So far we're finding sherds of various sizes, the largest ones so far measuring about 5cm across. They are mostly body sherds, but sim sherds are not upcommon, we started hitting some larger rocks (20-25 cm across) at the bottom of the level. We finished this lot around noon.

27eb 2000 We got out a little earlier today, it was nice to 6c/002 be able to start digging right away. We re going down another 20 cm in Square 1, and we're hitting tons of sheeds, but nothing else yet. Some albitage flakes started coming up around 30 cm below ground surface. Mostly chest, Othink. There have also been some obsidion flakes and blades between 30 cm and 40 cm. We seem to be going through quite a bit of tumble. At the bottom of the level in the northwest corner to be found a huge rim sheed. I'm trying to get the rest of the square level now, and to get the walls a little straighter. There is still a lot of resamies coming out. Ed thinks we may be on a living surface, so were going to try to go down 20 cm more, hopefully in 10 cm levels.

Colors This level has started out with the high concentration of sheets continuing. By I've seen a couple of pieces that look like they've been incised. Most of the renamics are pretty large, and rim sheeds are very common. There is a file of rocks in the west corner that are embedded in the wall, so we're leaving them for now. There has been a little bit of carbon, but no way to collect it.

(cont) Some more charcoal flechs showed up at the end of the level, Several more of obsidian bloodes and flakes also came from the last few centimeters. One piece of copper ore came from the southwest side of the square. We'll do one more worm level, and then maybe move to the next square. We're at 50 cm below ground surface now. It's orange with red paint, very pretty. We just got our first piece of bajareque in this level. Other a piece of mice. We found a couple more discretions for allos, and a large leg for a vessel. This level was actually only 10 cm, so it ended at 70 cm below ground surface.

66/006 This level is from 70cm -80 cm below ground surface. There is some interesting stuff in here-a red shert : sore, a pièce of mica (3-4 cm across), and some huge sherds, the largest one is probably 20-25 cm across. a lot of large um shords, many with handles. I think we might continue down faither, because we're still getting so many artifacts. We just pulled a small piece of pottey with a hieroglyphie day sign in the between 2 other glyphs which were both broken. Very exciting. We've also got a piece of bojacque, and some tiny fleks of charcoal. We had some larger charcoal pieces at the bottom of. The level, but we didn't collect them because I wasn't sure they hadn't been touched we also found an absidean core, flake, and blades, a possible check ever, and a modified that flake. The level ended at 80 cm below ground level.

60007 This level is from 80 cm - 90 cm below ground suface.

We are still coming up with lots of sheds. I'm starting to wonder if we're ever going to hit the bottom! There are still a few charcoal flakes, but not very many.

We also found some possible yellow ochre. We just got a couple pieces of animal bone, but I can't tell what kind they are. A couple of bajareque pieces also showed up. The artifact density is finally dropping off. We only got 2 bags of sheets, and one of them is small. This level is ended at 90 cm below ground surface.

Tomorrow we will start excavating in Square 2.

621008 Today we started execurating square 2 in Structure 20 There are several by rocks, and I thinks I've been able to explain why we have to leave them in. I don't think it is a wall, probably just more tumble, but I'm not sure yet. already son some sheeds coming up, and we've only about 5 cm down! This is going to be a 20 cm level. Very overcast today, which will actually be nice. The sherds we've getting up here are pretty thick compared to the one s we were fending under the tumple in Square 1. There are some red chert debitage flakes coming from the north corner, but I don't think they're from a single core. For a minute there, I thought we might have a soft wall, fisses but it just turned out to be tumble, so now we've taking out the rocks. We just got a flake of green chart with cortex on it. I haven't seen any that color before. We've been getting some vesicular basalt works, but no groundstone. We got a little excited, so this livel ended up being 30 an below ground surface. a lot of shords, a lot of obsidian, and a few plakes.

