTLY I CHOOSE THIS MOUND BECAUSE IT WAS ATTACHED TO A LARGE MOUND & I KNEW IN EXCAVATION PAST, MANY ARTIFACTS HAVE BEEN FOUND ON THE "SADDLE" BETWEEN TWO MONUMENTS. THIS I THOUGHT THIS LOCATION WOULD GIVE ME EXCELLENTLY PRESERVED ARCHITECTURE & A WIDE ARSENALAGE OF ARTIFACTS.

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I BEGAN TO DIG THE STRUCTURE. THE SURFACE FEATURES MATCHED UP WITH WALLS ETC. THE PRESERVATION WASN'T EXCELLENT BUT IT WAS ABOVE AVERAGE IN MANY PARTS. I BELIEVE AT ONE TIME TREES HAD TO HAVE COVERED THIS MOUND BECAUSE THERE SEEMS TO BE HEAVY ROOT ACTION & DESTRUCTION ESPECIALLY ON THE EDGES OF THE STRUCTURE. PRESERVATION BECOMES BETTER CLOSE TO THE CENTER.

I HAD TO CHANGE DATUM MIDWAY THROUGH BECAUSE I DID NOT HAVE A LONG ENOUGH STICK. BUT I KEPT WITH A CENTERLY LOCATED DATUM PLATE THROUGHOUT MY FINAL NOTES. I HAD TO SET 2 OTHER DATUM IN ORDER TO REACH FEATURES ON THE SOUTH END OF "POSSIBLE BALL COURT". I HAD PROBLEMS SETTING THIS BUT I BELIEVE I FINALLY GOT IT BECAUSE I CHECKED OUT WHEN I CROSS REFERENCED.

FEATURE: SUNNY DAY SKIES #1

"Sunny Day Skies" is a wall located dividing the North & South half of the structure. This wall is about in the middle of the structure & runs East → West at 275° N.W. This is a fairly substantial wall that could be seen poking through the surface: I believe that to the East it corners around the wall, "STAMMI" & to the West it ends as a door jam, "THE VIBRATION OF MICHT". Overall, this wall is 735 cm long. It seems four courses high & is composed out mainly of small, medium, large & a few very large river cobbles. There are a few cut blocks, but we find them as an eastern corner, on the top course near the middle, & even as ~~a~~ part (ix) in the third course from the top. The cut blocks sizes → A sample: (31cm length × 10cm high) (30×22×10) (25cm × 12cm). This wall seems to be about 60cm tall & sits on a layer of sand: Excavation limits: [] Surface - 60cm Deep; wall 60-80cm → 60 + 85cm → Sand to level where I stopped excavation. The wall is an average of 70-75cm thick. "Sunny Day Skies" seem to be built over "STAMATTI" & possibly though I think it corners, "SWAMI" & to the north it runs over "ST. FRANCIS DE MON TEMPS". Cut blocks do seem to be part of construction & are also found on the south west corner. I exposed the entire north side, but only about 335cm along the south side. I believe this is very late construction & could have been built to replace well as a divisor of space.

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FEATURE #2 : STAMATTI

I DID NOT HAVE A CHANCE TO FULLY EXPOSE STAMATTI. I EXPOSED A LITTLE UNDER 100 CM OF IT. IT CORNERS WITH "OUT OF LOVE FOR COCKWOOD" & THEN RUNS SOUTH UNDER "SUNNY DAY SKIES". I BELIEVE THIS WALL IS CONTEMPORARY WITH: OUT OF LOVE FOR COCKWOOD, HAULT, ST. FRANCES DE MINTAUMPE & POSSIBLY THOUGH I'M NOT SURE IT IS AT LEAST ASSOCIATED WITH "WELL". OF WHAT I EXPOSED "STAMATTI" SEEMS TO BE TWO COVES TALL & THREE COVES WIDE, THOUGH IT COULD POSSIBLY BE JUST TWO. IT IS CHARACTERIZED BY MEDIUM TO LARGE RIVER COBBLES. THIS WALL SEEMED TO HAVE BEEN FILLED IN WITH A LAYER OF SAND. IT COULD HAVE BEEN ABANDONED DURING AN ENLARGEMENT PHASE FOR THE "SWAMI". ITS ORIENTATION IS ABOUT 20° N.E. AGAIN NOT VERY MUCH OF THIS WALL IS EXPOSED SO I COULD BE OFF.
I THINK THIS WALL IS ABOUT 70 CM THICK.

