

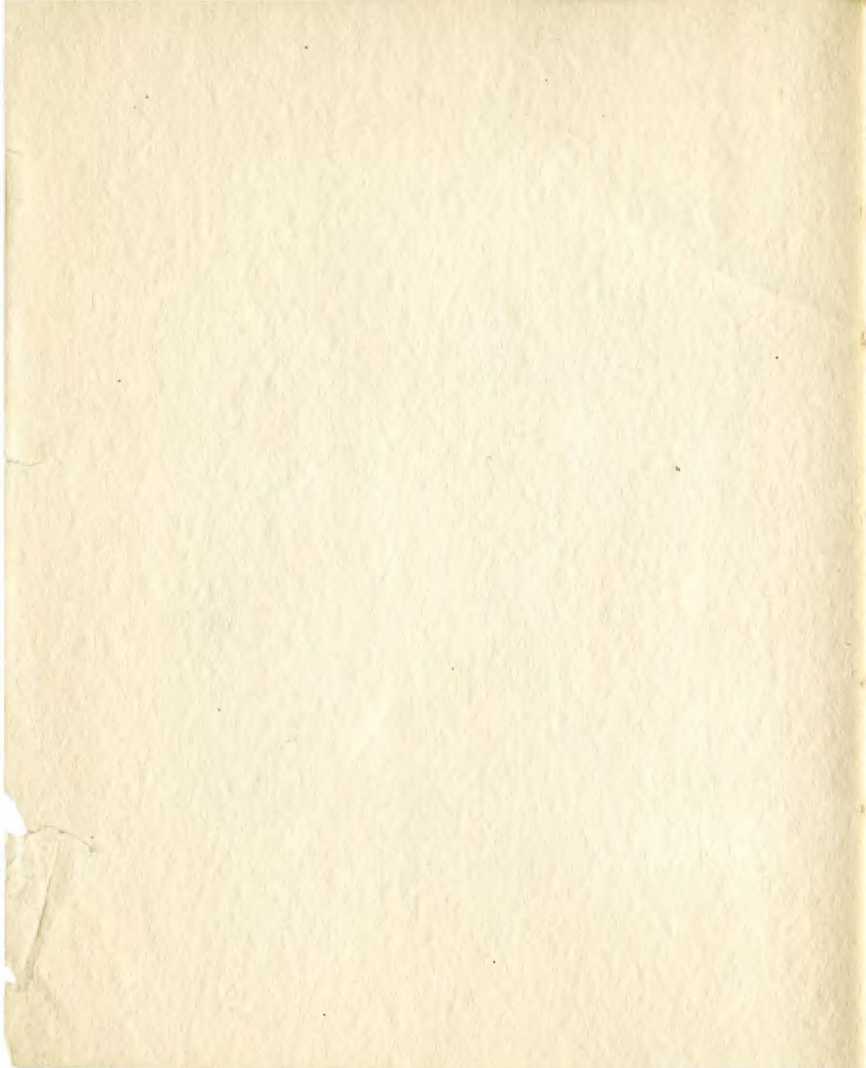

AMENDMENTS.

ARTICLE III.

MEETINGS.

a. The regular meetings of the club shall be held every alternate Friday afternoon at four o'clock, from the first Friday in October to May, inclusive.

ARTICLE VIII.

SECRETARIES.

a. It shall be the duty of the Recording Secretary to take note of all proceedings of the club; to read at each meeting the minutes of the preceding meeting and any papers pertaining to the business of the club.

ARTICLE XVII.

MEMBERSHIP.

a. The club provides for two memberships, active and associate; the associate membership is intended for those who find it impossible to attend the regular meetings.

b. Any associate member may become an active member by paying the regular dues. The associate membership shall not exceed fifteen.

c. The membership of this club shall not be limited to city residents.

d. After one year, the membership of this club shall be limited in number.

e. Candidates for membership must send to the Corresponding Secretary a written application endorsed by two members of the club.

f. All honorary members shall be proposed by the Executive Committee.
