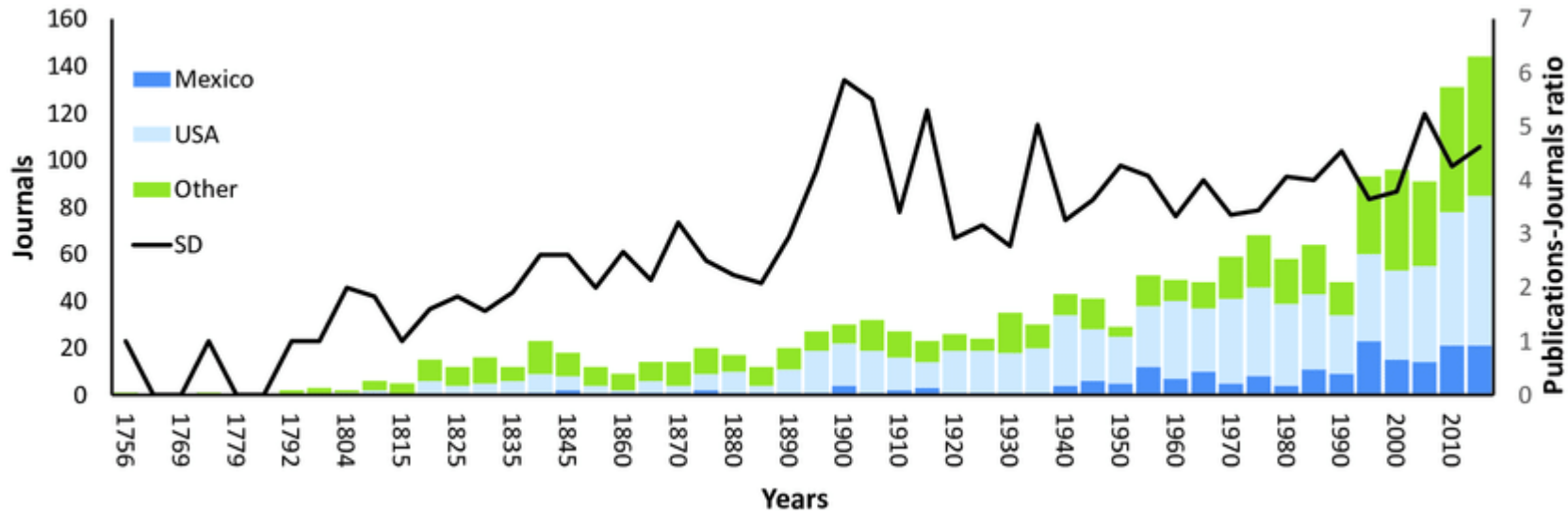

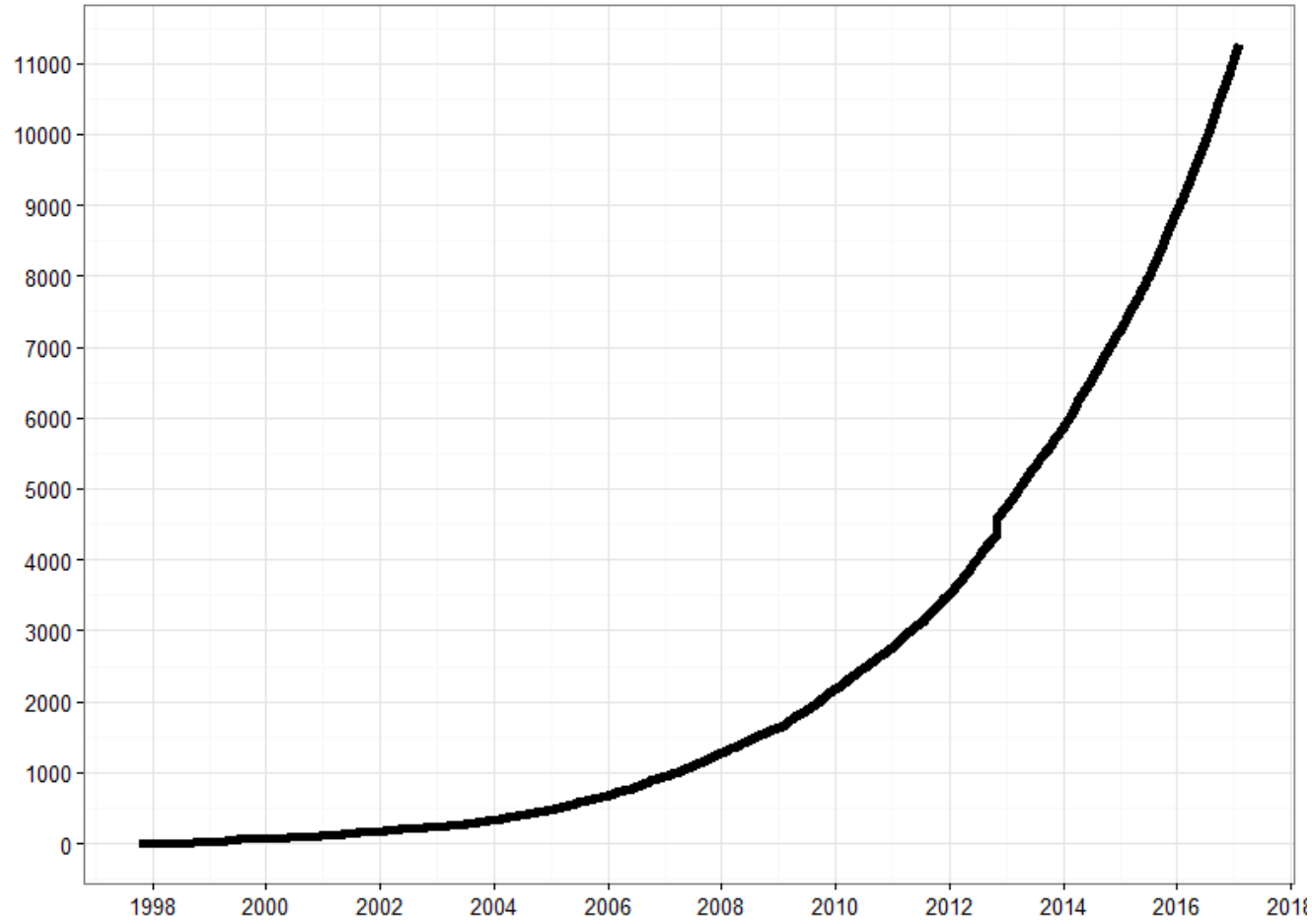

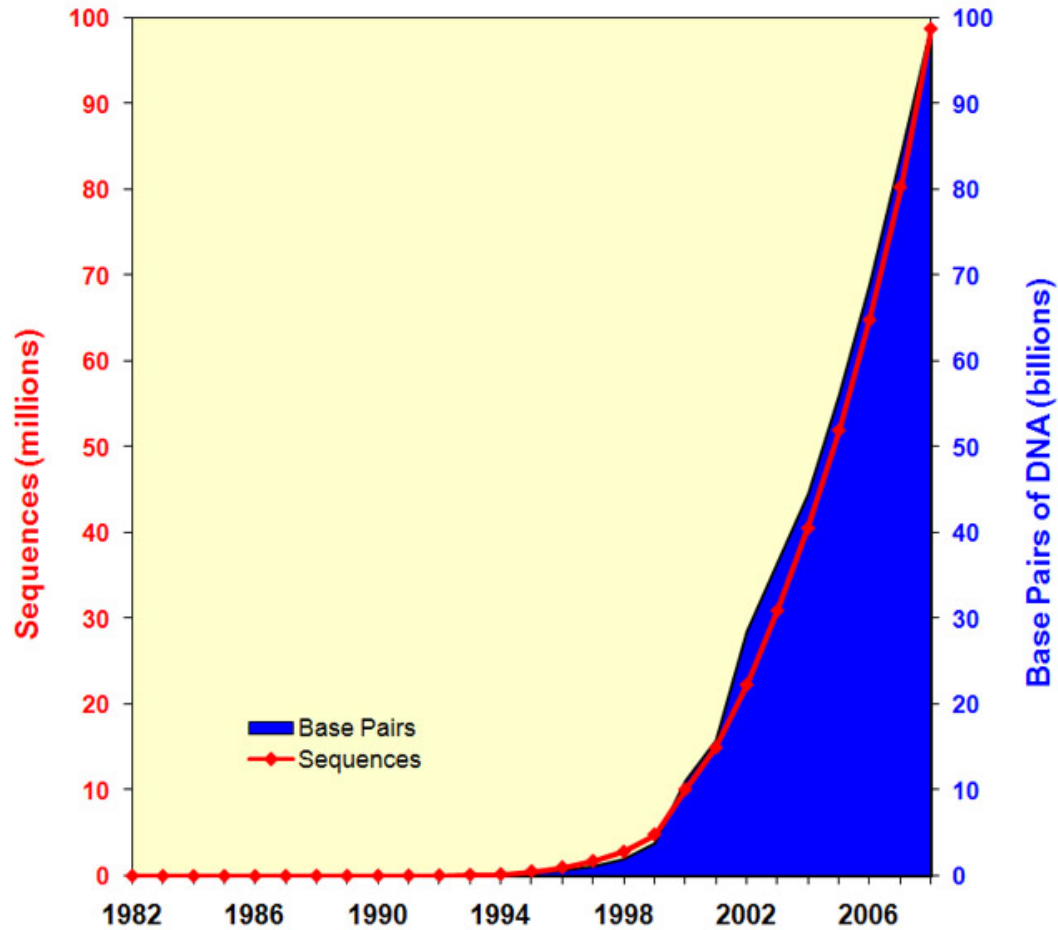