FEATURE #3: OUT OF LOVE FOR COCKWOOD.

I BELIEVE THAT I HAVE MOST OF THIS WALL EXPOSED, TOTAL LENGTH IS 1/2 METER WIDTH. THIS WALL IS 4 METER LONG AND RUNS AT AN ORIENTATION OF 280° N.W. THIS WALL WAS ALSO UNDER A LAYER OF SAND & CORNER WITH "STAMATTI" IN THE EAST & "ST. FRANCES DE MINTAUMPE" IN THE WEST. THIS WALL IS ABOUT 70-78 CM THICK & COMPOSED OF 3 COVES THICK & AT LEAST 3 COVES TALL. THESE ARE MADE UP WITH MEDIUM TO LARGE RIVER COBBLES WITH A VERY FEW VERY LARGE AS A CORNER OR SUCH. THIS RUNS ALMOST PARALLEL WITH "SUNNY DAY SKIES" & "HAULT" & "WELL". S.W. CORNER 120 CM AWAY FROM "S.D.S." & SOUTH EAST CORNER IS 70 CM AWAY.

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FEATURE #4: VIBRATION OF NICHE

THIS FEATURE IS MY DOORWAY. THE DOOR WAY IS CREATED FROM THE EDGE OF "SUNNY DAY SKIES" (N/Verstein) & "FUNKY OLD GOOD KING RA". THIS DOORWAY LINKS THE NORTH & SOUTH DIVIDED SPACES. THIS DOORWAY IS ROUGHLY 75 CM LONG & 60 CM WIDE. PART OF THE DOOR JAM IS CUT BLOCK & THE OTHER PART IS A VERY LARGE RIVER ROCK. THE OTHER SIDE OF DOOR WAY IS THE FUNKY OLD GOOD KING RA. THIS LOOKS THREE COVES TALL & MADE UP OF MEDIUM TO LARGE RIVER COBBLES. A COBBLE FLOOR EXISTS IN THIS DOORWAY → SMALL - MEDIUM SIZE RIVER COBBLE.

#5 FEATURE: ST. FRANCIS DE MONTEUMPE

"ST FRANCIS DE MONTEUMPE" IS ABOUT 420 CM HIGH & I BELIEVE ORIGINALLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE SAME PHASE OF OCCUPATION AS "STAMATTI", "OUT OF LOVE FOR COCKWOOD" & "HAWK". I SHALL DIVIDE "ST. FRANCIS DE MONTEUMPE" INTO NORTH & SOUTH TO DISCUSS THIS WALL. NORTH & SMALL ARE PARTITIONED BY "SUNNY DAY SKIES". FIRST NORTH. 115 CM FROM CORNER OF "OUT OF LOVE FOR COCKWOOD" → "SUNNY DAY SKIES" APPEARS TO RUN UNDER "SUNNY DAY SKIES". ONLY TWO COURSES ARE VERY DISTINGUISHABLE. THESE ARE MEDIUM TO LARGE RIVER ROCKS. MOST OF THIS WALL WAS BURIED IN SAND. A PLATFORM OR FLOOR IS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS AND EXTENDS WESTWARD FROM THE WALL. I CANNOT TELL HOW MANY COURSES THICK. ORIENTATION ABOUT 110° N.E.

CONT'D: ST. FRANCES DE MON TRUMPE

I believe that the South side of this Wall has had a later addition. I believe the original levee was three courses tall of medium to large river rocks. This would be about to the same level as "North Trumpe" & "Hault". Then another five courses were added similar medium to large river cobbles. It was at this time I believe the filled the structure with sand & added the dividing wall, "Well". This South Trumpe is about 85cm - 90cm tall above base of excavation. It courses with Hault to the South. Bottom half is contemporary with "Hault" "Out of Love for Cockwood", "Stamati". This Wall is oriented at 08° N.E. & a platform extends westward from the level of the second course from the top. Top of ■ South Trumpe is probably associated with "Well" and then "Sunny Day Skies." This section is 200cm long.

FEATURE #6: Wall

This is a very ugly wall probably used just to divide space. It is 230 cm from edge of Out of love for Cockwood to Well & about 115 cm away from "Hault". This Wall seems to be about two courses day & one thick. It does not look to have been built very well & I believe came before "Sunny Day Skies" although they probably had the same function. I exposed part of this wall: 220 cm long: East to West. "Well" seems to have been built a 55 cm South of "Sunny Day Skies" & parallel. This wall was built on top of Sand & buried under Sand. Orientation 280° N.W. Rocks are of medium thickness.