Lake This level joke will (hopefully) be 10 cm, ending at 40 cm below ground surface. We should be almost down to the midden level again. There are still quite a few shords coming out, and a few debitage flakes, most of them pretty big. We got a chunk of bajareque and some obsidian. We're still going through some small rocks; which is slowing things down a little. We re starting to fall some unusual stuff out. There are 2 pebbles with a flattened side on lack one, a round clay ball about I cm in diameter and a clay cone-shaped thing with a hole in the top and doto incised around the hole. GC/018 This level will be another 10cm, to 40 cm below ground surface. We want to get below the tumble line, and then we'll move on to the next square. There are still a good number of sherds coming to out, but they are mostly plain wares, not very many painted. We also got a possible groundstone fragment. At the end we found another groundstone fragment, We also found 2 fragments of a ceramic stamp, obsidion, and bajareque. This level took up to 40cm below ground surface, and below the level of the tumble, so we're moving out of square 3, into a square 4, where hopefully we'll finally find a wall! It looks pretty promising, though.

66/019 We're starting on Square 4, going 20 cm below ground surface. There is a lot of tumble on top, but hopefully there will be a wall underneath. We didn't finish the this lot today (again!), there are too many rocks. Hardly any artifacts now, although we did get a huge obsidian flake, 5-7 cm long, 4025 cm wide and a couple come thick. We pulled a few rocks, but no wall so far.

10 Februso We started out this morning by fulling a few more tumble rocks, but there's still not much to see. We overshot a little on this one, so the level ends at 30 cm below ground surface. It looks like we might finally have a wall. We just pulled some tumble that was along the line dividing Squares 4 and 5, and the wall should be right behind it. This lot is actually going to be the area on the northwest pide of the wall, and the next lot will be the southeast side of the wall. We even't able to keep level with all the rocks.

We just pulled a piece of obsidian from worden directly over a long bone directly east of the ribs and about Icm lower. There is a second long bone parallel to the first long bone. Both bones are perpendicular to the east end of the ribs. an immature vertebra came from the northwest corner of the pedestal Aquare. The two long bones may be a tibra and fibala. All of the bones have been surrounded by trash. The easternmost long bone runs at a slight NNW-SSE angle, and would intersect the first long bone (closest to the ribs). Onother shed came from directly on top of the westermost long bone. The three larger long bones (tibia, fibula, + femur?) all go into the northeast profile quite aways. Now that more of the pelvis is exposed, 9 think it's an adult. There is also the distal end of a tibia, and possibly a fibula, both adult sized, an unning E-W about halfway between the femus/pelvis and the other pelvis and unknown vone. The tibia + fibula are just under where the calcaneous bone had been. I also removed another ankle bone that I can't remember the name of, which was under the cureiforms (Itit's the lone that articulates we all three, and I removed a talus. all the foot bones are from the same individual. Except for the foot bones, all the other bones are still in place! I photographed them when I finished today, and will cover them up for the night.

(C1028 Well, the lot continues. I'm hoping to finish up nore bones: Well someone got into the pit again last night, and they took the adult pelvis that was lying against the femur. The head of the femur has trees been broken off, and it has been damaged around the posimal end, but otherwise none of the other bones have been disturbed. I'm going to work on getting them out so hopefully they won't be clamaged anymore, but maybe if there isn't a pelvis the bones will be left alone. So for only pelvises have been actually removed, which is kind of stronge. I just checked the long bones running into the northeast profile, and the northernmost one has been removed. I also found a child's rib in the dist over the long bones, which I think came from between the long bones. The unidentified bones from yesterday are 3 vertebrae, and the long bone isn't one, but is actually another metatorsal. I removed it because it was falling out of the dist. The tibes and fibula are articulated, running into the northwest profile. I'm taking it down a little bit at a time so I can continue to follow the bones. Underneath the tibia + fibula and running perpendicular to them are another fibula (I think) and another long bone. What I was calling vertebrae earlier are actually bones of a second foot. Several of the tarsals are still articulated. about half of the pelvis that 9 thought bad been token is still there. It's only part of the ilium, the rest of it was destroyed, as far as Q can tell I'm going to photograph the bones and remove than as they become exposed enough. I removed the half of the ilium that was left, but if it fractured into several pieces. I also removed to two

