Headings should not be underlined, ONCE AN ARTICLE IS ACCEPTED FOR PUBLICATION, THE AUTHOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT THE FINAL VER-SION ON DISK. Disk requirements are Macintosh 3.5" drive in Word 5.0 or higher format. The author's complete name, address and telephone number should be typed on a separate sheet and attached to the original copy of the manuscript. Three copies of each manu-script are to be submitted. Photographs, drawings, car-

toons, and other illustrations are welcome. Authors should be prepared to provide copies of permission to quote copyrighted materials. Queries concerning pro-posed articles or reviews are welcome. The editors reserve the right to make grammatical corrections and minor changes in article texts to improve clarify. Ad-dress questions regarding specific styles to the Editor.