FEATURE # 7 HAULT

I believe Hault to be contemporaneous with "Stamatti", "out or σ coe." & "St. Francis de Montenipe" HAULT is now two courses ~~high~~, but I think it could have been as many as three or four. Hault is 4 courses thick and composed of large, roughly same size river cobbles. thickness 111 cm. height: 40cm above base of excavation. Hault extends into the limits of my excavation but I would assume it connects with "Stamatti" though I cannot see their intersection. I would also assume that "Hault" is parallel to "Out of Love-for Coconino". 230 cm from limits of excavation to course with "St. Francis de Mon Temp". I believe "Hault" possibly extends further maybe even to another course associated with platform. I also believe that Hault at one time had a layer of cut blocks as the front. ORIENTATION: 270° W

FEATURE # 8 OH CAPARNOH

OH Caparnoh is a cut block wall that is 950 cm Long. This is a fairly late addition to the structure. The cutblocks were probably re-used from structures in the old site core. OH Caparnoh extends along the South side of Structure facing Ball Courts and while very pretty root & tree action has severely affected the orientation of cut blocks & preservation. I believe this wall is oriented at 280° N.W. This wall is one course thick & lays on top of a layer^{or two.} of medium to large river cobbles. Some Doggs & Blue Cloud run under the construction of this wall & "Caparnoh" connects with "Blue Serpent" In the West. Some measurements on the cut blocks: (40x24x10) (50x10x10) (33x32x10)

CONTD #8 ON CAPAENOH

"Soul Lotus" EXTENDS Directly Behind Hall "Capaenoh" I believe I accidentally stepped through Soul lotus. Not all though in my aerial. Soul lotus & Capaenoh create a step effect. Capaenoh open towards the large wall in space, maybe practice ball court. I believe this was filled in to some extent before construction of "Oh Capaenoh" because Capaenoh does not extend near the level that Space Doggy & what I assume Blue Cloud do.

FEATURE #9 SOUL LOTUS

"Soul Lotus" is oriented the same as Oh Capaenoh : 280° N.W. Soul Lotus is 980cm Long and stands on average of 30cm above "Oh Capaenoh". "Soul Lotus" is also a cut block wall/step. The cut blocks are just like Capaenoh's. Volcanic Tuft Varying in size from $(60 \times 40 \times 10)$ to $(31 \times 16 \times 10\text{ cm})$. "Soul lotus" is two courses tall & appears to stand on top of another layer of cut block. My best preserved section is the South West corner. There, the blocks do not look very disturbed.

FEATURE # 10 BLUE SERMON

BLUE SERMON CORNER WITH OH CAPACNOH & HOROS SOUTH.
BLUE SERMON SEEMS TO BE A WALL ABOUT THREE COURSES THICK.
THE EASTEN MOST COARSE, FRONT. IS CUT BLOCK & THIS MAKES A
PECCY COARSE WITH CAPACNOH. THERE IS AN UNDETERMINABLE MIDDLE
COARSE OF MEDIUM RIVER ROCKS, NO DISTINCT PATTERN. THE
BACK SIDE SEPARATES THE WALL FROM THE PLASTER SURFACE "CROSSBLOCK"
& LINES UP WITH THE LINE TO THE SOUTH; "GODS SAID NEPTALI" &
TO THE NORTH; "EL BANCHO. THIS WALL HELPS TO FURNALLY
DEFINE THE SOUTHERN PERIMETER OF THE PLASTER SURFACE.
THIS WALL IS ORIENTED: 353° N.W. THIS WALL CINTINS BEYOND
THE LIMITS OF EXCAVATION BUT FUR WHAT I UNCOVERED IT IS
160cm LONG FROM JUNCTION WITH OH CAPACNOH & 110cm WIDE.
THIS WALL FACES AGAINST THE BACK OF SPACE DOQQY. IT SEEM TO BE
ABOUT 15cm OR 1 COARSE ABOVE THE LEVEL OF THE TOP OF
"SPACE DOQQY". "SPACE DOQQY" TO "BLUE SERMON" IS ABOUT 110cm
APART & FILLED WITH SMALL ROCKS. I'M NOT SURE ABOUT THE
RELATION. I BELIEVE BLUE SERMON IS RELATED TO THE LARGER
STRUCTURE ATTACHED TO THIS ONE. A QUASI STEP / TERRACE EXISTS
ABOVE THE LEVEL OF THE FRONT CUT BLOCKS JUST THREE CUT BLOCKS.

