***Haplophragmoides apertiumbolicatus*, new name for
Haplophragmoides umbilicatus Kaiho, 1984 (preoccupied)**

A new name for the species *Haplophragmoides umbilicatus* Kaiho, 1984 is proposed, the species being a junior homonym of *H. umbilicatum* Pearcey (1914, p. 1008, pl. 2, figs. 8-10). The name *Haplophragmoides apertium-*

bolicatus, nov. nom. is hereby designated to encompass the description and holotype in my previous work (Kaiho, 1984, p. 115-116, pl. 7, figs. 6a, b). The species name is given because of its somewhat open umbilicus.
