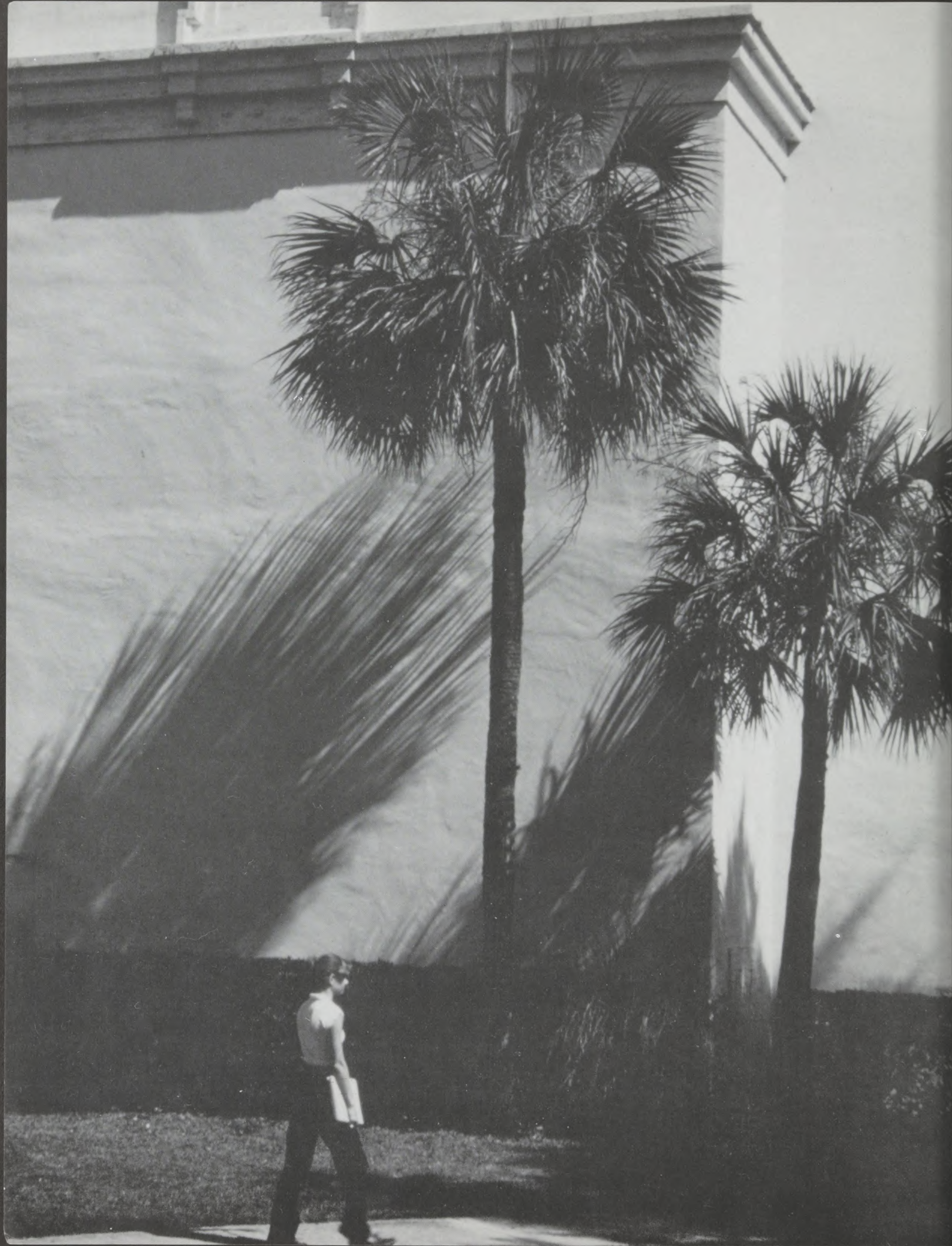

The 1982 Commencement had special meaning for me, since it marked the end of my own senior year at Rollins—I started out in 1978 with the Class of

1982 and shared four happy and rewarding years here with them. Now that I have completed the traditional undergraduate course, I can no longer claim to be the “new” President. It touched me deeply that the Senior Class surprised me on the graduation platform with a diploma which made me a member of the Class of 1982. I have already sent in my contribution to the Alumni Fund!