# The Pace of Research is Increasing

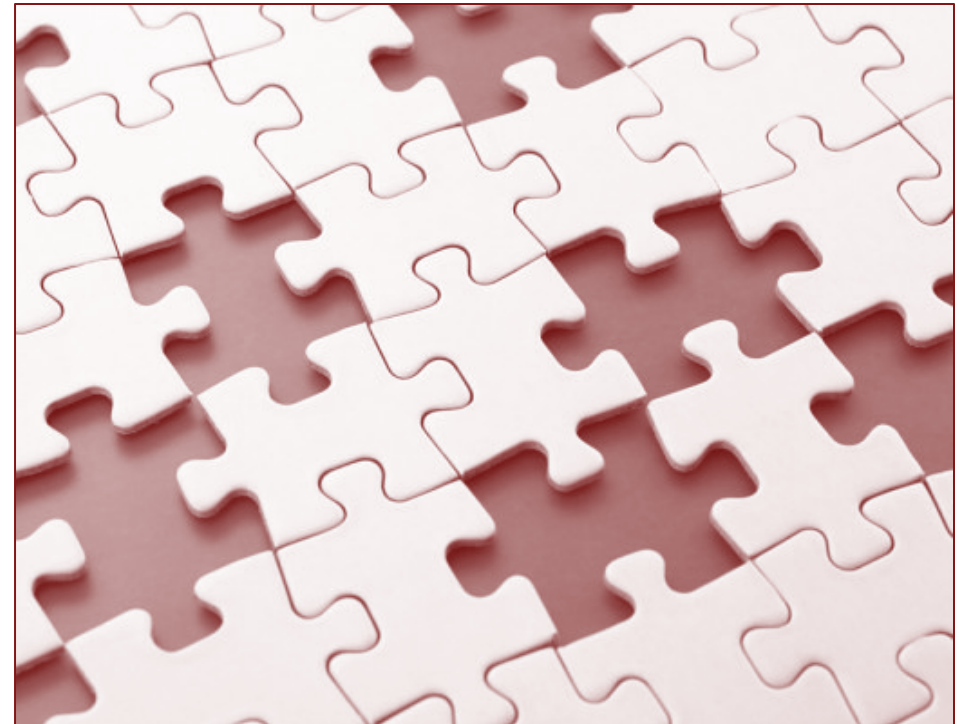

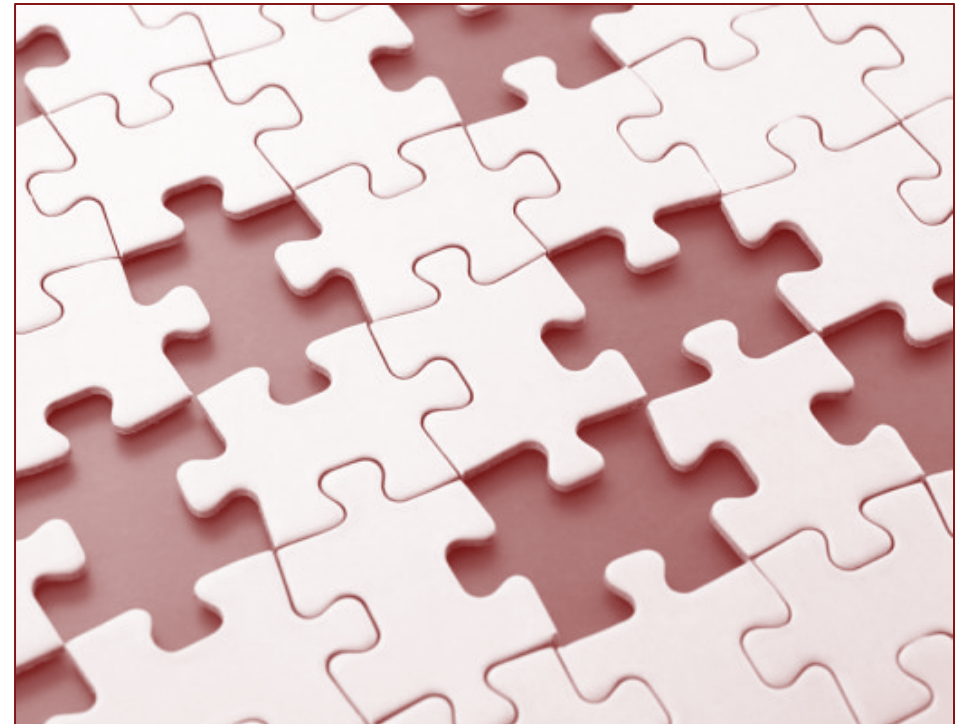

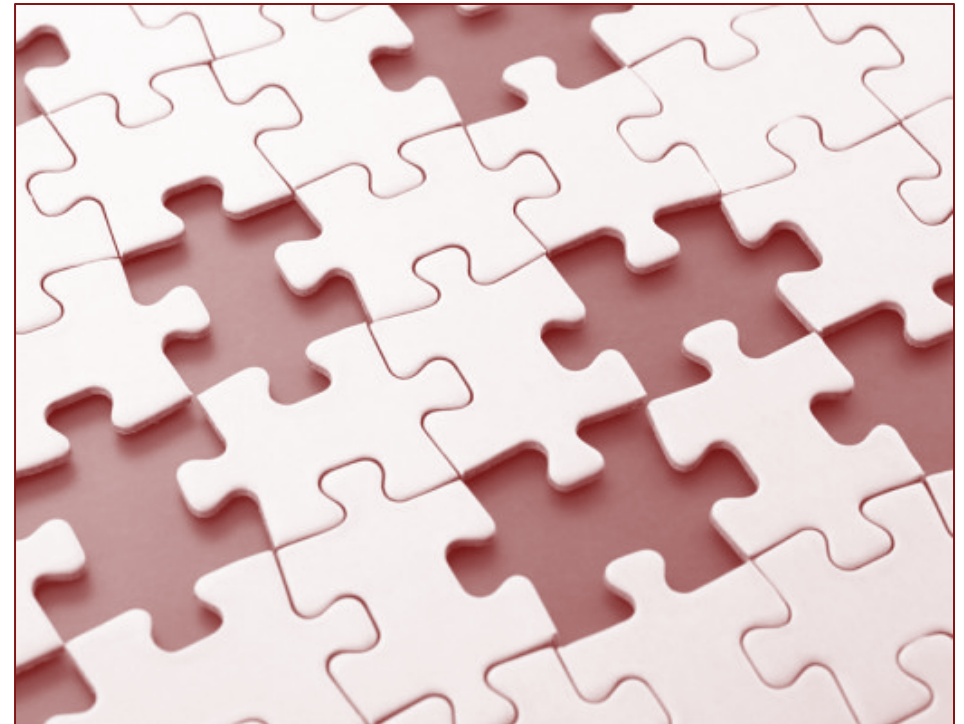

## *Survival Skills 101*

- **Managing Research Data**  
file naming, file & folder organization, ReadMe's
- **Formatting Your Data for Analysis**  
cleaning up data tables/spreadsheets
- **Concepts of Data Driven Visualization**  
which visualization for your data?
