- **How do I borrow books?**
 - Videos are available on a range of topics, including how to borrow and return books, pay fines, and use the scanning and print service. To access library services for students visit <https://www.brookes.ac.uk/library/library-services/library-services-for-students/>
- **Where are the short loan books?**
 - When books have access restrictions, ask for them at the Welcome Desk. These have been listed as 'high demand.' These are kept in the Short Loan collection here: For more information see <https://www.brookes.ac.uk/library/library-services/borrowing/short-loan-collection---guidelines-for-users/>
- **Can I reserve books?**
 - If a book is out on loan, at another Brookes library, or you are rarely on campus, you can reserve books to collect later. To see a video on how to reserve a book do visit <https://radar.brookes.ac.uk/radar/items/44a38221-3fec-4ae9-8821-e498109190cc/1/>
- **How many books can I borrow?**
 - Students may borrow up to 20 books or other items, using your student card on self-issue machines. The limit is 30 for final year undergraduates, postgraduates, researchers, and staff.