The end of four years invites reflection on the Rollins experience. Like my classmates, I came to Rollins because it was a small, independent college, committed to the liberal arts, where the *individual* is valued and respected. Although times change, at Rollins the common denominator has always been our personal, open, and informal atmosphere. The family spirit and tradition are what make this such a special place, and these values have never been stronger. These have been the happiest four years of my life.

The 1981-82 year has brought us one year closer to our Centennial. The Class of 1986, which enters in September, will be seniors when we observe our 100th Anniversary on November 4, 1985. The past four years have prepared the way for this important event, and the next four years will be the fulfillment of the goals and aspirations which have shaped the history of Rollins from the beginning.

We began preparing for our Centennial with the formation of the College Planning Committee in 1979. This group of faculty, students, alumni, and Trustees worked for nearly two years, engaging all elements of the Rollins community in a comprehensive review of plans, goals, and needs of the College. The 524-page Final Report contained 138 recommendations for quality improvement and institutional advancement, and we have been working diligently to refine and implement them. Much has been accomplished, and the sense of movement and progress is quite contagious.

It is an exciting time for Rollins and for Central Florida. Economic and demographic projections

point to continued growth and development in which Rollins can play an important role. The National Planning Association in Washington predicts that one of every five Americans will be employed in Texas, California, and Florida by the year 2000 and that these three states can expect 30% of the projected population increase in the next twenty years. Rollins was the first college in Florida, and we have always set the standard for excellence among small colleges in the South. Across the whole Sunbelt, from South Carolina to Arizona, there are only a few small, selective, independent, liberal arts colleges, and none with the national visibility and reputation of Rollins. We are in the right place at

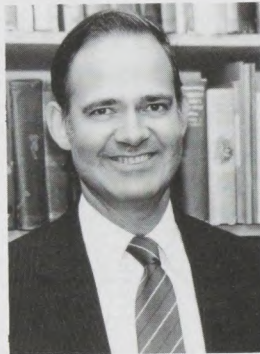
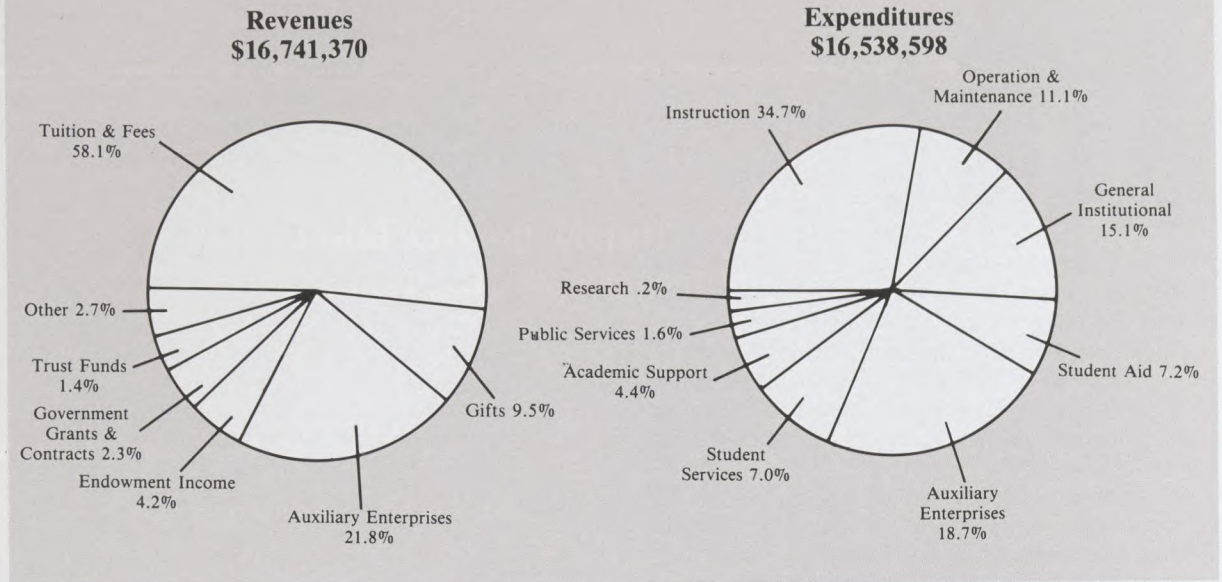
the right time, and we intend to be aggressive in asserting the excellence and importance of Rollins College.