FEATURE # 11 PANTECA.

THIS FURNALLY DEFINES THE EDGE OF THE PLASTER SURFACE.
ORIENTATION 280° W. I BELIEVE THIS EXTENDS TO LARGER STRUCTURE
WESTWARD. I ONLY EXCAVATED ABOUT 70CM ALONG THIS CUT BLOCK
WALL. THIS WALL DROPS 30cm TO THE LEVEL OF THE "GODS SAID
NEPTALI". TWO COARSE HIGH: CUT BLOCK WITH MEDIUM-LARGE ROCKS
BELOW. MOVING NORTH: front cut block. 1 coarse small-medium rocks
another coarse very small-small rocks, then PLASTER SURFACE.

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FEATURE # 12 & IDA LAID DOWN

This is the outer wall / terrace on the Northern side. I exposed ONE OF THE CORNERS. I ONLY EXPOSED 390 CM OF THIS WALL. THE PRESERVATION IS NOT THE BEST BUT I HAVE A general IDEA of what this wall USED TO LOOK LIKE. THE NORTH WEST CORNER IS CREATED FROM TWO CUT BLOCKS. I BELIEVE THIS WALL USED TO BE FOUR COURSES TALL though only THREE ARE STILL PRESENT. FROM BOTTOM TO TOP: THIS WALL SITS ON A COARSE OF MEDIUM TO LARGE RIVER COBBLES. THOUGH THE SAME COARSE IS REPRESENTED IN ANOTHER SECTION OF THE WALL WITH JUST MEDIUM & SMALL COBBLES. THEN A COARSE MUCH LIKE THE SAME LIES ON THIS. ON TOP OF THIS ARE LARGE TO VERY LARGE RIVER COBBLES. I believe that this had another course of cut block DUE TO THE ABSENCE OF CUT BLOCK AS TUMBLE. I BELIEVE THAT "A WEE OFF" IS THE BACKSIDE TO THIS WALL. I BELIEVE IT IS TWO COURSES THICK OF MEDIUM ROCKS w/ small rock fill BUT THIS IS NOT ABSOLUTELY CLEAR. THIS WALL IS ABOUT 100CM THICK.

ORIENTATION: 270° N.W. THIS WALL CORNERS WITH "A WE LOVE YOU MIGHTY GOOD" & INSIDE CORNER "FUNKY OLD GOOD KING RA". I'M NOT SURE WHAT PHASE I'M SEEING ARCHITECTURALLY.

FEATURE # 13 "A WEE OFF"

I believe, "A WEE OFF" is the inside of "A Ida laid down". This corners with "FUNKY OLD GOOD KING RA" (N.W.) Wall extends into limits of excavation. These blocks in the line are smaller than "A Ida laid Down"; MEDIUM TO LARGE. FLAT FACES ARE TO THE INSIDE OF THE ROOM. ORIENTATION: 272° N.W. THERE IS A BUNCH OF TUMBLE EITHER WITH THE PLATFORM OR THE WALL. ORIENTATION OF TUMBLE ≈ 250° N.W. DONT KNOW HOW MANY COURSES TALL.

FEATURE # 14 & WE LOVE YOU MIGHTY GOOD

THIS WALL CORNERS WITH "¶ I DA HAD DOWN. AGAIN THIS WALL IS NOT VERY WELL PRESERVED. I EXPOSED 265 CM OF THIS. IT LIES INSIDE LIMITS OF EXCAVATION. THIS SECTION IS HORRIBLY PRESERVED. EVEN WORSE THAN "¶ Ida had Down." THEY HAVE EXACTLY THE SAME CONSTRUCTION. THERE IS A CHANCE THAT THIS WALL CORNERS IN THE NEXT METRE SOUTH. THIS WALL MIGHT USE PART OF "FUNKY OLD GOOD KING RA" AS ITS BACK. THIS WALL IS SO BADLY PRESERVED, I'M NOT SURE WHAT IS GOING ON. I CANNOT TELL IF THE ROCKS IN BETWEEN 2 WALLS ARE TUMBLE OR FILL. "F.O.G.K.RA" STANDS MUCH TALLER, ≈ 40CM ABOVE THE LEVEL OF THIS WALL, BUT "F.O.G.K.RA" IS BETTER PRESERVED & GOOD THUS EXPLAIN THIS BUT I'M NOT QUOT TO JUMP THIS THEORY. LARGE & VERY LARGE ROCKS. TOP COURSES, ORIENTATION 06° N.E.