- **Keep Your Research Safe with Backups**  
Who, What, Where, When, Why, and How

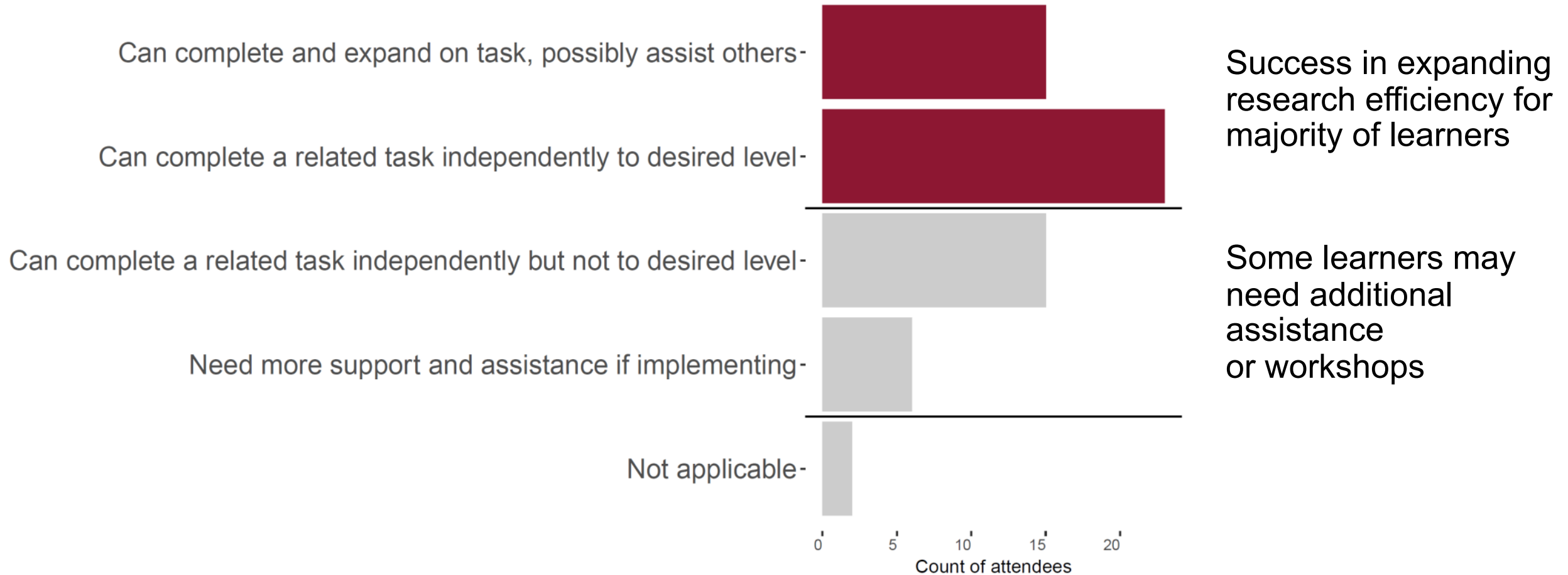