We have concluded another successful year, with full enrollment, strong applications, a balanced budget, and an impressive array of recognitions and achievements among students and faculty alike. Members of the Class of 1982 have been accepted at excellent graduate schools and have landed good jobs. Faculty members have been recognized for their scholarly publications and professional activities. Rollins has been favorably mentioned in the national press—even on “The Today Show”—and Cindy Harper '82 is featured in *Glamour* magazine as one of this year's ten outstanding women graduates in America.

Of course, the most gratifying recognition has come from loyal alumni, parents, and friends. The Alumni Fund set a new record both in participation and in dollars raised, and total giving of \$1.8 million was the largest in our history. The names listed in this Report represent special friends whose generosity has made possible the continued excellence of Rollins College.

On behalf of all members of the Rollins College community, I record profound appreciation for this support and for the confidence and encouragement which it represents. We will be working hard to be worthy of your continued support in the future.

I am pleased indeed to report that Rollins College is healthy, whole, and vibrant. The past academic and fiscal year has been one filled with activity and positive development. Let me review a few of those developments from my perspective as a Trustee.

Following the work of the Planning Committee, whose report was received by the Board in October 1980, a Trustee Self-Study Committee was established to assess the work of the Board itself, its committee structures and procedures, in order to enable us to serve Rollins more effectively. I had the privilege of chairing that committee. We completed our study in May.

The Trustee Self-Study Committee reaffirmed our commitment to stewardship for the resources of the College. We recognize that we must sustain this fine, old College in trust, for future generations. To carry out our responsibilities, we recommend to our fellow Trustees that we have three major, stand-

ing committees of the Board, for Educational and Financial Affairs and for Development. Those committees are currently being composed. They will be staffed by the three Vice Presidents.

In a very real sense, the record of generous support from the private sector enumerated in this publication forms the blueprint for the ongoing work of the Trustee Development Committee. All of the Trustees commit their time, talent, and treasure, as they are able to do so, because they believe in what Rollins stands for. The Development Committee in particular will provide continuing leadership, together with Alumni, Parents, Patrons, Businesses and Foundations, for vital fund-raising for Rollins.

Inspiration for us all was provided by the extraordinary generosity of George and Harriet Cornell. The head of the Parents Association, C. E. Meyer, served as an active Trustee. The three Alumni Trustees, Susan Thompson, Peter Sholley, and Robert Showalter, provided special connections with the Alumni Association. Trustee Charles Rice served as the first chairman of the newly founded Board of Overseers for the Crummer Graduate School of Business. Sparked by special gifts from John Tiedtke, who retired as Chairman in February, but who remains an active Trustee, and from Thomas Johnson, who has served as a Trustee for forty years, the Board challenged itself to give or raise \$100,000 by May 31 to insure a balanced budget. I am pleased to say that we exceeded that goal.

As a result of these good works, and those of many others, we had a successful year in developing the financial resources of Rollins, as reflected in this report. The Board of Trustees, with alumni and friends, looks forward to an even better year ahead of shared accomplishments.

We recognize that we must sustain this fine, old College in trust, for future generations.

As an alumnus of Rollins, I have had the opportunity of watching the College grow and change over more years than I sometimes care to count.