FEATURE # 15 FUNKY OLD GOOD KING RA

THIS WALL CORNERS IN THE NORTH WITH "¶ WERE OFF" IN THE SOUTH IT ENDS NEAR THE VIBRATION OF MICTE. WHERE IT OPENS FOR AN ENTRANCE FOR CLASSROOMS. THIS WALL IS EITHER 440 CM LONG OR 530 CM. I'M NOT SURE EXACTLY WHERE IT CORNERS. ¶ IF WHAT I BELIEVE TO BE A LINE, IS ACTUALLY ONLY TUMBLE. THIS WALL APPEARS TO BE 3 COURSES TALL OF RIVER COBBLES (MEDIUM - LARGE) & A FEW SCATTERED WT BLOCKS. WT BLOCKS SCATTERED THROUGHOUT ENTIRE CONSTRUCTION. THIS WALL MIGHT BE CONTEMPORARY WITH SUNNY DAY SKIES, THOUGH I'M NOT POSITIVE. THE ORIENTATION OF THIS WALL IS: 22° N.E. I'M NOT SURE OF THE COURSE THICKNESS BECAUSE OF ITS ILL PRESERVATION. THIS COULD BE THE INSIDE OF "¶ We love you mighty good". "ST. FRANCIS DE M M TRUMPF" & "F.O.G.K.RA" SET THE PARAMETERS EAST & WEST FOR STONE PLATFORM, "STANFORD PEIRSON EXPERIMENT!"

FEATURE # 16 HOOTENANNY

THIS IS A SMALL RUNNING EAST → WEST AT: 270°W. I BELIEVE THIS USED TO BE THE RETAINING WALL FLOOR THE PLASTER FLOOR; NO LONGER THERE & IS THE RETAINING WALL TO THE OTHER COBBLE FLOOR, "CROSSROADS REPRISE". I EXPOSED 130cm OF THIS WALL. 30cm TALL. MAYBE 3 COURSES TALL OF MEDIUM SIZED RIVER COBBLER. I ASSUME THIS WALL ATTACHES TO THE LARGER STRUCTURE ATTACHED TO THIS ONE.

FEATURE # 17 STANFORD PRISON EXPERIMENT

THIS FEATURE IS A COBBLE FLOOR WHICH EXTENDS BACK FROM ITS RETAINING WALL, "HOOTENANNY" TO THE PLASTER SURFACE "CEASEROS". THIS WALL EXTENDS UP TO THE WALL, "& WE LOVE YOU VERY MUCH". THE FLOOR IS CHARACTERIZED BY PACKED EARTH & SMALL → MEDIUM SIZE COBBLES W/ FLAT FACES UP. BITS & PIECES OF PLASTER PEEK THROUGH LIMITS OF EXCAVATION. NO EXACT JUNCTION BETWEEN COBBLE & PLASTER CAN BE SEEN.

FEATURE # 18 SINAMI

I BELIEVE THIS FEATURE IS A WALL CONTEMPORARY WITH "E IDA LAID DOWN" & POSSIBLY EVEN WITH OH CAPARESH THOUGH I'M NOT SURE IF IT DOES indeed. I BELIEVE IT COVERS WITH OH CAPARESH IN THE SOUTH. I'M NOT SURE WHAT IT DOES IN THE NORTH. I COULD COVER WITH "E IDA LAID DOWN" BUT I HAVE CLAY HERE SO I'M NOT SURE WHAT THE ARCHITECTURE IS like. THIS WALL APPEARS TO BE 4 COURSES THICK OF RIVER COBBLES LARGE - VERY LARGE = OUTSIDE COVERS - 3 INSIDE COVERS = MEDIUM - LARGE - KEE COBBLES. HEAVY DISTURBANCE BY ROOT ACTION. 3 COURSES DEEP. TOP COURSE LARGE - VERY LARGE. LARGE ROCKS = SECOND COURSE. 3RD COURSE = 20cm OF SMALL ROCKS & PACKED EARTH. 60cm TALL.

FEATURES: SPACE DOGHT.

