



# JOB GUARANTEE or INCOME GUARANTEE

- Sustainable unemployment
- Burden on economic growth

### **Ambitions:**

- affordability welfare state
- structural full employment
- stimulating economic growth

#### Radical Income security

#### BASIC INCOME GUARANTEE

- less bureaucracy
- disastrous for GNP and welfare



#### Radical job security

#### JOB GUARANTEE

- higher GNP and welfare
- in accordance with market economy?
