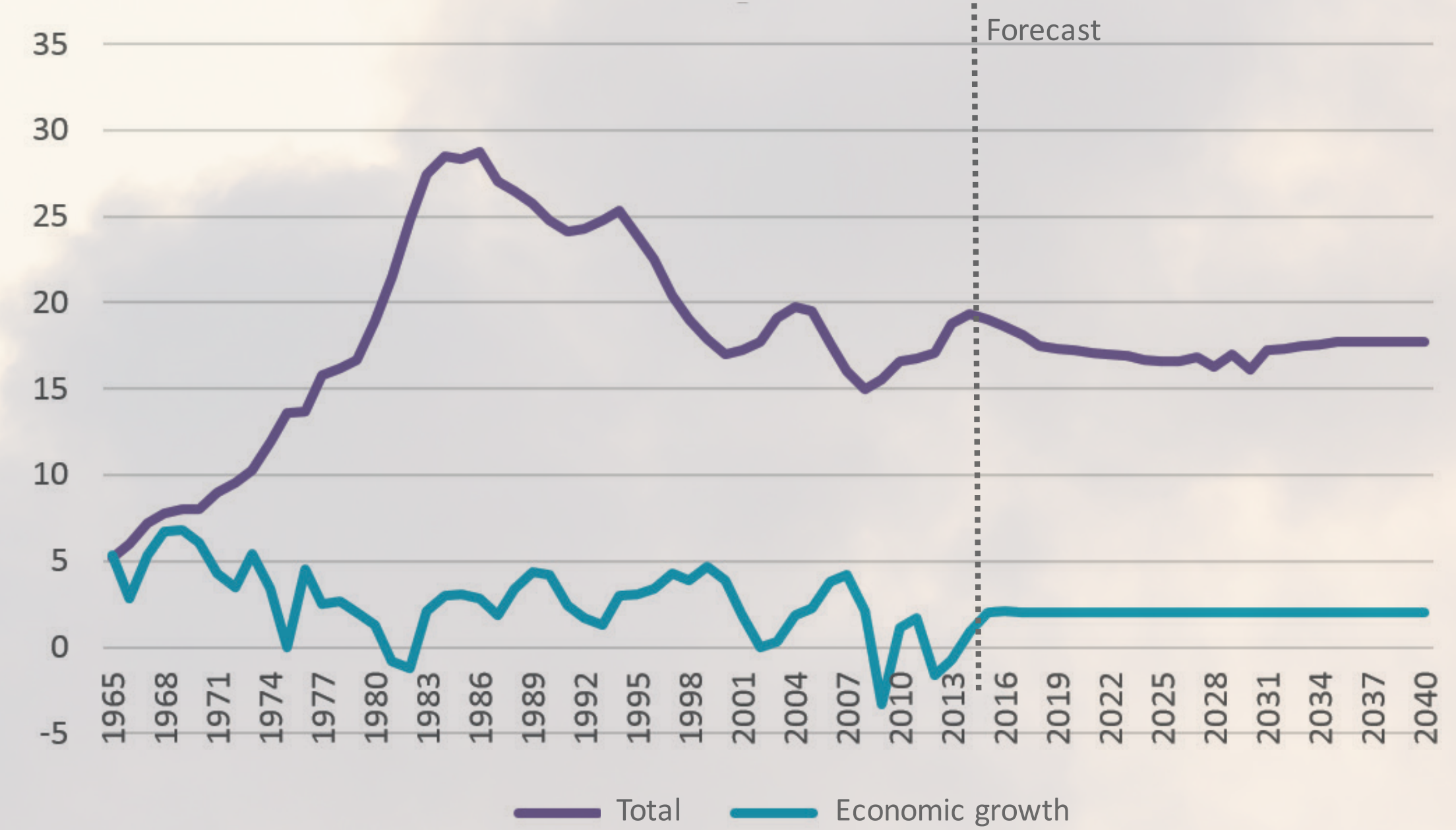
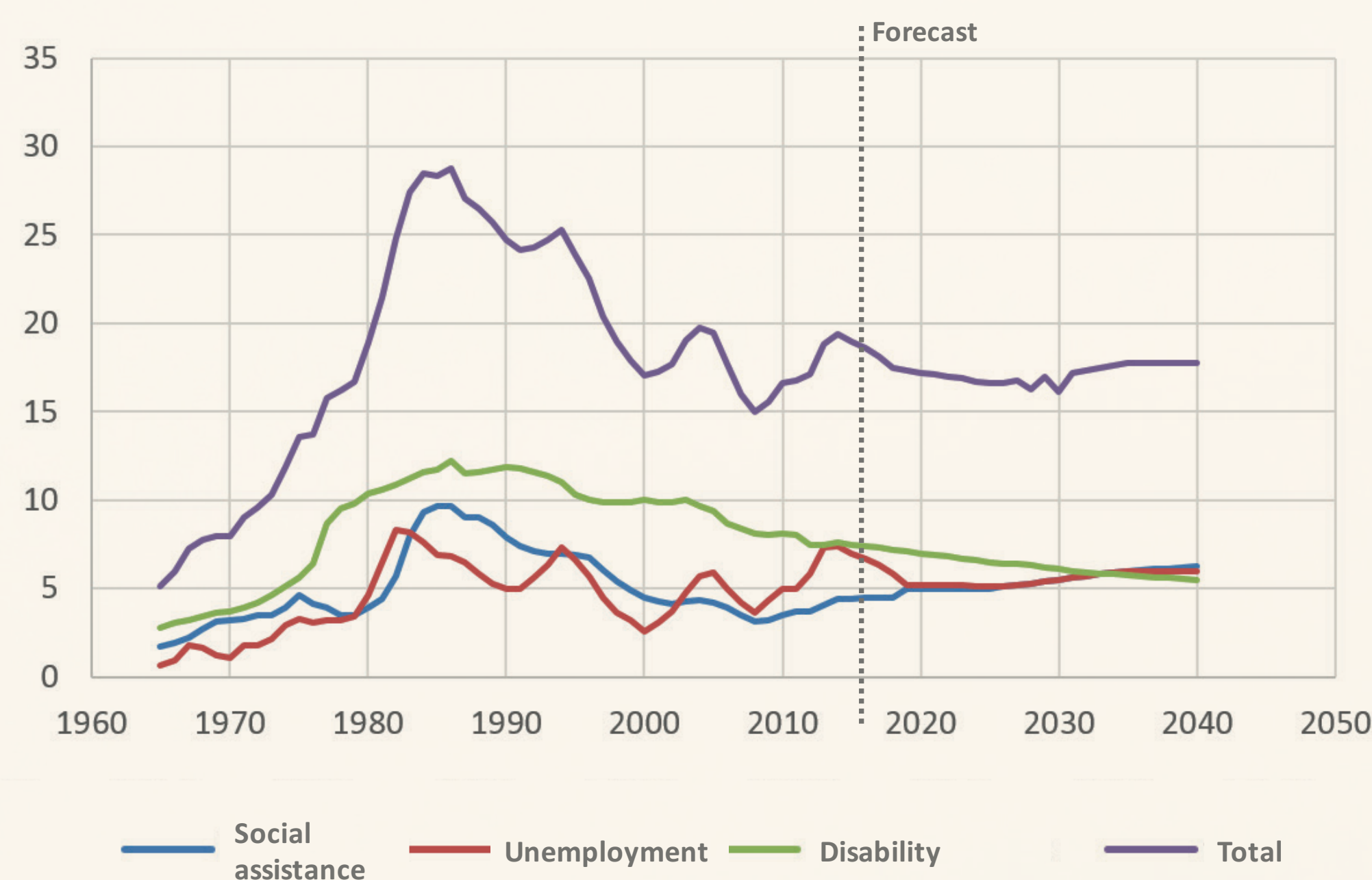




JOB GUARANTEE or INCOME GUARANTEE

- structural full employment
- stimulating economic growth

Radical Income security BASIC INCOME GUARANTEE

- less bureaucracy
- disastrous for GNP and welfare



Radical job security JOB GUARANTEE

- higher GNP and welfare
- in accordance with market economy?
