The Missoula College and Bitterroot College Affairs Committee shall be composed of seven (7) members, of which at least one (1) shall be a member of the Senate and at least two (2) shall be students at-large from either the Missoula College or Bitterroot College. Any student may be a non-voting advisory member of the Committee.
