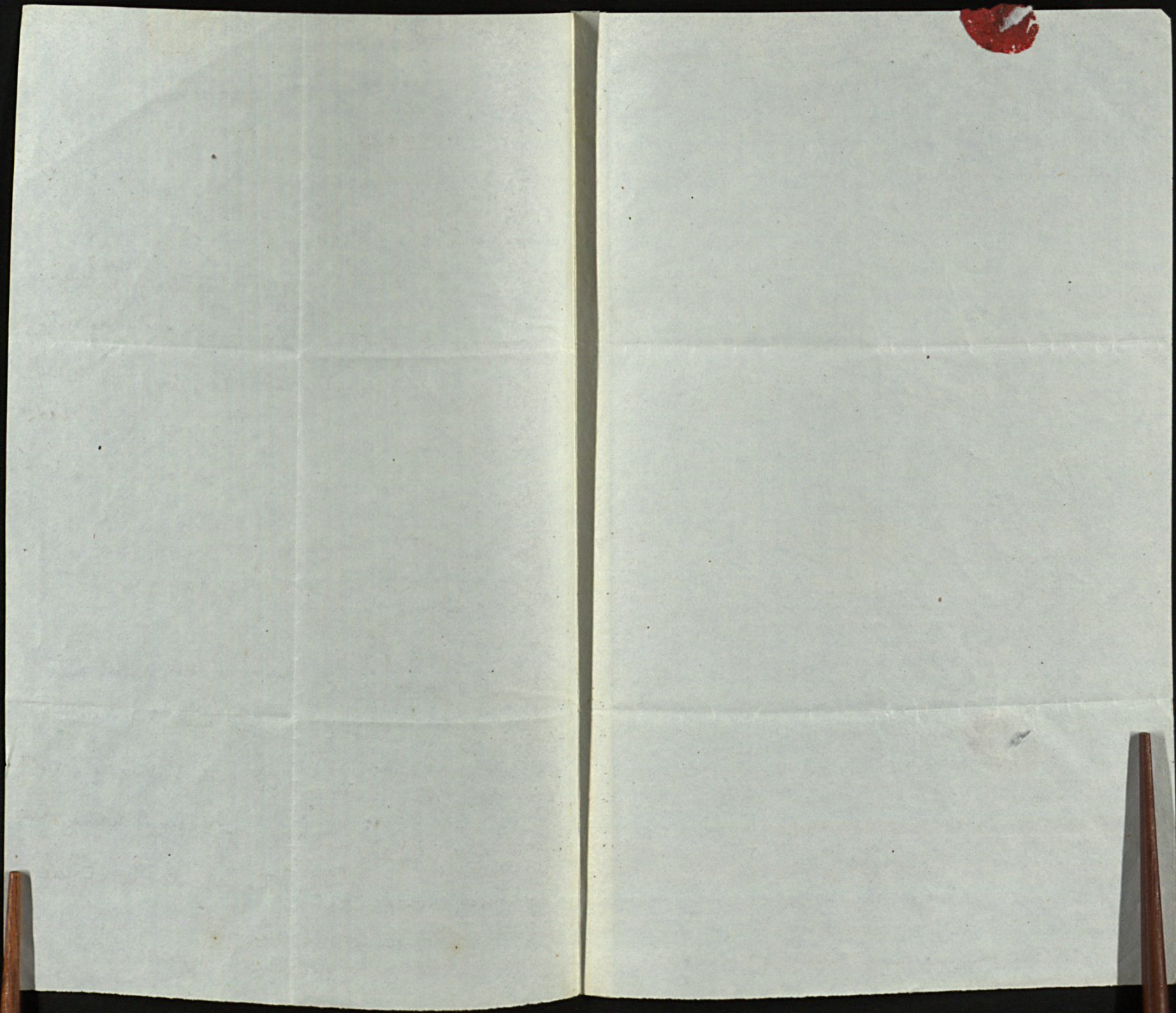
You are very kind to me and the Review.