(CC/028 metataisals, which I believe were consecutive. I uncovered some more of the other pelvis, which looks child sized again. We took a carbon sample of material that was burned inside a seramic vessel. a couple of the sherds were not saved, but some of the material was scraped directly of the inside of the sherds. The sherds are from a fairly large plainware jar. The bones are so closely packed together that there's no way to pedestal them, so we've going to have to take them out individually. The 2nd carbon sample was taken from about 5cm above the bone, and was the west. Some toe bones came from west of the pelvis, directly to the west of the small femur, and a netatarsal (*5, right) from just north of the small femur. The head of the small femus femus is NW of the small pelvis, only about 3 cm away from the acetabulum, the the small femus. There were some and broken rib fragments from under the tibia and fibula. It suns even with the top of ELROND for about 50 cm, then steps up about 13cm and runs back to abut LEGOLAS. DURIN also abut ELPOND to the southeast, 3HADOWFAX to the mortheast, and Plan THEODEN to the southwest. There are a few chinking stones included in Durin. The average stone in DURIN is 20-25cm across.

SHADOWFAX-79cm x 29cm, 55cmbd-92cmbd, from Datum 2.330° orientation.
This is the back wall the piche SAURON in Structure 20. It is composed of faced and unfaced popules, and a few chinking stones.
It forms an abutting corner with ELROND at the SE end, and a second abutting corner with LEGOLAS at the NW end. SHADOWFAX is also abutted at the bottom by SAURON and on the back (SW) by DURIN. It is 3-courses high and one course wide. The average stone is 15-20cm across.

LEGOLAS-157en x59cm, 107cmbd-487cmbd, from Datum 1. 20° orientation. This is the fourth step in the staircase in Structure 20. It is composed of faced and unfaced exp cobbles, with a couple of limestone slabs. There are also a couple of pieces of residual basalt incorporated into LEGOLAS. It was back and abutto APABORN at the southwest half of the northwest side of LEGOLAS, It is also abutted at the bottom of the pouthwest half of the southeast side by DURIN. In the northeast of half, LEGOLTS makes up the northwest half of the southwestern wall of the outside room. It also forms the northwest wall of the niche SAURON. It is abutted the coutreast by SHADOWFAX. It also forms an abutting corner with BOROMIR. LEGOLAS marks the place where the Stainage attaches to the Love structure. LEGOLAS is 3-7 courses high, and 2-3 courses wide. The average stone in LEGOIAS is 20-25 cm wide. On the northeast side, LEGOLAS is abutted at the bottom by GLDEFINDEL, and on the southeast side by the floor of SAURON.

SAURON- Form × 49 cm, 93 cm bd, from Datum 2.

on the southwest, SHATOWFAX on the southwest, and LEGOLAS

on the northwest. SAURON is constructed from faced and unfaced

if it is a niche, it wasn't closed. The average stone is 20-30 cm across.

BALIN-59cm xiDom, 29cmbd-63cmbd, from Worten &.

BALIN is a capped niche in the wall BOROMIR in Structure 20.

It faces southeast, and would have been wisible from outside the structure. It is constructed of unfaced niver coubles and limestone. It is located in the back wall of the outside room.

BALIN may have originally been open, and then capped with a later addition to BOROMIR. The average stone in BALIN is 10-15 cm across.

GLOIN-133cm x 117cm, 122cm pd, from Datum 2

This is the original floor for the outside room in Structure 20.

It is constructed of small river coubles, averaging 10-15 cm across. I Some of the colbles have been faced on their top surface. The floor abutts BORDMIR and GOIDBERRY, and presumably LEGOLAS, ELROND, and SARUMAN, although it is covered in these areas by a later floor, GIORFINDEL, so I don't know for sure.

GLOIN would have been about level with the topog SARUMAN.

GIDEFINDEL-158cmx 131cm, 109cmbd, from Datum 2.

This is a later floor for the outside room in Structure 20. Pt
constructed over GIDIN, although it is only put partially intact.

It is constructed of small, unmodified cobbles, as well as a

few small prices of limestone. In all its present condition,

it abutts LEGOLPS, ELROND, the back of SARUMAN, and parts of
GOLDBERRY and BOROMIR. The average stone in GIORFINDEL is 6-10cm across.

GANDALF-145cm×107cm, 83cm bd, from Datum 1.

This is a floor or perface that suns from BOROMIR to GIMI.

