***Elphidium wakkanabense*, new name for *Elphidium
asanoi* Kaiho, 1984 (preoccupied)**

A new name for the species *Elphidium asanoi* Kaiho, 1984 is proposed, the species being a junior homonym of *E. asanoi* Matsunaga (1963, p. 109, pl. 36, figs. 6a, b). The name *Elphidium wakkanabense*, nov. nom. is hereby designat-

ed to encompass the description and holotype in my previous work (Kaiho, 1984, p. 124-125, pl. 10, figs. 1a, b). The species name is given after the Wakkanabe Formation from which the species occurred.