The past year was a good one. I am glad to join in sharing a report on this year with my fellow alumni and the many other friends of Rollins.

It was the best year for general fund-raising on record, with over \$1.8 million contributed to the College in 1981-82. This achievement raises the sights of all of us, as we begin to anticipate the Centennial in 1985.

Many of us enjoyed this year participating in the celebration of the Jubilee of the Knowles Memorial Chapel and the Annie Russell Theatre. I was a student at Rollins when they were dedicated, and I know how much these facilities have meant to the campus and the community over the years. The Chapel and Theatre were built by generous gifts from caring people—by alumni, foundations, and businesses. As I walked around the Annie Russell Theatre recently, I saw plaques recognizing the benefactions of the Edyth Bush Charitable Foundation, the Jessie Ball duPont Trust, the Kresge and the Selby Foundations. These gifts have had a multiplying effect.

As a businessman concerned about the bottom

line, one of the things of which I am proudest this year is the record \$878,000 raised in The Rollins Fund. This drive is central to our development. The Rollins Fund includes all annual giving to the College—the Alumni Annual Fund, the Patrons Fund, the Parents Fund, and the Corporate Associates Fund. Alumni and friends have asked about this new term, and I think the best definition is a statement from the materials used by our volunteer workers to educate themselves for their tasks:

The Rollins Fund represents *unrestricted* gifts. That means spendable cash used to run the College day to day. This money makes up the difference between what it costs to operate Rollins and what is received from tuition, endowment, grants. The Rollins Fund is not for added frills, but basic necessities—it is the cornerstone for the College's entire fund-raising effort.

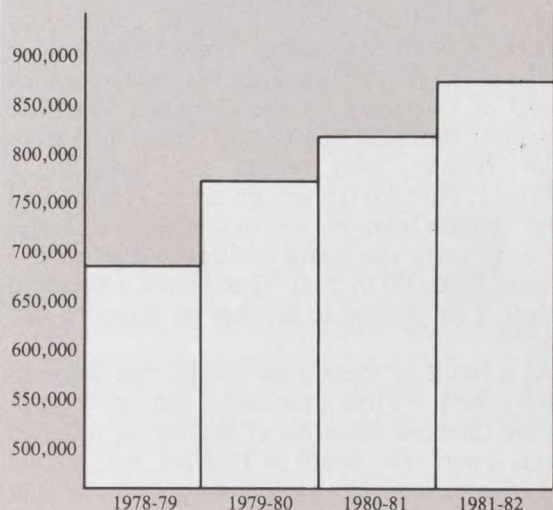
You will see later in this report the detailed figures for the 1981-82 Rollins Fund. Suffice it to say that it would take about \$9 million in added endowment to provide to the College what the Rollins Fund has this year. Clearly, the annual gifts of alumni and friends made a substantial difference for Rollins.

As a businessman concerned about the bottom line, one of the things of which I am proudest this year is the record \$878,000 raised in The Rollins Fund.

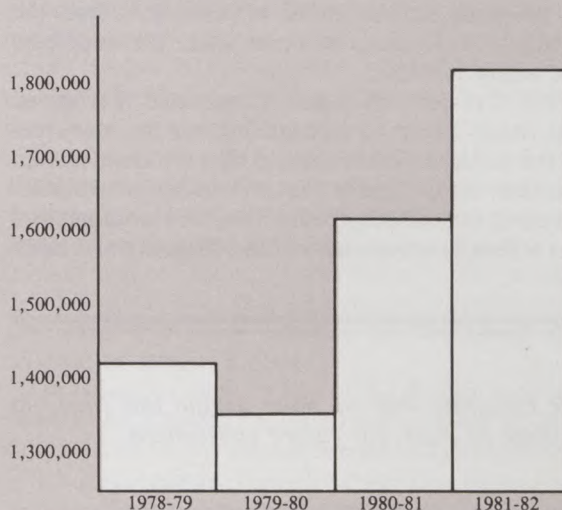
Gifts from Private Sources

The 1981-82 Rollins Fund Phonathons: Everyone Got into the Act.