Ot is composed of unmodified cobbles and a couple of pieces
of limestone. There are also some chinking stones included
in the floor. GANDALF may be a later floor, because it is higher
than Loth ARAGORN and DENETHOR, which are directly to the
southwest and northeast, respectively. It is at about the same
level as the top of BOROMIR. The average stone in CANDALF is 20-25 cm across.

ARAGORN-96cm × 10tcm, 91cm bd, from Datum 1.
This is a floor on the southwestern 13 of the summit of Structure 20. It runs from LEGOLAS to ARWEN, and appears to run under GANDALF. It also abutto the back of FARAMIR to the SW, and it runs into or possibly under SAM. It is composed of river cobbles, and contains smaller cobbles as chinking stones.
The average stone in ARAGORN is 20-30 cm across.

GIMII-116 x 20cm, 61cmbd-74cmbd, from Datum 1. 30° orientation
This is a line marking the end of the brench SAM. It is only four
stones long, one course high, and one course wide. It looks
like it may have continued across over DENETHOR and possibly
ARAGORN, however. It is composed of river cobbles, with a
couple of chinking stones. GIMII looks like it may have been
a title later addition along with SAM. It is abutted on the
southeast side by GANDALF, The average store in GIMII is 20-30cm across.

5AM forms half of an L-shafed bench on the summit of Structure 20.
9t is constructed of river robbles, and has smaller chinking
stones incorporated into it. It is two courses high, and runs

other half of the bench, ELBERETH, and the bottom of ARWEN.
5AM is built on top of a layer of fill abour DENETHOR, which
appears to run underneath it. It is unclear how SAM

ELBERETH - 127cm x 101cm, 45cmbd - 98cmbd, from Dotum 1. 38° orientation

the most part, but the other stones are not. There are some
chinking stones incorporated into ELBERETH. It is four courses

DENETHOR-77cm x113cm, 100cm bd from Datum 1.

This is an early floor on the summit of structure 20. It
is composed of robbles, some faced and some unfaced. There
we also a few chinking stones incorporated into the floor.

Not much of the floor is preserved, but the part that is
intact abutla ELBERETH to the northwest and runs under SAM
to the southwest. DENETHOR may believe run under the fill
beneath GOLLUM, but it is very unclear. It also looks
as though DENETHOR may have continued to the back LMW)
Aide of BOROMIR, but because that part of the floor is not
intact, it's difficult to say for sure. If it did continued to
BOROMIR, then it probably also runs under BANDALF, and
possibly even ARAGORN. The average stone in DENETHOR is 20-25 cm across.

GOLLUM - 273cm × 19 cm, bembd - 72 cm bd, from Datum 1. 286° orientation GOLLUM is a very late addition summit wall in Structure 20. It is corposed primarily of faced and impaced colbles, but there is also some vesicular bosalt and limistone. All of the facings are on the southwest side of GOLLUM. There are also several chinking stones incorporated into the wall. GOLLUM is 3-4 scarse courses high, and 1 course wide. It is constructed on top of a layer of fill alless placed above DENETHOR, GOLLUM abutts FRODO at the northwest end, and BOROMER at the southwest end. It seems to be built directly over &GIL-GALATO on the northwest end ELBERETH on the southwest. GOLLUM's construction is relatively poor, somposed to the rest of the Mestructure. It is definitely one of the last features to be constructed on the summit. The average Stone in GOLLUM is about 20cm across.

GIL-GALAD- 213cm x 80cm, 50cm bd, from Datum 1. This is a structure 20. It is constructed out of river of cobbles, all einfaced. There are also some chinking stones incorporated into the floor. GIL-GALAD abutta FRODO to the northwest, GOLDBERRY to the northeast, and BOROMIR to the southeast. To the southwest, GIL-GALAD disappears under GOLLUM. It is possible that it continued across the summit, which would have put it over DENETHOR. If it did continue across, though it's unclear how it would have related to ELBERETH. They are on the same level, and they look like they they could connect under Gallem, but I don't think that they do. It appears that they could be on earlier floor underneath GIL GALAD, but it wasn't explored any further than a small test pit about 20 cm across, which soid hit some stone streetly we below GIL-GALAD. The average stone in GI-GALAD is 20-25cm across.

