My friend ■

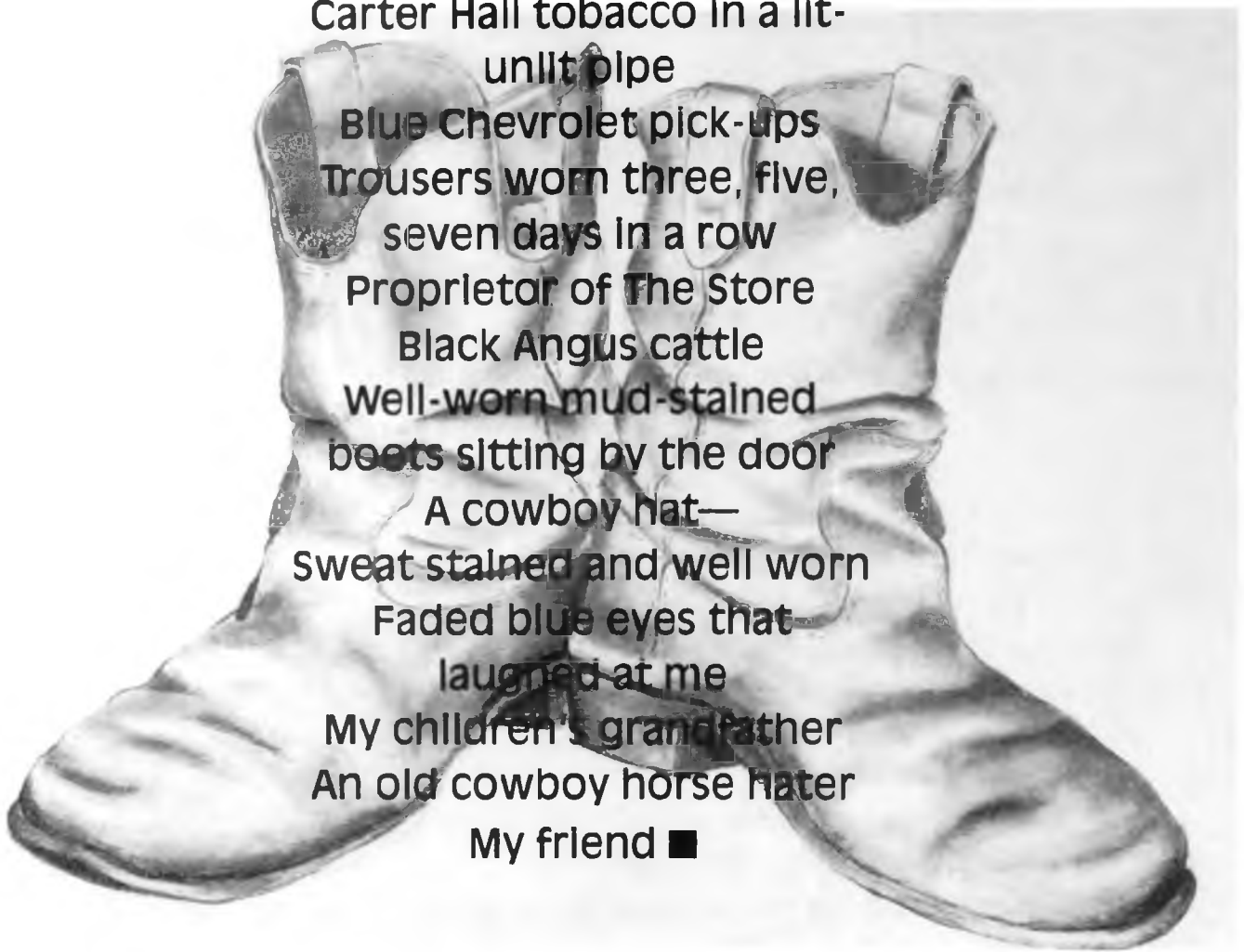