This year for the first time Rollins students joined in large numbers with alumni volunteers to telephone for the Rollins Alumni Fund. The year's calling began in December with a preliminary mini-phonathon for gift club members. In February, students and even college faculty and staff were added in an effort that required two campus buildings to accommodate the callers. And in April, the party grew to require an entire floor of the Barnett Bank in Winter Park. That phonathon was supplemented by a Philadelphia session for the northeast region.

The phonathons garnered \$33,883 in pledges and involved more than 100 enthusiastic volunteers. Perhaps the most exciting result is that they raised participation rate among Liberal Arts alumni from 17% to over 19%. Caliees often returned their pledge payments with complimentary notes:

"I wanted to let you know how impressed I was with the young man, class of '82, who called me last month. He was so personable, bright, and enthusiastic—a standout individual who impressed me greatly."

"A nice young man! Sorry I couldn't give more!"

"I was very impressed with her (student caller) . . . she gave her time and expected nothing in return but did it for Rollins."

"I enjoyed talking with the student who called a few days ago. Three cheers for whoever had the original idea!!!"

And finally, words from a member of the Class of '81, from which, with the other recent classes, came many of the phonathon pledges:

"I am enclosing \$10 as I was not able to work 40 full hours last week. Please accept this small contribution with a smile, knowing that when I am richer I will contribute more!"

And we say, Hooray for this young alum, and others like her who know that it's their participation that counts!

WILLING DONORS

In 1981-82 Rollins was the grateful recipient of several bequests from alumni and other friends. Although unrestricted legacies are the most helpful of all because of their flexibility, those designated for financial aid to students, books for the Library, and faculty support are central to the College's educational program and are also warmly welcomed. The thoughtful donors listed below are helping to ensure the College's continuing excellence.

Estate of Clarence A. Coddington

\$27,025

Mr. Coddington moved to Winter Park in 1945 after his retirement as Chairman of the Board of Beacon Milling Company. He was a generous donor to Rollins through the Patrons and Conquistador programs during his lifetime. Mr. Coddington established a trust to pay income to several beneficiaries. Upon the death of each of them, his or her share of the trust principal will be divided between Rollins and Piedmont College.

Estate of Ralph N. Ewing '31

\$500

Although Mr. Ewing did not obtain a degree from Rollins, he maintained close ties with the College. He was a faithful supporter of unrestricted annual giving and contributed to the Enyart Field House building fund. His unrestricted bequest is a further expression of loyalty and concern.

Estate of Harrison Hollander

\$250

Mr. Hollander moved to Winter Park in 1947 and became vitally interested in the Bach Festival at Rollins and other cultural programs in the area. A music and drama critic, he also was program annotator for the Florida Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Hollander's legacy is designated for the Book-A-Year program of the Library where it will be added to earlier gifts in his memory made by Mrs. Hollander and friends.

Estate of Robert E. McNeill, Jr.

\$2,500

Mr. McNeill spent his entire business career in banking, rising from teller to Chairman of the Board of Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company in New York. He served as a Trustee of Rollins from 1972-78 and received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from the College. Mr. McNeill's legacy has been added to memorial gifts from family members and friends to establish the Robert E. McNeill Scholarship Fund, a permanent endowment to assist promising students at Rollins.

Estate of Helen Steinmetz '08

\$533

This amount represents a final distribution from Miss Steinmetz's estate. Last year the College received \$39,408, which was divided equally between unrestricted funds and the Book-A-Year program, which builds the Library's endowment.

Estate of Stella C. Van Houten

\$75,400

Mrs. Van Houten became acquainted with Rollins when she stayed at the Seminole Hotel in Winter Park. She was so impressed by the industry and courtesy of the Rollins students who worked there during the winters she spent in Florida that she instructed the trustees of a charitable trust established by will to consider the College as a grant beneficiary. Distributions from the Edward W. and Stella C. Van Houten Memorial Fund will be used to strengthen the Library.