ARWEN-119 cn x 90 cm, 18 cm bd - 11 cm bd, from vature 4.

ARWEN is a shelf in the western some of the summit of

Structure 20. It is composed primarily of unfaced cobbles,
although there are a few faced cobbles along the northeast
and southeast sides. There are a few chinking stones present,
but not nearly as many as in other features in the structure.

ARWENIS 4 courses high, 3 sources wide. It abouts FRODO
on the northwest and FARAMER on the southwest. It is built
on a thin layer of fill above both SAM and ARAGORN. It is
probably a late addition to the summit, and to the structure
as a whole. It is one of the highest features in the ptwetture.

The average stone in ARWEN is 25-30 cm across.

PIPIN - 643cm x 54 cm, 10bem nd - 270 cm bd, from Datum 1. 38° orientation PIPPIN is a wall running along the outside of the rore wall FRODO on the northwest side of Structure 20. It is composed primarily of faced cobbles, although unfaced cobbles and limestone are also present. Chinking stones une also incorporated into the wall. PIPPIN is 6 rourses high and 2 courses wide. It abutts a with the bottom of FRODO for the entire length of the core structure. At the northeast end, PIPPIN forms an intertocoting corner with GOLDBERRY. at the southwest end, PIPPIN corners to abut FRODO FRODO forms a corner with FARAMIR. However, PIPPIN was later extended out beyond the corner of the rore structure, possibly to form the northwest border of the patio GALADRIEL. Beyond the corner of the core structure, PIPPIN apara expands to 3 courses wide, and abutto the western come of FARAMIR. PIPPINis also abutted by GALADRIEL to the southeast where it extends post the core structure. PIPPIN was added to the structure sometime after the original construction was completed. The average stone in PIPPIN is 20-30cm across.

GALADRIEL - 1662mx 405 cm, 169 cm bd-182 cm bd, from Datum 1.

This is a floor outside the rore structure on the southwest side. Ot was probably a patio, and may have been covered. It is constructed of both faced and was unfaced colver, and a couple of pieces of linestone. There are also some chinking stones. GALADRIEL is 2 courses high and 4 courses wide, although it was probably wider originally. It was added on to the core structure, and abutts FARAMIR to the northwest and PIPPIN to the morthwest. GALADRIEL probably extended to the end of PIPPIN when it was intact. The average stone in GALADRIEL is 15-20 cm across.

CELEBORN-296cm x 270cm, 200cm bd from Datum 1
This is a Post-llassic addition on the southwest side of Structure 20. It is composed primarily of unfaced colbles placed on end. There are also some limestone slabs and chinking stones in the feature. There are some faced colbles, but the facings are not arranged in any particular order. CELEBORN is one course high, and 8-10 courses wide. It abutto FARAMIR at FARAMIR's southeast end, and extends southeast past FARAMIR for over a mees meter. It is unclear why this feature was added, but it wasn't until after the structure had been abandoned. The average stone in CELEBORN is 20-25 cm across.

BILBO-204cm × 56cm, 155cm bol-194cm bod, from Datum 2.

This is another Post-Classic addition to Structure 20. It is on the southeast side of the structure. It is composed primarily of unfaced of cobbles placed on end. There is one limestone slab, and a couple of faced cobbles, but the facings are not arranged in any particular order. BILBO is one course high, and 1-3 courses wide. It abutts the front of MERRY from MERRY'S southwestern end to the point at which it angles off. This flature was also added after the atucture was abandoned. The average stone in BILBO is 20-25cm across.

TOM BOMBADIL - 262cm x 44cm, 43cm rod -15/ocm rod, from Datum 2. 300° orientation. This is a wall on the outside of Structure 20, along the northeast side of the structure it starts at GOLDBERRY's corner with SARUMAN and continues along GOLDBERRY, abutting it, until BOROMIR, where TOM BOMBADIL forms an abutting corner with GOLDBERRY. TOM BOMBADIL is composed of faced cobbles and limestone, with the facings on the outside. There are also chinking stones. TOM BOMBADIL is 1-9 courses high and 1-3 courses wide. The authors at non BOMBADIL is 1-9 courses high and 1-3 courses wide.

