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1 The Associated Students of the University of Montana 2 Ballot Referenda Regarding Rafter 360 Pilot Program 3 **April 8, 2015** 4 SB81-14/15 5 Authored by: Ryan Hazen, ASUM Business Manager; Betsy Story, ASUM Senator 6 Sponsored by: 7 8 Whereas, the Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) represents the 9 University of Montana (UM) student body; 10 11 Whereas, throughout the year ASUM has looked at a proposal that aims to make 12 textbooks more affordable; 13 14 Whereas, this would be a fee increase; 15 16 Whereas, ASUM is required to put fee increases to a student vote before ASUM can 17 support said fee; 18 19 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, the following language be placed on the 2015 ASUM 20 ballot: 21 22 "There is a proposal brought before ASUM to combat rising costs of textbook. The 23 proposal would entail the following: 24 25 1) To contract with Rafter, Inc. a total value of \$21 per qualified undergraduate 26 student per credit hour to cover the cost of textbooks and qualified materials, plus 27 software and services to implement the program and would have a flat rate of \$252 28 for every incoming freshman taking between 12 and 21 credits per semester; for 29 incoming freshmen taking between 1 and 11 credits, the fee would be \$21 per credit; 30 for freshmen taking above 21 credits it would be an additional \$21 per credit; 31 32 2) Students would be provided with textbooks and coursework materials at the 33 beginning of each semester and return them at the semester's end. A liability fee 34 would be implemented that would cost \$1 per credit for students taking between 1 35 and 11 credits, \$12 for students taking between 12 and 21 credits, and \$12 plus an 36 additional \$1 for each credit over 21 credits; 37 38 3) If passed, the pilot program would be implemented towards incoming freshman for 39 a two year period. UM would then have the option to continue or to discontinue the 40 contract with Rafter Inc. after this two year period." 41 42 43 Yes, I support implementing the proposed pilot program by Rafter Inc. 44 45 No, I do not support implementing the proposed pilot program by Rafter Inc. 46
