

#### **Article Search**

Searches multiple databases

### Subject-specific databases


 Use to search databases not included in Article Search or QuickSearch

### Google Scholar

- Broad, multi-disciplinary search
- Off-Campus access may require additional setup (LibX)




### Off Campus Access



- Why am I hitting a paywall?
  - Restart browser or clear cache and then log in again
- LibX
  - Browser add-on that works with EZproxy

## Finding Books

#### QuickSearch

Includes results from the library's catalog

### **Library Catalog**

- Search course reserves
- Request items from the ARC



### **Interlibrary Loan & Document Delivery**

#### Articles

 Once requested, scanned and uploaded within 3-5 business days

### **Books & Media**

- Typically ready for pick-up in 7-10 days
- Additional processing time for branch/regional locations & distance learners

- Exists to publicize, disseminate, and provide ready access to works by, for, and about the University of Central Florida





### **More about STARS**



- Administered by the UCF Libraries, STARS is available to host and promote research, creative activity, and institutional outputs to:
  - Ensure persistent access to your work
  - Increase discovery of UCF scholarship and creative endeavors
  - Foster scholarly collaborations with colleagues
  - Document and record UCF's history and progress
  - Discover open access materials and projects created by UCF authors
  - Allow you to share your work while retaining your copyright



### Storage of Files & Data

- Examples of content you may put in STARS:
  - Working papers, conference papers, and technical reports
  - Faculty-student collaborative projects
  - Journals published by the UCF community
  - Published articles when copyright and/or license allow
  - Faculty course-related output primarily of scholarly interest
  - Organizational annual reports, newsletters, etc.
  - Data sets
  - Books or book chapters when copyright and/or license allow
  - Image collections or audiovisual materials
  - Conferences and events
  - Projects that include digitized content and/or links to online content

### Publishing Resources

- Evaluate and compare different sources to help determine the best journal: Journal Citation Reports (JCR) <a href="https://guides.ucf.edu/database/JCR">https://guides.ucf.edu/database/JCR</a> or The Source (book)
- Consider the checklist from Think Check Submit: http://thinkchecksubmit.org/
- Search SHERPA/RoMEO to see if your published works can be archived in places such as your personal website or in STARS: http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/search.php





### Open Access



- Aim is to make scholarly literature freely available and often free of most copyright and licensing restrictions
- Directory of Open Access Journals: <a href="https://doaj.org/">https://doaj.org/</a>
- Use the SPARC Open site to evaluate the openness of journals: <a href="http://sparcopen.org/our-work/howopenisit/">http://sparcopen.org/our-work/howopenisit/</a>
- Use precautions if publishing Open Access by looking through a list of journals removed from the Directory of Open Access Journals: <a href="https://tinyurl.com/removed-from-DOAJ">https://tinyurl.com/removed-from-DOAJ</a>

### **Research Impact and Metrics**




- Journal metrics:

- Article citation counts
