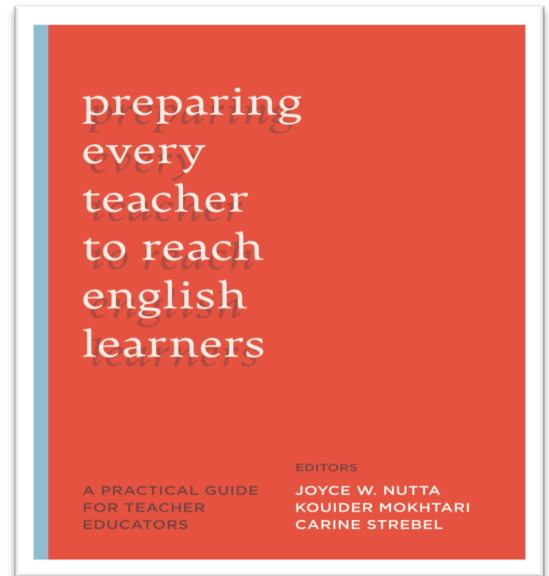
The book presents a practical, flexible model for infusing English learner (EL) instruction into teacher education courses.
