


- Shared names (Bob from FL, Bob from GA)

- Transliteration (鲍步 or 博比)

Name ambiguity

- Accents and diacritics (Bób)
- Name changes (Bob Jones → Bob Smith)
- Multiple family names (Bob Jones Smith)