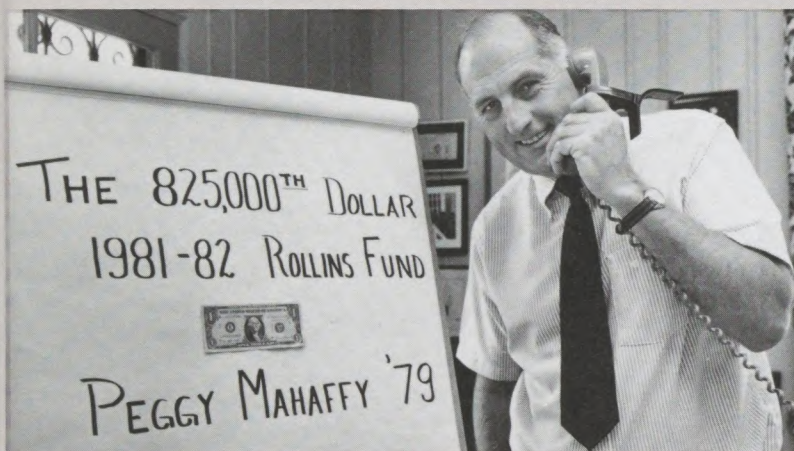

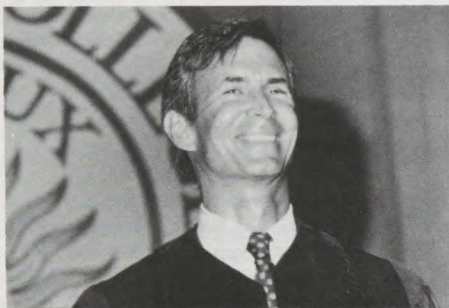

The 1982 Rollins College Commencement ceremonies featured the recognition of three distinguished Rollins alumni. Among the 919 individuals receiving diplomas from the College were famous actor Tony Perkins '54 and Pittsburgh attorney and Rollins Trustee Thomas P. Johnson '32. Historian Watt P. Marchman '33 was honored with the Alumni Association's Distinguished Alumnus Award. Following are the citations read by President Thaddeus Seymour during the presentations.

ANTHONY PERKINS

HONORARY DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

You would have crossed this platform thirty years ago, but you went and transferred to a prep school—not in New England but on Broadway, where you played Tom in "Tea and Sympathy" and graduated as the brightest young star of a generation. Of course, we were not surprised. You were already the star of the Annie Russell Theatre, and you had even made a movie. They filmed "The Actress" in December of your junior year, and when asked how you spent your Christmas vacation, you could reply, "Oh, I went to Hollywood and made a movie."

In your professional career you have played sensitive and versatile roles on Broadway and in Hollywood, where you have appeared in over forty films. You almost ruined the motel industry with "Psycho", which still keeps us awake after The Late Show. And we liked your "Equus" so much that we did it here, and we lost some sleep over that, too.

This is your first visit in thirty years. You will find here the Rollins you left behind; the friendships and familiar haunts, like the wall outside the Green Room where you used to sit

and hold forth; the tradition of great and caring teachers like Wilbur Dorsett and Ed Granberry and Howard Bailey; and the family spirit which makes this such a special place. We hope that you will remember those days and this one, and remember also Laura's curtain line: "Years from now, when you talk about this—and you will—be kind."

As we conclude the Jubilee Year of the Annie Russell Theatre, we celebrate a career which was nurtured on its stage. We welcome you back with pride and affection, as I confer upon you, Anthony Perkins, the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, with all the rights, privileges, and signal obligations thereunto appertaining.

