Any library or information resource that can be accessed via computer, e.g.

- Electronic books.
- Electronic journals.
- Scholarly databases.
- ☐ Dictionaries, encyclopedias, economic data.
- Information gateways.
- The Internet.

Also reports, magazines, grey literature.



Aims of Information Services

The primary aims of Information Services:

- to support the learning, teaching and research activities.
- to keep the university community informed of the library`s services and possibilities.
- to develop direct communication between the library and the academic departments.

The Best Free Research Search Engine

- 1. <u>Google Scholar</u> (peer-reviewed papers, theses, books, abstracts and articles from academic publishers, professional societies, preprint repositories, etc);
- 2. Google Books (thousands of books, from popular titles to old);
- **3.** <u>Microsoft Academic</u> (content from over 120 million publications, including scientific papers, conferences and journals);
- 4. Worldwide Science The Global Science Gateway;
- 5. Science.gov (over 60 databases, over 2,200 websites and 200 million pages of journals);
- 6. Wolfram Alpha (A self-described "computational knowledge engine");
- 7. Refseek (over one billion web pages, encyclopedias, journals and books);
- **8.** <u>Educational Resources Information Center</u> (more than 1.3 million bibliographic records of articles and online materials);
- 9. <u>Virtual Learning Resources Center</u> (thousands of scholarly websites);
- 10. iSeek (help to find exactly what you are looking for);
- 11. ResearchGate (a unique social networking site for scientists and researchers);
- 12. <u>BASE</u> (Bielefeld Academic Search Engine) search engines especially for academic web resources
- 13. Infotopia "Google-alternative safe search engine";
- 14. PubMed Central (perfect for those studying anything related to healthcare or science);
- 15. Lexis Web (researching legal topics).