TREEBEARD-188cm x 71cm, 749cmbd-172cmbd, from Datum 2. 34° overtation.

TREEBEARD a wall running under SARUMAN and outside of

Structure 20. It is composed of large cobbles, both faced and

unfaced. The facings are all on the outside of the wall. TREEBEARD

is probably the earliest feature present, and may not be a

part of the structure. SARUMAN is brill on top of it, but

otherwise it doesn't really relate to the rest of the structure.

THEODEN also runs over TEEST TREEBEARD, It runs parallel

to EOMER, and with the Post-clossic addition of CELEBORN,

it also almost seems to form the boundary of a room, However,

CELEBORN wasn't built until after the structure was abandoned,

ELENDIL-121cm x 89cm, 112-129cmbd, from Datum 3.

ELENDIL is the corner of a substructure, possibly related to

Structure 20. It is composed of faced and unfaced cobbles, limestone,
and chinking stones. The facings are on the outside of the walls.

The corner is bruilt on a layer of fill. ELENDIL is 1-2 courses

high. It is possible that MERRY was extended out at an angle
for some reason relating to this substructure, because the

engle of MERRY runs parallel to the northwest wall of this

structure. The average stone in ELENDIL is 25-30cm across.

ELROHIR-91cm x 49cm, 85cmbd-101cmbd, from Datum 3. 6° orientation. This is the wall of another substructure, also possibly relating to structure 20. It is composed of faced cobbles and a couple of chinking stones. The facings are all on the outside of the wall. ELROHIR is one rouse high and one course wide, although it may be wider. Not enough was excavated to be sure. The average stone in ELROHIR is 15-20cm across.

NIMPODEL-98cm × 35cm, 96cmbd=116cmbd, from Datum 3. 310° orientation This is another substructure wall that may be related to Structure 20. It is constructed of vesicular brobalt and faced cobbles. The facings are on the contaide of the wall (Sw).

NIMPODEL is one course high and one course wide. It is built on a layer of fell. It is unclear how NIMPODEL relates to Structure 20 or to the other substructures. It appears that it might run underneath ELROHIR, but I'm not sure. The average stone in NIMPODEL is 15-25cm across.

Final Notes Summary

Structure 20 Man underwent several construction phases before it was finally abandoned. The first phase consisted of building the row structure. This included FRODO, FARAMOR, EOMER, BOROMER, and GOLDBERRY. Some summit features were probably completed during this time as well. DENETHOR appears to be the earliest floor on the summit, and the bench ELBERETH may be contemporary. Once the core of the structure was completed, the stancase was built onto the front, allowing access from the southeast. The steps, from the bottom up, are MERRY, SARUMAN, ELLOND, and LEGOLAS. DURIN is a surface between ELROND and LEGOLAS, around this same time, an outside room was built on the southeast side of the structure, next to the staircase. GOLDBERRY was extended from BOROTTER to SARUMAN to form the northeast wall. ELLOND and LEGOLAS each form part of the southwest wall, separated by a step or niche, SAURON, which steps down from DURIN. The third wall, to the northwest, is formed by BORDMIR. In about the center of BORDMIR is a niche, BALIN. Those was no wall on the southeast side of the room, so It anything that took place in it would be visible to the public, as would whatever was stored in the niche. The niche itself was probably also open on top at this point. The floor of the room was GiòIN, constructed of stone stone cobbles. Ten burials were uncovered over the course of the executions in this structure. Seven were outside the structure on the northwest side, som i of them along PIPFIN from voughly the midline of the structure to the some north corner of the structure. The seventh build was found on topy PIPPIN where it corners with GOLDBERRY. This one was provably later than The other six burials. One barial was found outside the south corner of the structure, between EDMER and THEODEN. This burial is provably roughly contemporary with the six outside of PIPPIN. The final two burials were found on the summit on top of DENETHOR. These two are palso probably fairly late Durials, like the one found on top of PIPTIV. all but one of the burials were bundled. No artifacts were found directly associated with the busials, except for very small sheeds packed around some of the bones. The burial that wasn't a bundle was a very large person, probably male, laid on his back, fully extended. It is unclear why he was buried obferently (see AD-00-9-8+1 and photos).