THOMAS PHILLIPS JOHNSON

HONORARY DOCTOR OF LAWS

As a student at Rollins fifty years ago, you were equally at home in academic and athletic surroundings. So it is appropriate that we recognize you here in the Enyart-Alumni Field House, not simply because of your life-long interest in sports, but because this is literally "The House That Tom Built." You led the fund drive which provided this fine facility for future generations of Rollins men and women, and this is only a sample and example of your life-long service to your *alma mater*.

A member of the Class of 1934, your leadership began when you were elected President of the Sophomore Class and ultimately the President of the Student Body. You played football, baseball, and golf, managed The Sandspur and Tomokan, and then, by gum, graduated at the top of your class. At Harvard you had the unusual distinction of being Editor of the *Law Review* for two years, and you graduated again at the top of your class, *magna cum laude*. Your academic career of scholarships, leadership, and participation proclaims Rollins at its very best.

But Rollins was just the beginning. You entered a fine law firm in Pittsburgh, and

when war came, you served as special assistant to the Secretary of the Navy and retired as a young Lieutenant Commander. Today you are a Vice President of Rockwell International, Chairman of the First Seneca Bank and Trust, and a Director of several major corporations. And when Billy Mazerowski's hit went over the wall in 1960, your Pittsburgh Pirates became World Champions.

We honor you for your impressive accomplishments as student, lawyer, businessman, and sportsman, but most of all we thank you for what you have done for Rollins. You have served as a Trustee continuously since 1939, finding time to head the Alumni Association along the way. You have had a hand in every major event and decision for nearly half the history of this College, and Rollins has flourished under your stewardship. Insiders know that we might not have survived the crisis of 1953 without you.

So, thank you for reminding us that success comes from study and hard work, and for sharing with Rollins your uncommon talent, spirit, and generosity. I am proud to confer upon you, Thomas Phillips Johnson, the honorary degree of Doctor of Laws, with all the rights, privileges, and signal obligations thereunto appertaining.

WATT PEARSON MARCHMAN

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNUS AWARD

The mission of a college is best described by the accomplishments of its graduates, and your career as historian and librarian gives eloquent testimony to our commitment to the liberal arts. A major in English and American literature, your enthusiasm for history was reflected in your work as College Archivist, a job which helped you to work your way through college. No one was more proud of your career than Fred Hanna, with whom you founded the Union Catalogue of Floridiana and carried out our Semicentennial Celebration. For three years you ran our Placement Office for students and alumni and

then, in 1939, became Executive Secretary and Librarian of the Florida Historical Society. Under your leadership the Society's membership and library increased significantly.

Since your military service in Europe during World War II, you have devoted your life to the archives, memorabilia, and library of the 19th President of the United States, Rutherford B. Hayes. As Director of the Hayes Library and Museum and Manager of the Hayes State Memorial, you have assisted generations of historians, scholars, and authors in their work.

In your home of Fremont, Ohio, you have encouraged an interest in local history and historic preservation, and you have held important positions in numerous library and historical organizations. A prolific editor and scholar, you have written monographs and articles in the field of history, for which you have received numerous awards and recognitions, including The Award of Merit of the Ohio Academy of History. In 1980, Findlay College conferred upon you its honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, and a conference room in your name was designated in the Rutherford B. Hayes Library.

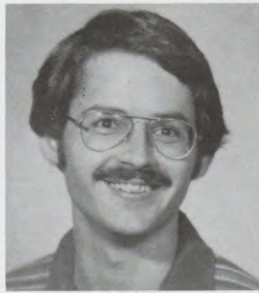

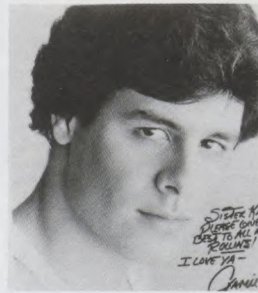

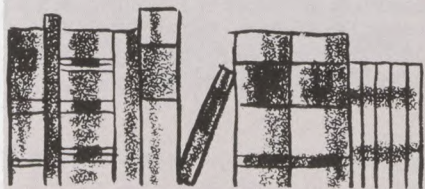