I shall first describe how deep I discovered Space Doght to be when I found it in 29H-21; v2. Today I'm taking the notes even though I'm not finished my excavations of the Wall. I took the wall down past its base. I believe that the wall begins about 5 cm below the surface & continues to about 110 cm below the surface. The excavation continues to 160 cm below the surface. During excavation we encountered 5 distinct soil horizons B: dark brown, soft, moderately fine, soil with some roots included. C: red brown, fine, hard clay - most of the wall is packed in it. D: tan, coarse, loose-compacted sand. E: very fine, soft, highly micaceous soil. F: very fine, hard, micaceous soil. These are given in descending order, beginning with the soil in the wall. The wall itself is characterized by

VEERY SMALL: 0-5mm
SMALL: 5-10cm
MEDIUM: 10-20cm
LARGE: 20-30cm
VEERY LARGE: 30-40cm
EXTRA LARGE: 40- cm

large river cobbles on the top coarse, with a coarse of medium river cobbles underlying with very small - small river cobbles filled in between. Then another coarse of medium to large river cobbles with small - very small fill. This is the pattern & it continues this way for all 6 courses of the structure, with the exception that the larger rocks generally appear closer to the surface.

This wall is oriented 'Den North'. This wall is about 160 cm thick & consists of two retaining walls, the Eastern drawn & 1 coarse thick of large - very large river cobbles (30cm thick) The Western retaining wall is 50 cm thick & consists of two coarse of medium - large river cobbles. The wall seems to be filled in with small, medium & large river cobbles, because no courses are discernable.

Space Doggy # 19 CONTINUED

From corner to corner, this wall is: 1500cm long almost exactly. It is oriented at: DWN N. The wall is on average 160-165 cm thick. From about 10-11 meters the wall in an exposed cross section is as much as 6 courses thick but as little as three. These rocks are all fine cobbles & range in size from medium to large. Each course looks about the same size. To the north this wall corners with "Oh Capernach". To the south this wall corners with "Psalm of Joshua". This wall marks the Western Side of what could be the practice or earlier ballcourt.

* This Wall is: 16³⁰ cm long on the outside.

FEATURE # 20 Psalm of Joshua

This wall links "Space Doggy" with its compliment, "Blue Cloud". This wall closes in the space along the South side. The outside & south side of Psalm of Joshua is 670cm long. The inside is .350 cm wide. 60cm from inside & 35cm from outside looks like a circular feature with diameter: 60cm. It looks like it might have held something. Psalm of Joshua is 150cm wide. I believe this wall is 5 or (six) courses thick. all the rocks seem to be about same size. This wall could conservably be as thick as "Blue Cloud" & "Space Doggy." I excavated this wall using test pits. 90cm inset from S.E. corner the wall appears to be about 15cm. I'm not sure if this [redacted] was deliberate architecture or bad preservation or robbing. Wall is generally very well preserved.

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FEATURE # 21 BLUE CLOUD

Blue Cloud runs North - South & is the Eastern wall complimenting Space Doggy. This wall courses with Psalm of Joshua & Oh Capernoh. The inside of the Wall is between 1460 & 1470 cm's. The outside of the Wall is about 1700 cm long. The construction of this wall is very similar to that of Space Doggy. I exposed part of "Blue Cloud" on the inside. I took this down 120 cm below the surface to expose 30 cm of the wall. I believe this wall extends even further than this. I uncovered 4 courses all the rocks seem to be the same size & large River Cobbles. Top Course, Rocks: large, then a layer of small cobbles, layer of large rocks, layer of cobbles, etc etc. down. This Wall is also between 160 - 165 cm wide. I cannot determine exactly from my test pits, how many courses this wall is thick. This Wall is oriented: between Due N & 07° N depending on the test pits. I assume it must be due to preservation.

POINT OF INTEREST

It appears that this closed in Space (possible ball court) is inset into the courtyard. That is while the inside of "Space Doggy" & Blue Cloud continue down many courses, the outside does not follow the same behavior, that is, it is a course or two above what I believe was ground surface. The holds more true closer South. Near "Psalm of Joshua" this is just a hunch. The corner of Psalm & Space Doggy has courses below

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FEATURE #22 CROSSROADS

CROSSROADS IS A PLASTER SURFACE / PLATFORM LINKING IA-48 WITH ITS NEARER, WESTERN COUNTERPART, IA-49. THIS SURFACE IS FAIRLY WELL PRESERVED. I TOOK TWO ELEVATIONS WITH TRANSIT, ONE NORTH, ONE SOUTH. THIS FEATURE IS ABOUT A SOLID 700cm OF PLASTER SURFACE. IT BECAUSE ILL PRESERVED & INCLUDES MANY SMALL COBBLES WHICH APPEAR TO MAKE A SMALL COBBLE SURFACE BEFORE PLASTER.

