1 The Associated Students of the University of Montana 2 **Resolution Amending Elections Bylaws** 3 5/1/18 4 SB50-17/18 5 Authored by: Victoria Lewis, ASUM Senator; 6 Sponsored by: 7 8 Whereas, There is currently a discrepancy between the deadline for campaigning candidates and 9 write-in candidates in the Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) Bylaws; 10 11 Whereas, Bylaws Article 5, Section 3 Subsection H currently reads: 12 13 "Each candidate, candidate team, or ballot referendum campaign must document expenditures for the Elections Committee by filing an expenditure form, complete with 14 receipts, at a date determined by the Elections Committee, no later than 1.5 weeks prior 15 16 to the general election. Write-in candidates may turn in expense reports by 5 p.m. on the 17 business day immediately following the announcement of the election results. Expenditure forms must be filed even if there are no expenditures. Additional 18 expenditures made after the form deadline must be documented and filed prior to the 19 20 closure of voting. Candidate expenditures will be made public by Elections Committee prior to the first day of general election. Each candidate, candidate team, or ballot 21 referendum campaign is subject to disqualification, upon recommendation by the ASUM 22 23 Elections Committee and confirmation by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Senate, if expenditures are filed late or if total expenditures exceed the aforementioned limits 24 25 according to Article 5, Section 2.H of ASUM Bylaws."; 26 27 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That Bylaws Article 5 Section 3 Subsection H read: 28 29 "Each candidate, candidate team, or ballot referendum campaign must document 30 expenditures for the Elections Committee by filing an expenditure form, complete with receipts, at a date determined by the Elections Committee, no later than 1.5 weeks prior 31 32 to the general election. Write-in candidates may turn in expense reports by 5 p.m. on the 33 business day immediately following the announcement of the election results. 34 Expenditure forms must be filed even if there are no expenditures. Additional 35 expenditures made after the form deadline must be documented and filed by 5 p.m. on the 36 business day immediately following the announcement of the election results. Candidate expenditures will be made public by Elections Committee prior to the first day 37 of general election. Each candidate, candidate team, or ballot referendum campaign is 38 39 subject to disqualification, upon recommendation by the ASUM Elections Committee and confirmation by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Senate, if expenditures are filed late or if 40 41 total expenditures exceed the aforementioned limits according to Article 5, Section 2.H of ASUM Bylaws." 42 43 44 45 Passed by ASUM Senate: _______, 2018 46