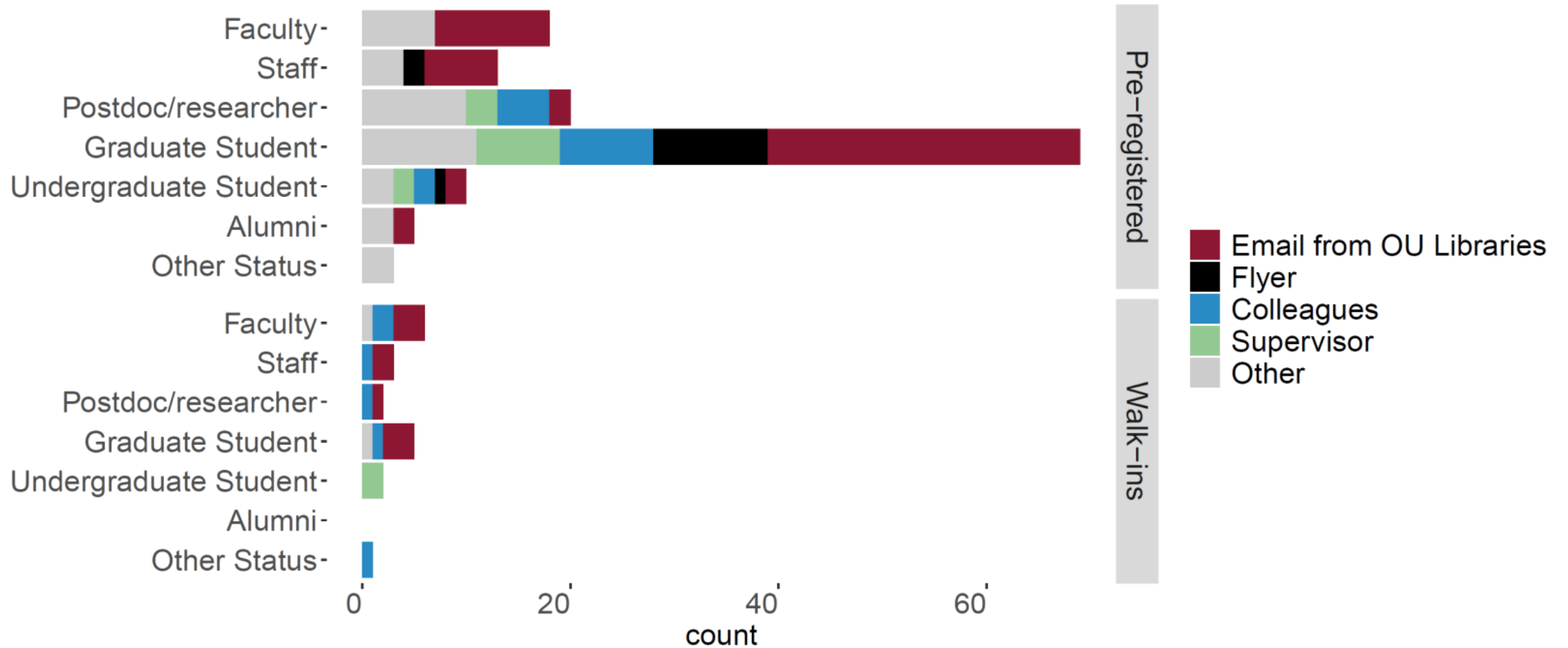

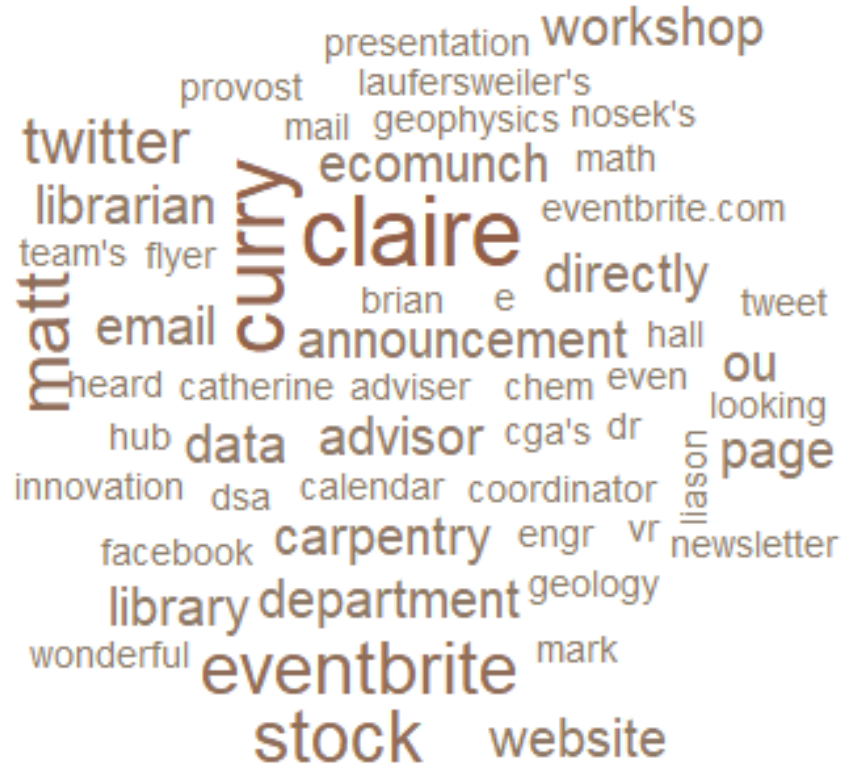