To the North, I believe that "Hootenanny" extended towards IA-49 & acted as the retaining wall for the entire North Side. However, I believe this was ripped out either by me accidentally or in antiquity. I believe the latter. In its widest parts, crossroads is, of that exposed, IN ITS WIDEST PART IT IS roughly 180cm wide. The Surface stops at the Wall "El Rancho" in the East & I assume that it runs all the way to the basal feature of the other structures. In antiquity this Surface could have been as much as 800cm long.

FEATURE #23 NO EXIT

I TEST PITTED & FOUND THIS WALL. IT IS FLANKING THE EASTERN SIDE OF A PLASTER SURFACE, SOUTH WEST OF MY STRUCTURE. IT DOES NOT APPEAR TO HAVE ANY RELATIONSHIP WITH "BETAS OF JASHUA" I EXPOSED ONE COURSE OF MEDIUM-LARGE IRREGULAR ROCKS. I'M NOT SURE WHAT THE ULTIMATE FUNCTION OF THIS WALL IS. I CAN ONLY GUESS THAT IT WAS PROBABLY A RETAINING WALL OR FORMAL DEFINITION FOR THE PLASTER. THIS DOES NOT EXTEND 200cm SOUTH IN ANOTHER TEST PIT. SOMETHING MUST HAPPEN TO IT. EXPOSED LENGTH: 150cm : ORIENTATION 17 N.E.

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FEATURE # 24 & THE GODS SAID NEPTALI

THIS FEATURE IS A LITTLE CONFUSING BECAUSE SO LITTLE OF IT IS EXPOSED BUT, I BELIEVE THIS WAS ATTACHED TO BOTH IA-48 & IA-49. THIS FEATURE HOOKED OUT OVER THE ENCLOSED SPACE "POSSIBLE BALL COURT": "The Gods-said Neptali are in the Same Line as the El Rancho. It is about 190cm from Pantana to [] edge of Terrace" & God said Neptali A small step down (15cm) exists East of this but I did not open enough to understand this. To the South, this feature steps down about 40cm onto another small to medium surface. This is fairly extensive and I wonder if this runs West & becomes the 1st major terrace of IA-49. Medium-large few very large linear blocks & one or two cutblocks (34x40x10 cm). ORIENTATION 05° N.E. What could be 1st Terrace Orientation: 263° W.

FEATURE # 25 AMOS

THIS FEATURE IS PART OF AS MANY AS [] THREE TERRACED STEPS WHICH LEAD DOWN FROM GITANGALI - plaster Surface "Crossroads". This is one course thick & looks poorly built. ORIENTATION: 10° N.E. This appears in the crosscutting, possibly to have been 30 cm tall. This Wall / step / terrace might be the outside of "Funky Old King Ra" but that just a guess.

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FEATURE # 26 21 Rancho

This wall / terrace Stair is about 30 cm above the level of "Crossroads". It stands two courses tall. I think Amos looked very similar to this. This could be the 1st step up into the living level of the mound. This is in the same line as "& the Gods said Neptali" the back of "Blue Cloud". This Wall curves South & heads east right behind Soul Lakes. This Wall also seems to serve as a retaining Wall for the plaster Surface. I can see the Wall for at least 4 meters, this is mostly southern orientation 10° N.E.

FEATURE # 27 GITANJALI

"GITANJALI" is a cobble Surfacing consisting of mostly medium few small & even less large River cobbles. This Surface is bordered on the East by ~~the~~ "St. Francois de Mon Teurpe" "Sunny Day Stair" was built on top of this Surface. This Surface is higher in the South & drops towards the North. This could just be preservation. or Southern end of Gitangali was built up with the Tales "St. Francois de Mon Teurpe". It is also bordered by "F.O.G.C.D.". General Dimensions: 500cm x 180cm. I'm not quite sure what the function of this Was; This was either built or added to after the decomission of "Stamatti" "out of here for Corkwood".

