By telegram of 5 June 1973, confirmed by letter of 6 June, the President of the Council of the European Communities requested the opinion of the European Parliament, pursuant to Article 43 of the Treaty establishing the EEC, on the proposal from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council on a regulation fixing the main intervention centres for oilseeds for the 1973/1974 marketing year and the derived intervention prices in these centres.

The European Parliament referred this proposal to the Committee on Agriculture.

The committee appointed Mr HÉGER rapporteur. It considered this proposal at its meeting of 5 June and adopted the following motion for a resolution with 11 votes in favour and 3 abstentions.

MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

embodying the opinion of the European Parliament on the proposal from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council for a regulation fixing the main intervention centres for oilseeds for the 1973/1974 marketing year and the derived intervention prices applicable in these centres

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the proposal from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council (COM (73) 888 final);
 - having been consulted by the Council pursuant to Article 43 of the Treaty establishing the EEC (Doc. 95/73);
 - having regard to the report of the Committee on Agriculture (Doc. 98/73).
1. Approves the Commission's proposal;
 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission of the European Communities.
