8 9	Whereas, the Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) represents the interests
9 10	of over 12,000 students at the University of Montana;
10	of over 12,000 students at the Oniversity of Wontana,
12	Whereas, the Montana Residential Landlord Tenant Act (MRLTA) was designed to fairly protect
13	and represent both landlords and tenants;
14	
15	Whereas, UM students are both landlords and tenants;
16	
17	Whereas, Current Legislative proposals such as Senate Bills 174, 175, and 176 and House Bill
18	348 would significantly curtail tenants' rights to privacy, safety, and equal treatment under the
19	law;
20	
21	Whereas, Senate Bill 176 presents a gross overreach on the part of landlord advocates and a
22	legislature in dictating rulings to the judicial branch;
23	
24	Whereas, the protections currently laid out in the MRLTA are particularly important to college
25	students and other vulnerable tenant populations;

27	Whereas, preserving the equity and fairness of the MRLTA is important to all students who live
28	off-campus;

30	Whereas, the ASUM Off-Campus Renter Center (OCRC) is an ASUM agency that works to
31	advocate for the rights of student tenants who rent off-campus;
32	Whereas Mary O'Mellay Director of the OCBC has identified surrent logislation that threatens
33 34	Whereas, Mary O'Malley, Director of the OCRC, has identified current legislation that threatens the balanced relationship of landlords and tenants dictated by the MRLTA;
35 35	the balanced relationship of fandiords and tenants dictated by the WIKLTA,
35 36	Therefore, Let it Be Resolved, that the Associated Students of the University of Montana
30 37	(ASUM) supports landlord-tenant laws that ensure equal protection for tenants;
38	(Abolit) supports functore tenant haws that ensure equal protection for tenants,
39	Therefore, Let it Further Be Resolved, that ASUM condemns any legislative efforts to weaken
40	legal protections and basic rights for vulnerable tenant populations in Montana;
41	
42	Therefore, Let it Further Be Resolved, that the ASUM lobbyist is authorized to advocate for the
43	preservation of legal protections of student tenants;

- 45 Therefore, Let it Further Be Resolved, that ASUM encourages student organizations across the
- state, such as ASMSU and MAS, to take a formal stance against any legislative efforts to
- 47 undermine the rights of student renters and otherwise vulnerable tenant populations;