I WENT INTO EXCAVATION OF STRUCTURE # IA-48, WITH THE HYPOTHESIS THAT THIS STRUCTURE WAS PART OF A NEW SITE CORE. I REASONED THAT THIS NEW CLUSTER, STRUCTURES IA-49, IA-48, IA-47, IA-46, IA-45, IA-44, IA-43, IA-42, IA-40, & POSSIBLY IA-39 & IA-19, WERE THE EXTENT OF A (POSSIBLY UNFINISHED) NEW SITE CORE. I ALSO REASONED THAT A POLITICAL, RELIGIOUS, OR ECONOMIC SHIFT IN FOCUS, WAS THE REASON FOR THE MOVE. IN DECIDING TO TAKE STRUCTURE # IA-48, I THOUGHT THAT ITS PROXIMITY AS A STRUCTURE ON THE SOUTHERN PERIPHERY OF THIS NEW SITE CORE WOULD BE PARTICULARLY HELPFUL IN UNDERSTANDING THE TRANSITION FROM [REDACTED] AS TO NEW SITE CORES. IT IS THROUGH UNDERSTANDING THIS TRANSITION PERIOD THAT I FEEL WILL SHED LIGHT AND GIVE ENERGY TO THE REAL QUESTION; WHY DID THE INHABITANTS OF LA SIERRA CONTINUE BUILDING OUTSIDE THE SITE CORE & WHY DID THEY CHOOSE TO ARRANGE THEIR DEVELOPMENT THE WAY THEY CHOSE TO?

Thus I began to excavate & formulating an excavation plan that would include understanding the basic function of Structure # IA-48 & the relationship of Structure # IA-48 to both the old & the "new" site core. I ran an axial trench down North across the middle of the structure. From here I excavated laterally along the architecture. I also decided to run another N-S. axial trench, this time across the "saddle" of Structure # IA-49. This added to my general question & excavation plan. What relationship do IA-49 & IA-48 share.

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As I began to clear away the structures both the architecture & the artifactual record were very interesting when plugged into the original Question. I shall first address the architecture. Structure IA-48 was attached to Structure IA-49. Though at this point, I'm not sure if this had always been the case or if it was an addition, or an incorporation of the two functions of the structures. I did not excavate West of my axial Trench, 29E, towards structure IA-49. I would assume that a plaster surface is more official architecture than a surface constructed from stone. Thus were these buildings for public use? Next the smaller structure seemed to be divided in its construction. This division partitioned a north space & a south space. Thus the function of the smaller structure was even divided further. This division appeared to happen into a later phase of construction. Then an important question might be: does the partitioning of this space reflect the possible change in function of the structure? If so does this change relate to a shift in political, religious, or economic focus. []

ABOUT THE SAME TIME THIS SPACE WAS PARTITIONED, THIS BUILDING WAS ENLARGED & CUT BLOCKS WERE ADDED. THIS A FORMALIZATION WAS UNDERTAKEN. A CUT BLOCK STAIR/STAIRCASE WAS CONSTRUCTED & CUT BLOCK CAPPED ALL OF THE WALLS. THIS MAKING THE STRUCTURE VERY IMPORTANT. SO AT THE TIME OF THE PARTITIONING OF SPACE, A VERY IMPORTANT SET OF ADDITIONS WERE EITHER COMMISSIONED OR UNDERTAKEN.

thus I believe that the reason for the division of Structure # IA-48 is linked in somewhat to the reason for the shift in the site cores.

Next, extending from out under the Southern cut block entry feature of Structure # IA-48 is a large wall in space. These walls (Blue Cloud, Space Doggy, Psalm of Joshua) are very large. I have speculated that it could be an "entry" or practice ball court. Regardless of the function of this other structure, it is important that it was fired in and thrown into disuse either with the construction of IA-48 or during one of the structures building phases.

This could also help explain a reason for the shift in site cores. ^{By} the height of the structure IA-48's building period. The occupants no longer wanted whatever that space was. Thus I believe the architecture could possibly shed light on a number of solutions.

Another issue to tackle the question, is through the artifactual record. In this case of this structure it is not only helpful to understand what artifacts were found or asss function, but also note what artifacts were not found. Structure # IA-48 seemed to have been kept reasonably clean of artifacts in parts & the structure lying east of IA-48 was kept very clean of artifacts. Why was this so & can we infer relationship from the artifacts that will help to understand the partitioning of space.

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FURTHER NOTES ON DATUM.
