Finding Articles

Article Search

- Searches multiple databases

Subject-specific databases

- Use to search databases not included in Article Search or QuickSearch

Google Scholar

- Broad, multi-disciplinary search
- Off-Campus access may require additional setup (LibX)

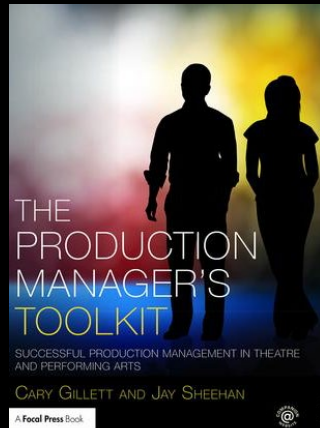
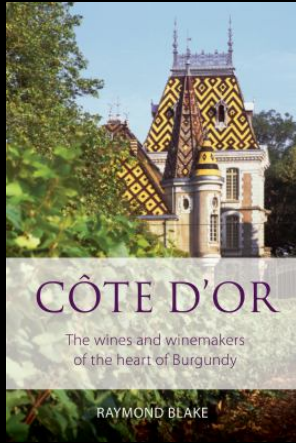

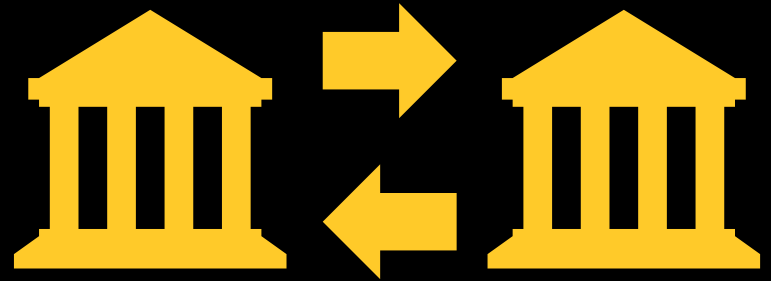
Interlibrary Loan & Document Delivery

Articles

- Once requested, scanned and uploaded within 3-5 business days

Books & Media

- Typically ready for pick-up in 7-10 days
- Additional processing time for branch/regional locations & distance learners

More about STARS



- Administered by the UCF Libraries, STARS is available to host and promote research, creative activity, and institutional outputs to:
 - Ensure persistent access to your work
 - Increase discovery of UCF scholarship and creative endeavors
 - Foster scholarly collaborations with colleagues
 - Document and record UCF's history and progress
 - Discover open access materials and projects created by UCF authors
 - Allow you to share your work while retaining your copyright

Storage of Files & Data

- Examples of content you may put in STARS:
 - Working papers, conference papers, and technical reports
 - Faculty-student collaborative projects
 - Journals published by the UCF community
 - Published articles when copyright and/or license allow
 - Faculty course-related output primarily of scholarly interest
 - Organizational annual reports, newsletters, etc.
 - Data sets
 - Books or book chapters when copyright and/or license allow
 - Image collections or audiovisual materials
 - Conferences and events
 - Projects that include digitized content and/or links to online content

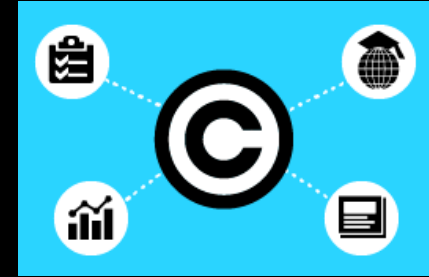


Open Access



- Aim is to make scholarly literature freely available and often free of most copyright and licensing restrictions
- Directory of Open Access Journals: <https://doaj.org/>
- Use the SPARC Open site to evaluate the openness of journals: <http://sparcopen.org/our-work/howopenisit/>
- Use precautions if publishing Open Access by looking through a list of journals removed from the Directory of Open Access Journals: <https://tinyurl.com/removed-from-DOAJ>
